# Mousetrap shows 'Blithe Spirit'

Mousetrap Theatre has the unique experience of presenting Noel Coward's most famous play "Blithe Spirit" exactly 75 years after the famous author first penned it.

While the production runs over 3 weeks from 29 April to 14 May, Coward took only 6 days from 3 - 9 May 1941 to write his masterpiece. The play was his most successful, having held the record for the most performances for several decades, until it was surpassed by Agatha Christie's equally famous Mousetrap (yet another link to this well-known local company).

The action takes place at the country home of Charles and Ruth Condomine. Charles (Steve Pearton) is a novelist who is about to write his next book, "The Unseen", about a murderous psychic. In order to do some background research for his book he invites his friends Dr and Mrs Bradman (Tom Burrell and Karen Christl) to join him and his wife Ruth (Karen Matthews) in a séance. The séance is to be led by Madame Arcati (Susan Harding-Smith) who used to be a professional medium in London, and is considered somewhat of a local celebrity, but is totally unaware that Charles is a nonbeliever and is using her to learn a few tricks of the trade.

The séance does not go to plan, and has the

unfortunate outcome that Charles' first wife Elvira (June Tretheway), crosses over from the other side. Needless to say, his current wife Ruth is not impressed at having Charles' previous wife in the house, particularly as a ghost that only Charles can see and hear. Ruth already has her hands full running the household and trying to train the new maid Edith (Bec Mundell), so when Charles comments that he thinks the three of them should be able to have a jolly good time, Ruth does not take the news well and accuses him of wanting to be an astral bigamist. Elvira on the other hand is watching on enjoying every moment but then she too decides that Charles should be attending to her needs rather than Ruth's.

With two angry wives to deal with, Charles finds himself in a very difficult situation. Difficult for him, but very humorous for us.

# **Coward is both an extreme joy and great challenge**,"

says director Marcus Thomas. "He always saw life as a frivolous exercise and brought this attitude, along with his great wit and insight, into his plays. The dialogue is so rich and well constructed that, while his characters appear superficial on the surface, there are indeed many layers to be explored".

The play might be 75 years old but the subject matter and humour remain ageless.

# Markets from the heart

Relax and soak up a feeling of community while grabbing a bargain at the Redcliffe Showgrounds Markets held every Sunday morning.

Run by the Kippa-Ring Lions Club, the earlymorning markets aim to provide a social, budgetfriendly place for locals to meet and shop.

Lions Club public officer Ken Leonard says market-goers can enjoy breakfast at the Lions' catering van then browse the stalls. Stalls include fresh fruit and vegetables, plants, clothing, tools and hardware, jewellery and handmade arts and crafts and more.

"The basic premise of the market is to enable local residents to buy and sell items of day to day need at realistic prices," Ken says.

"Our clientele are young families through to elderly couples with grandchildren, single families through to pensioners seeking day to day needs for their families, rather than tourist items."

The markets have been an institution on the peninsula for decades, held at various sites before settling at the showgrounds.

In 1996 the markets were at the Kippa-Ring Shopping Centre. From 2003 to 2005, they operated at Kippa-Ring State School. In 2005 they moved to the carpark of the Redcliffe Leagues Club. In 2007 they moved to the Redcliffe Showgrounds.

Keeping with the community spirit, stallholders only pay \$8 a week for a site and each week a different charity collects a small entry fee from visitors, Ken says.

"Our patrons willingly pay the entry cost of 20 cents per adult because of the market's quality and the fact that a local charity is collecting the entry fee," Ken says.

All market profits raised by the Lions Club also go to local charities and other worthwhile causes, Ken says.

"We are a true not-for-profit service organisation dedicated to serving our community without financial gain," Ken says.

"Together our programmes have donated approximately \$1 million to the local community in the past nine years."

The markets are held at the Redcliffe Showgrounds every Sunday between 6am-11am. Entertainers and new stallholders are welcome. Phone 0418 191 578 or email redcliffe-kippa-ring@ lionsq3.org.au.

### Join the circus and have fun while raising money for the Cancer Council at this year's Redcliffe Relay For Life.

Redcliffe Relay For Life will be held on May 28-29 at the Mary Nairn Fields and organisers are encouraging locals to embrace a circus theme.

Cancer Council Queensland spokeswoman Katie Clift encouraged Peninsula residents to get their registrations in quick to be part in the relay.

Relay teams are also invited to brighten up their campsites with decorations to be in the running for a prize, Katie says.

"By taking part you can help us create hope for cancer survivors, hope for those who have lost loved ones, and hope for a cancer-free future," she says

"More than 26,000 Queenslanders are diagnosed with cancer each year. Join us and help make a difference."

