Father's Day on the Peninsula is set to hit all the right notes this year with the huge Scarborough Sounds event returning for its second year as part of the Redcliffe Festival.

Last year's inaugural event drew more than 5000 punters out for an afternoon of music, food and fun, so the decision was made to keep it as a regular addition to the Redcliffe Festival calendar.

"Scarborough Sounds was created to offer amazing musical acts in a park setting on Father's Day," Moreton Bay Region Industry and Tourism chief executive Shane

Newcombe says.



"In 2015 the event reached capacity, so 2016 has seen the event site expanded and entertainment increased to accommodate for growing numbers.

"It offers visitors and locals a free event to spend a quality afternoon and evening with

family and friends enjoying music and a picnic in the park."

Also, Newcombe says with an expanded site comes a bigger and better line-up of bands and entertainment.

Audiences can expect to enjoy some of the best live music around," he says.

"This year we have the Hot Potato Band playing – the 11-piece brass band, fresh from their acclaimed shows at Woodford Folk Festival 2015 and one of Australia's most toured music groups.

"The main stage will also have Parasol featuring Frankie Smart, Thomas Armstrong-Robley & Suited to You, and Soulstice – an incredible a capella group.

"Alongside the bands, families can enjoy gourmet picnic food and markets, wine, and a huge bonfire on the beach.

Best of all, Scarborough Sounds is a free event, which should put an even bigger smile on all the dads' faces.

"The event is intentionally held on Father's Day so families, both local and visiting, will thoroughly enjoy Scarborough Sounds," Newcombe says.

Goes Tropicale

The iconic Redcliffe Jetty will play host to its namesake celebration this month, with the Redcliffe Festival's Jetty Fiesta set to bring the pier to life on Saturday 10th September.

Held on the final weekend of the Redcliffe Festival, the family-friendly street party boasts a variety of entertainment including stage shows, roving performers and musical guests, climaxing with the biggest fireworks display in the Moreton Bay Region.

CEO of Moreton Bay Region Industry & Tourism Shane Newcombe says the Redcliffe Festival was experiencing great success, but the plan was to make it even bigger.

"We wanted to continue activating different areas of the Peninsula to showcase to visitors, he says.

"Jetty Fiesta was conceived to deliver yet another free event aimed at bringing Redcliffe Parade to life with a fantastic family-friendly street party.

"It's just great to see the local community and region visitors get behind this event - last year we had so many happy faces wandering Redcliffe Parade."

Shane says there are a lot of festive inclusions this year, all showcasing a spectacular island theme.

"Highlighting island culture and entertainment, there will be an exciting fire and drumming show, Heilani dancers and the Macaw Bird Pop Up Experience, where guests can have photos taken with the exotic birds," he says.



Also, the fireworks will, for the first time, span the length of the entire jetty – a very exciting prospect."

Shane says the Bay of Boats is another new initiative this year.

"We are inviting boat owners to drop anchor in the water and experience the fireworks from the best seat in town," he says. "We want boat owners to dress their vessels in fairy and solar lights to light up the bay - it will look amazing from the shore."

One of the highlights of the event is the Saturday evening fireworks and laser show.

"The Jetty Fiesta fireworks have built up a bit of a reputation and received a great reception in 2015," Shane says.

"The jet ski fireworks were particularly popular last year, so they are back again this year, and we've also added a few extra treats to ensure this year's fireworks outdo last years."

This year the Redcliffe Golf Club is hosting the State Special Olympics golfing section. On 11 September, the Club, Special Olympics Australia and Queensland Amputee Association will be teaming up to host the inclusion event.

Special Olympics Australia supports individuals with an intellectual disability to achieve their personal best through sports training and regular competitions throughout Australia.

The Redcliffe Golf Club hosts the annual Queensland Special Olympics golf event and has done so since 2003, along with running a disability golf program since 2001.

The annual Special Olympics sees competitors from all over Queensland and Northern New South Wales play at the Club. Special Olympics athletes are partnered with junior athletes who train at the Redcliffe Golf Club.

"This is a fully inclusive event run every year by the Redcliffe Golf Club," says Brendan Monaghan, Head Coach. "Pairing the athletes breaks down barriers and allows our athletes to participate. None of it would be possible without the support of the Redcliffe Golf Club and the professionals there," says Monaghan.

The event includes: 18 holes – Single Stableford open to participants with a disability with an official golf Australia handicap with strokes counted for each hole instead of counting the total number of strokes taken in the game for \$30; 8 holes – four person Ambrose open to participants with a disability and the parents, carer or family member for \$20. There will also be a free clinic available for anyone to come along and join in. The event cost includes a sausage sizzle and a soft drink.

This is a well attended event," says Trainee Golf Professional Laura McCahon, who made her way through the Redcliffe Golf Club's junior programme to train professionally. "We look forward to seeing lots of people there as spectators or participating in the clinic," McCahon says.

If you love a bit of history and you'd like to take a walk down memory lane, look no further than Redcliffe Remembers.

This nostalgic event will close the two week long Redcliffe Festival on Sunday 11th September, celebrating the richness of Redcliffe's past. The foreshore area will be transformed to honour and celebrate the iconic people and places from past and present.

The event will begin with a re-enactment of the first landing in Redcliffe on the beach, followed by the Gubbi Gubbi people providing the indigenous welcome.

Redcliffe Remembers is a celebration of the Redcliffe Peninsula as the location of the first European settlement in Queensland,"

explains Luke Richter-Steers, Marketing and Media Manager of the Redcliffe Festival.

Stage entertainment will delight festival goers with performances from Little Stevie and the Tail

Fins, acoustic Celtic band The Life of Reilly, the Redcliffe Scottish Pipe Band, Moreton Celtic Fiddle Club, The Lovely-Daze, and The Brief Divide. Take a break from the festivities while enjoying these talented performers.

