

Quota International of Redcliffe is holding their annual Redcliffe Craft and Gift Fair on Saturday 2nd July at the Redcliffe Showgrounds' Webb Hall. Proceeds from this year's Fair are going to Hummingbird House, the only children's hospice in Queensland.

Quota International is a not-for-profit organisation well known for supporting and empowering women and children throughout the world. Founded in 1919, Quota International is one of the world's longest running international service organisations for women and thrives today with more than 5,600 members. The organisation has been changing lives in 269 communities in 12 countries all over the world.

The Show awed, inspired and brought locals together. And indeed the strength of the Redcliffe community has only amplified in the years since – despite the growing population and rezoning of local Council boundaries.

Of course we're not a farming community anymore, but today's Redcliffe Show is still one of the most anticipated events on the Redcliffe calendar

#### WHAT'S ON OFFER?

Those fortunate enough to have wandered the Show's tents and alleyways before will be familiar with the monster fireworks and the crowds at Wood Chopping Championships.

This year's Show will again feature the traditional favourites – a V8 Ute Challenge, freestyle motocross and show jumping.

Friday is the Show's 'People's Day'. Highlights of the day are bound to be the Championship Dog Show (9am), pig racing (from 1pm), and the Trackskill V8 Ute Challenge (5pm).



# Pat-BikeShow

It's a celebration of military service, the work of Legacy Brisbane, and diehard ink – and it's coming to the Redcliffe Show Grounds this month.

The Moreton Bay chapter of Patriots Australia – a Motorcycle Club for regular, reserve and ex-serving members of the Defence Force – is hosting a Redcliffe Tattoo Show.

Patriots Moreton Bay Sergeant At Arms, Adam McGuire, said the show will be a "family affair, with under 18's welcome".

"There'll be cars and bikes on show, a Pin Up Girl competition, live music, rock and roll dancers ... and a licensed bar!

It's a very cheap day out. If you wish to stay and kick on for the night, live music will be going 'til midnight, and you can camp over night at the grounds."

Registrations for the Pin Up Girl contest start at 11am, with judging from 2pm.

For those unfamiliar, the term *pin up* refers to a photographic or illustration style that is printed and meant to be pinned up on a wall.

Originating at the start of the 20th century, the style became very popular during World War II as millions of young men spent weeks and months away from their sweethearts and longed for an escape.

The Pin Up Girl has become part of modern pop culture and endures to this day.



But of course, the Redcliffe Tattoo Show is all about Legacy Brisbane, with money raised from the raffles and tattoo competition on the day to be donated to this incredible charity.

"Legacy assists military families who have lost family members and those who are struggling after separation from the defence," said Adam.

"I have personally had assistance from Legacy; they are a very welcome support when really needed."

Brisbane Legacy currently cares for more than 8,000 widows and 250 dependants. Established in 1928, the organisation is helping 90,000 widows and 1,900 children and disabled dependants throughout Australia.

# LEGENDARYMOSS IN FINE TUNE

The last time Australian rock legend lan Moss was on stage on the Peninsula,

it was in front of thousands of music fans as his trademark riffs rang out across the Decades Festival in October last year.

The guitarist and sometimes-vocalist for Aussie pub-rock legends Cold Chisel is revered in equal parts for both his incredible guitar stylings and his truly iconic song writing, the latter of which has made him a five-time ARIA Award winner as a solo artist.

In stark contrast to rocking out in front thousands of raging Chisel fans screaming for hits such as *Khe Sanh* and *Cheap Wine*, Moss will now take to the stage at the Redcliffe Cultural Centre on June 18 in solo mode to deliver an intimate performance of his much-loved 2005 album, *Six Strings*.

That album, recorded with just Moss' inimitable voice, an acoustic guitar and a few microphones, and packed to the brim with Chisel classics, solo gems, a couple of covers and some newly written tracks, has become part of the lexicon of classic Australian music reborn for new and diehard fans alike.


lan says he will remain faithful to what's on Six Strings, with some exciting additions.

I'm really looking forward to heading back to Redcliffe and introducing four or five new songs to my fans," he says.