Katie says the whole Redcliffe community is invited to get behind the relay. Those not in a team can come along, cheer on the teams and enjoy the food, entertainment and activities.

# Wellness on the menu

### You'll be amazed at the healthy foodie treasures you can find Under the Verandah at Redcliffe.

Set against a backdrop of pre-loved books, the café provides organic, raw, gluten free, vegetarian and vegan food, as well as specialty tea and coffee varieties.

A former intelligence officer with the Australian Army, new owner Lesley Beshaw says her acquisition of the café over Easter this year came from her own love of the quaint, quirky space.

"I've loved the café since I discovered it almost two years ago when the business was quite new," she says.

"I loved the energy, the food and obviously the books, so when the previous owner mentioned she wanted to sell around October 2015, I thought 'why not?'

"The thought of working in what I feel is 'healing space' was so appealing."

The new business opportunity also resonated on a personal level with Lesley, as it followed a long series of her own health battles with thyroid cancer and coeliac disease.

"I have spent may years trying to 'fix' myself and have had a lot of time to read, research and speak to many doctors and health practitioners," she says.

"After trying many 'eating styles' I have



experienced the impact food has on day-to-day life and in the long term - each change to my diet resulted in a big difference to how I felt.

# How's the BBBC Tracking?


Many may be unaware that in late 2014, the Woody Point local's lawn bowls club, the Bramble Bay Bowls Club (BBBC), was "looking down a black hole and to closing the doors within 3 weeks". However, as Hazel Richardson. marketing, events and functions manager of the BBBC notes, "the new board and management (which took over in September 2014) made changes to the structure of staff, putting key people in roles to push the club forward to where we are today...reducing our debts from over \$440,000 to \$170,000 in just one year". According to Hazel, those role changes, plus generous support from the community, including Koliana Winchester, Our Village, the Art Union and many volunteers, made it possible for the BBBC to "keep its doors open and continue trading".

Those looking for further details about BBBC's financial struggle should peruse the notice board opposite the bar. Though the struggle is far from over, staff and management seem positive that 2016 will see the BBBC flourish as not only the 'locals' bowls club, but also as a quality entertainment, restaurant and function venue.

As to the present... The BBBC overlooks the Woody Point seashore, being located on the corner of Hornibrook Esplanade and Victoria Avenue, Woody Point, on the Redcliffe Peninsula.

Lawn Bowls: Presently, the BBBC is home to the Bramble Bay Vikings, formed of competitive players as young as 18 years. Hazel notes, "the Premier 7's finals are coming up on the first and second weekend of April at the BBBC". The United Services Bowls Club and Waterloo Bowls Clubs also use the precinct to play socially on Fridays and Sundays (respectively). Recently the BBBC partnered with Norths Cue 8 Ball Pool offering over 18 Pool tables, and supporting a Junior Program and various tournaments.

However, it is the BBBC's social barefoot bowls functions that seem to be all the rave.



The pristine grass, reasonable equipment hire fee and variety of food and drinks make for an excellent afternoon on the green. According to Hazel, "social barefoot bowls are growing to be very popular for business events".

**Bistro:** Presently the BBBC Bistro hosts a smorgasbord of good old pub cuisine. However Hazel excitedly told the 'Redcliffe Guide' that change is in the air. A new Chinese menu was released at the end of March 2016. The chefs are preparing for the grand opening of the new Bistro in mid-late April 2016. Take away and delivery services will be offered soon. Watch this space!

**Other Events:** As well as offering barefoot bowls event functions, the BBBC management provide an excellent space for private functions. The BBBC also hosts weekly events, including Tuesday Trivia and Saturday Karaoke both beginning at 7pm.

All in all, as they say, 'when the going get's tough, the tough get going'. The BBBC staff and management have done exactly that. Hazel's last words were, "we will keep making changes to facilitate the Redcliffe Community and bring back the BBBC to where it was many years ago".

# Lookout for Settlement Cove Facelift

Redcliffe residents and visitors to the region will benefit from an upgrade to Settlement Cove Point, near the Redcliffe Surf Club, as part of a jointly funded State Government and Moreton Bay Regional Council initiative.

The improvements will include re-using existing shelter structures, new concrete pavements, sandstone seating blocks, garden beds and edging, landscaping, information and interpretive signage, and a new coloured concrete lookout area.

State Member for Redcliffe, Yvette D'Ath said that she was pleased that Council's application for funding under the State Governments Scenic Lookout Upgrade Program had been successful.

Almost \$93,000 will be invested in the Settlement Point upgrade funded on a 50:50 basis in partnership with the local council.

We are lucky to live in such a beautiful part of the world and we must invest in projects that harness and add value to the local aesthetic," Cr Winchester said.