Wander through the various food and market stalls, listen to the beautiful sounds of the guitar, harmonica, percussion, flute, didgeridoos, accordion, and the tuba of the street performers and buskers. The markets will be even bigger than usual and will offer food, drinks and specialty stalls. If you're after something more bespoke head to Picnic Park, the home of Handmade Market Lane where you can find local, indie craft.

If historic cars are more your thing, Redcliffe Parade will have over 100 custom and classic cars on display. If you'd rather be driving, enter one of the Billy Cart Races at Charlish Park for some fun. A recreated Penny Arcade with a modern twist, a vintage High Tea, and Historical Guided walk will also be happening throughout the day. "The High Tea hosted by History Redcliffe is a new addition to the program this year and is an attraction we anticipate to be hugely popular," says Luke.

I am pleased to advise that the intersection of Victoria Avenue and King Street Woody Point will be upgraded to incorporate traffic signals. As Divisional Councillor, I have advocated for a long time based on safety concerns raised by residents, for the installation of

traffic lights at this location.

Council has received part-funding to undertake safety improvements at this intersection from the Australian Federal Government Black Spot Programme. The remaining funds required for the construction of works have been included in the 2016/17 Council budget.

Through these works, Council aims to improve safety for all transport users; increase intersection capacity and reduce delays for motorists; ensure continued efficient intersection operation for road users into the future; renew the road pavements and stormwater drainage to provide an improved road corridor; and improve access for all transport users, including cyclists and pedestrians.

Construction is planned to start late 2016 and continue into 2017 with as much work as possible undertaken during the school holidays. To reduce the impact on traffic and to minimise construction time, council is considering a complete intersection closure with signed detour routes for through traffic. Local and property access will be maintained though this period.

It's an exciting time for residents as the Moreton Bay Rail Link nears completion.

Final steps include linking the MBRL signalling system with

the existing rail network. This work will include temporarily closing the Caboolture rail line from 9pm on Friday 16 September until 2am on Friday 23 September 2016. This work is necessary to ensure safe, high-quality infrastructure and service reliability when the Moreton Bay Rail Line opens.

A comprehensive service plan has been developed to limit the inconvenience for customers with buses replacing trains along the rail corridor and additional train services along the Shorncliffe line. Temporary timetables will be available, along with widespread advertising, signage, online notices and on-board and station announcements. I encourage regular Caboolture line commuters to take note of this substantial closure and have alternative options in place where possible. We live in a beautiful part of the world and the month of September means spring is here with its warmer weather.

I am pleased to have been able to secure \$100,000 for local community groups to install rooftop and hot water solar systems. Reducing

overhead costs for local community groups means money can be spent in our community allowing the groups to focus on what really matters.

One of the many groups that is benefiting from solar installations is The Endeavour Foundation in Kippa-Ring. The Endeavour Foundation provides intensive specialised education, training, and supported employment to 61 individuals with disabilities.

Other community groups that have shared in this \$100,000 include the Redcliffe Senior Citizens, Lions Recycle for Sight Australia, Encircle, Ridge Hills Football Club, Deception Bay Soccer Club, Bracken Ridge and Bald Hills Scouts and Aspley Memorial Bowls Club.

Local households will not miss out either as the Coalition is committed to tackling climate change without a jobs-destroying carbon tax. The Australian Government's Renewable Energy Target provides for an average rebate for a solar system of \$3000, or about 30 per cent of the installation cost.

Redcliffe based Anne Moore has enjoyed the Older and Bolder program for five years. "I love to look through the activity book to see what sorts of activities are on offer." she said.







For Moreton Bay Rail Link connection

Following approval from Queensland Rail and the Department of Transport and Main Roads, the next critical step to commission the historic Moreton Bay Rail Link project has been given the green light to proceed.

Minister for Transport Stirling Hinchliffe said Queensland Rail and the Department of Transport had resolved concerns with the signalling system and determined it is now reliable and safe to commence the final step in linking the signalling system with the existing rail network.

Mr Hinchliffe said preparations were now underway to support a rail line closure on the Caboolture line between Zillmere and Caboolture from 9pm on Friday 16 September until 2am on Friday 23 September 2016.

"To connect this line we will need to close the Caboolture line for six days which will be one of the largest rail line closures to ever take place in South East Queensland." Mr Hinchliffe said.

Mr Hinchliffe said the Project Team had deliberately chosen a date during the school holiday period to minimise the impact on commuters.

We are planning to mobilise more than 200 buses to accommodate affected passengers to ensure everyone can get to their destination.

Alternate bus replacement services will be available between Zillmere and Caboolture, for passengers during the closure with bus interchanges to be located at Elimbah, Caboolture and Boondall stations.

During peak period buses will be 'turn up and go' with express buses available from each station to Boondall station and buses stopping at all stations for intermediate travel.

During off-peak buses will run at 15 minute frequencies with buses running express and stopping at all stations.

Additional train services will also operate along the Shorncliffe line with frequency increased from 15 minutes to 7minutes 30 seconds during peak and increased from 30 minutes to 15 minutes off-peak.

"We know this is a major inconvenience to Caboolture and Sunshine Coast line passengers but I cannot stress enough how important this work is to enable the Moreton Bay rail line to open," Mr Hinchliffe said.



My name is Maya. I am 11 years old. I have had a really busy 11 years spending a lot of time in hospital. I have a syndrome called Velo Cardio Facial Syndrome. It means I am missing part of my 22 chromosome pair in my genetic makeup. Sadly the tiny bit missing has meant I have a lot of medical conditions and disabilities. I need oxygen tubes to help me breath. I need a tube to feed me and a special long term central line drip in my chest so mummy can give me continuous medications and nutrition via my drip.