Moss says being disarmed of his electric guitar and facing smaller audiences with just him, his voice and an acoustic takes him back to the roots of why artists make music.

"I'm fortunate enough to have a great catalogue of songs to choose from and the thing is, if you've got great songs with great lyrics, that's





all you need," he says.

"That's how every song ever written began one guy with the guitar or one guy on a piano or maybe one guy hearing and writing it all in their head.

"Being on your own up there you are a whole lot more exposed and vulnerable and I used to fear that — now I embrace the holes and the space.

"They speak as loudly as the music does and I love the challenge"

But it wasn't always an easy proposition for seasoned music veteran, who says putting down the electric guitar and taking a more stripped-back approach is a massive challenge for any musician.

"Only once in a blue moon would I try doing a solo show in the old days, and that was with an electric guitar," he says.

"I thought it would be easy, but it wasn't. You have to reappraise the whole thing, play differently, change your solo style. You have to go back to the song, look at what the lyrics are about, find a new way to express them.

"It's a real challenge, but a rewarding one."



# Annual Exhibition to Sweep Local Foreshore

Tides come and go at Deception Bay, as do the foreshore's daily visitors and the area's many community events.

"We are always very careful to leave the beach tidier than we found it, and the close homes are very tolerant of the work, noise, and the sunny chaos of the event."


Members of the community are invited to interact with the artworks and join the Carte Blanche team in conversation about conserving our local environment.

"Artworks can be anything ... from a big raft that the Deception Bay [Girls Guides] made two years ago, to lots of small items such as little jelly fish shapes from parts of milk bottles."





# 2016 TAX PLAN **STRATEGIES**

The end of the financial year is fast approaching. Below is a list of important strategies to consider for small businesses to reduce their tax bill.

Superannuation – Maximising the amount that you put into your superannuation is a well known strategy to reduce taxable income. Contributions are taxed at 15% in the fund. The maximum amount that you can put into superannuation is \$30,000 for people aged 18-49 for the 2015/16 and 2016/17 years. The limit is \$35,000 for those 50 and above. These caps move back to \$25,000 for all taxpayers effective 1st July 2017. Super guarantee is included in these caps. So do no exceed the limits as 49% tax could apply. Your Superfund must receive contribution by 30 June 2016 (Pay employees super by 30 June 2016 to get a tax deduction). Consider whether a Self Managed Super Fund (SMSF) is for you if you don't have one. Compulsory Super is 9.5% of Ordinary Times Earnings from 1st July 2014 fixed for 4 years.

Write-off items up to \$20,000 for Small Business with turnover less than \$2 million. An example is if your business needs to spend \$15,000 on a new computer server – then you may be able to write that off all at once. The turnover threshold should increase to \$10 million in 2016/17 financial year.

Spend on tools of trade (Fringe Benefits Tax) Exempt Items – Includes Handheld portable tools of trade, computer software, notebook laptops, electronic organisers, digital cameras, briefcases and mobile phones (All immediate write-offs for your employees).

**Defer Income** – Where practical, defer issuing further invoices and/or receiving cash / debtor payments until after 30 June 2016.

**Bring Forward Expenses** – Purchase all consumable items before the end of the financial year such as stationery. Consider repairs to items.

**Defer Capital Gains Tax (CGT).** If you're looking at selling a property in June 2016, defer contract date until after 1 July 2016. This buys you an extra year and more time to prepare for the planning of the capital gains tax situation.

**Ensure motor vehicle log books are upto-date.** Every 5 years this must be done. If the motor vehicle use has gone up, this is then highly worth considering.

Prepayment ideas – Consider prepaying something that will work tax effectively (up to 30 June 2017 period – 12 months). For example, you could buy some shares and prepay the interest on the loan before 30 June 2016 for 12 months. Prepay rent for 12 months. Prepay travel expenses. Prepay subscriptions.

In Summary, consider all the above strategies where appropriate to reduce the taxable income for 2015/16. Talk to Tim of Confidential Tax & Business about how to get ready for the next financial year; Trust Resolutions for Discretionary Trusts; Review Budget Changes; Review changes to Superannuation. And if you are employing staff, make sure you are super stream compliant.