The Point is a popular feature in the foreshore between Suttons Beach and Charlish Park near the Redcliffe Jetty. The site is host to a range of renowned events including the Redcliffe Festival and Festival of Sails. # Shoppers In for Clearer origin labeling **Food Labelling**

Local shoppers will start to see new labels pop up on food products from July, following an agreement on Country of Origin food labelling reforms.

Federal Member for Petrie, Luke Howarth MP, said the Commonwealth Government's agreement with the states and territories has come after decades of frustration.

"For years, consumers have had to put up with misleading and confusing food labels.

"This new system will provide the clarity shoppers deserve, importantly without imposing an excessive burden on businesses."

Many foods found on Australian retail shelves

will be required to include a kangaroo in a triangle logo to indicate if the food is made, produced or grown in Australia.

The new system will also include a bar chart indicating the proportion of Australian inaredients.

Kippa-Ring local Kaye Devine welcomed the changes.

"It is important that consumers will be able to make better informed choices with this new labelling," she said.

The reforms will be introduced from 1 July, with labels expected to appear in retail outlets later this year. Businesses will get two years to transition to the new labelling system.

# Look Out For Zonta

For most of us, our home is our castle. It's where we rule, where we feel the safest and for those living with friends or family, it's where we know we'll find support.

But for too many, home is prison.

Already this year, 19 women have died as a result of domestic violence, with Kippa-Ring mum Sandra Peniamina one of the latest victims.

May is Domestic and Family Violence Prevention Month - an annual initiative to raise awareness of domestic and family violence in Queensland.

The message is clear, says Zonta Club of Redcliffe member Lisa Allison, domestic and family abuse is not be tolerated in our communities.

"It's imperative that we're getting this message out there, but also that we ensure those who are experiencing domestic abuse know where to find support."

Zonta Redcliffe will again partner with the Redcliffe Dolphins for the annual 'sea of orange' match, which will see players wear orange socks during their home game on 29 May.

"Look out for the Zonta marquee at the game; we'll be giving away Youth and Adult Safety cards and merchandise such as footballs and wristbands to highlight Domestic and Family violence issues.'

Last year 's event saw around \$3,000 donated to Zonta by local Federal Member Luke Howarth MP, following a High Tea fundraiser with guest speaker. Minister for Women the Hon. Michaelia Cash.

"The event was a huge success and we are hoping to reach more members of the public this year and encourage them to show their support by turning up for the game," says Lisa.

"It is only through community awareness and support that attitudes towards Family Violence - and indeed all forms of violence - will change."

Other local programs include Encircle Redcliffe's family support and counselling, and the Redcliffe PCYC's up-coming RUBY (Rise Up Be Yourself) program for women who have been or are currently affected by Domestic Violence.

# Fly High with Redcliffe Kite Club



"There's really something for everyone in the kite flying community. Whether you're interested in single line, two line stunt kites or precision flying, everyone can join in," says Crowley.



# Crime Stoppers urges Redcliffe residents to Dob In A Dealer

Time is up for drug dealers in Redcliffe, with Crime Stoppers calling on local residents to report information about those manufacturing and distributing crystal methylamphetamine ('ICE') and other illicit drugs.

In the last six months of 2015 Crime Stoppers received almost 30 'ICE' related reports per month. The organisation is asking the Redcliffe community over the next two weeks to support the *Dob in a Dealer* campaign which aims to gather information about local drug dealing activity.

The Crime Stoppers *Dob in a Dealer* program is being rolled out across Australia to aid in the detection and disruption of drugs harming local communities.

Residents are urged to contact Crime Stoppers to anonymously report any information relating to people who may be bringing harmful drugs into the local community.

"We know that drugs like ICE or

methylamphetamines are of serious concern to the community," Crime Stoppers Chief Executive Officer Mr Trevor O'Hara said. The community is well aware of the devastating effects of ICE so we are asking all residents to help ut a stop to the flow of drugs.

Halting the spread of ICE requires a whole-ofcommunity response and Dob in a Dealer is specifically aimed at stopping the manufacture and supply of drugs.

"Crime Stoppers is committed to working with the Queensland Police Service, the media and local residents to gather anonymous information that can help to reduce drug supply and drug related crimes and help keep the community safe," Mr O'Hara said.

"Local residents often hold the key to information that can help solve and prevent crime. We are asking residents in Redcliffe to play an active role and report those people that are bringing harmful drugs into the region.

"Making a report to Crime Stoppers is completely anonymous. Information providers will never be identified or called to a court case, but every piece of information provided can help solve crimes and reduce the supply of drugs."

Crime Stoppers is a registered charity and community volunteer organisation, helping to keep families and communities safe. We work closely with police and media to receive valuable information from the public which helps to stop, solve and prevent crime. **ADVERTISEMENT**

# Tides Turning for HMQS Gayundah

### It took a mutiny, many voyages and seven decades at sea before the HMQS Gayundah was permanently scuttled off Woody Point.

But as the world premiere of *Mutiny on the Gayundah* reached its climax last month, there was heaviness about the audience.

Was this to be the gunship's final scene? Are the old girl's days really numbered?

The film's producer and star, Culture Vulture Richard Lancaster, is confident they won't be – Despite the suspicious collapse of the ship's bow on 28 March.

"The damage is quite severe and now the bow will crumble very quickly," Mr Lancaster said.

"However we are very confident about the probability of preserving the wreck for another 50-60 years."

Mr Lancaster has been working with Clontarf businessman and industrial chemist Barry

Richards to find a way to preserve the ship.

"We found a product that can protect the ship from rusting further, and we are in discussion with the Heritage and Marine Parks departments about going ahead with this plan."

Once the flagship of the Queensland Navy, the Gayundah drew Mr Richards' attention – even before he started fighting for the ship's restoration.

"I'm a jogger and I'd been running past the wreck for many years, always thinking to myself that we've got to preserve this incredible local landmark" Mr Richards said.

A specialist in surface coatings, Mr Richards has suggested the use of rust-proofing product, *Rust Conqueror,* which is manufactured by Australian owned company, Xtroll Global.


The company owner, Steve Ashworth, has since jumped on board to support the project.

Mr Richards said the good news "is that, in principal, we have approval to do some trial preservation".

Mr Richards estimates the preservation process would cost \$10,000, including preparation and cleaning, careful handling and relocation of marine life, structural bracing and rust stabilisation.

"We want to make sure the Gayundah is here for future generations to admire," he said.

# From Millie with love

The quiet road to the Hornibrook ambles past tufts of long green grass swaying in the Peninsula breeze. A blue sky with a single, perfect cloud frames the banksias that bend slightly in the gentle southerly that skips across the coast.

The place is silent, except for the sound of small white peaks rolling into the foreshore and the sand is just begging for a fisherman's footprints and a subtle seaside nap.

It describes perfectly a dreamy Peninsula day and it's all captured in the simple, exquisite beauty of Millie Clarke's brushstrokes.

The late artist honed her craft on the Peninsula during the '60s, prolifically producing a series of artworks that transported the Hornibrook, the headland and other landscapes from her painterly palette to the canvas.

Her paintings lined the walls along what was once Clark Arcade – now the Jetty Arcade – and her brother Robert says Millie and her husband Cecil's story is as gentle and bucolic as her depictions of the Peninsula's land and seascapes. They lived upstairs and overlooked the sea from the apartment in the front of the arcade, which looked down at the jetty."

Robert recalls, "Her husband Cecil, he was a great bowler and he won several bowls championships. They loved living there, loved the people and generally it was a lovely place to live.

"When they moved there, Cecil built the merrygo-round and put it on the esplanade, and the American sailors used to come over on the boats from the mainland to buy a dozen tickets, give them to the girls, and he made a bit of money out of that. That was in 1943-44."

The description of their quiet lives on the Peninsula translates perfectly to the palette, with her paintings putting the viewer firmly in the picture – you can almost feel the bay's breeze brush past your cheek.

This painting now hangs in her nephew Paul's home, and he says it takes pride of place and is a reminder about his family's past on the Peninsula.

"In the arcade, as you walked in on the right hand side she had a glass showcase all down the right side with over 100 paintings," Paul says.

"She used to sell them at quite a good price, sold quite a lot of them.

"This one takes pride of place in our lounge room. It's a beautiful reminder."

# BUILDING YOUR 'HOME SWEET HOME'

Building a new home can be an exciting time. It's the one time we get to make a decision about where we want to live, how big our house will be and how the house will look, inside and out, plus much more. However, it can also be a stressful and time-consuming experience. Knowing where to start and what to expect goes a long way to achieving the house of your dreams. We've put together some important tips to help with starting a new building project.

1) Know about the land you're building on, whether you're buying a vacant lot or knocking down and existing house and rebuilding. Before approaching a builder, know what your land size is, how your local council has coded your block and if there are any overlays, and the physical aspects of the block. Ask for recommendations from family and friends as they will likely give you honest advice and won't recommend a builder who hasn't provided a favourable experience. Also visit websites such as www.qbcc.qld.gov.au to view if a builder is licenced, and www.productreview.com.au for consumer reviews. Also check to see if they are insured with either Master Builders or HIA. Whether you choose a project home builder or custom design builder, research what other's experiences have been.

All in all, do your research. Know what floor plan and design you are happy with, as well as what features you want in your house prior to beginning negotiations with a builder. Doing this and following the tips should put you in a prime position for a happy and exciting building experience.
