In 2016, Scarborough Lights welcomed Moreton Bay Region Industry and Tourism to Scarborough and they have now taken over the organisation of the annual Scarborough Christmas Carols. Scarborough Lights simply enhance this community Christmas spirit. "The trees and lights bring people to the Peninsula right throughout the Christmas season," Sue says. **Overflowing with Christmas cheer** and community spirit, Scarborough will light up for the festive season.

In a few weeks, preparations for the lights will begin. "We will be calling out for volunteers to help set them up and decorate them once they're out, and we welcome any help," Sue explains.

Although a small group is responsible for organising the event, it could not proceed without the ongoing support of volunteers, local businesses, sponsors and the Moreton Bay Regional Council.



All characters are available for free photos with children, who will also receive a small bag of Iollies.

Supporting the Starlight Foundation, the Christmas fairies will be selling star wands. Last year, over 500 wands were sold for the organisation. With over 200 children visiting Santa at the Beach House on Christmas Eve last year, they expect to see even more in 2016. 

Play Safe on the Bay

With so many people enjoying the benefits of warmer weather, Redcliffe is expecting to see lots of vessels out on the water in the coming months. While it's a great way to see the Bay, explore the area, and perhaps spot a dolphin or two, it's important to remember to stay safe on the water.

Last year Sutton's Beach made it into Queensland's list of top 10 beaches. With over 93,000 fans of Sutton's Beach, it's no wonder so many locals and tourists are itching to get back out on the water with the weather warming up for Spring. The Royal Life Saving Society Queensland suggests everyone on board should wear a personal floatation device (life jacket), carry emergency equipment to monitor the weather, and follow boating traffic rules.

Boat and jetski license trainer Col Reeve has a wealth of experience on the water and offers online courses in boating and jetski licensing. With a lifelong dream to teach proper boating and personal watercraft safety, Col and his wife Claire began a business to do just that. Having seen plenty of accidents resulting from people not knowing what they're doing on the water, Col's passion to ensure locals and tourists alike will be safe in our bay has come to life.

It's such a beautiful place for boating and marine activity," says Claire. "We think it's important to ensure everyone has the right skills and the right knowledge to make sure they're safe out there."

And in case of

The Boatsafe Recreation Marine Driver Licence or Boat Licence course includes theory and practical on-water instruction. During the boat licence course, attendees are involved in group exercises, which include checking vessel safety equipment and whether the vessel is seaworthy.

Online licence training is approved by the Department of Transport and Main Roads and is a new and innovative approach to licence training, allowing flexibility for attendees. Col's training also includes pre-course study, comprising of about 40 minutes reading with short videos and questions for self-testing to make sure you are on the right track. Col encourages attendees to take some time out before attending the boat licence course to complete the pre-course study to make the written assessment easier on the day.




"The community here is just so vital for us and we're loving just talking to them and serving them some really generous, high-quality food," says co-owner Glenn Hendricks.



COMPUTER SKILLS FOR ALL

Kids these days seem to learn how to use computers from the cradle.

It's no longer uncommon to see a toddler in a stroller happily playing a game on a tablet, and school children cheerfully prepare slideshows using professional presentation software.

While most of us use computers regularly, there are still a lot of people who don't know how to use them, or who would like to know how to do things such as organise their photos or use Facebook, but don't know where to go to find out.

The Redcliffe Seniors Computer Club (RSCC) is a not-for-profit organisation, run by talented and caring volunteers, who offer one-on-one training to all members of the community over the age of 18.

All kinds of devices are catered for: smartphones (Android, Apple and Windows), tablets (iPads, Android and Windows), laptops (Windows and MacBook), and Apple and Windows desktop computers. Students can bring their own devices or use the club's equipment.

Whether it's carefully going through the absolute basics or developing more advanced skills, such as spreadsheets or desktop publishing, RSCC has tutors who can help in a friendly, social atmosphere.

What really sets RSCC apart, is that its classes are not structured and do not follow a strict curriculum.

Rather, all training, apart from occasional workshops on particular topics, is one-on-one, tailored to each member's particular needs.

The club's premises are conveniently located in the Bellevue Park Community Hall, in Sportsground Street, Redcliffe, and classes are held every day from Monday to Friday.

Volunteers are also able to make home visits to help solve problems with desktop computers and give advice on equipment issues.

RSCC offers a range of computer equipment, such as USB flash drives, memory card readers, USB hubs and other small items for sale at reasonable prices, as well as new laptops and printers. The club will fully personalise a new laptop for the member and present it "ready to go".

Anyone thinking of buying a new computer or computer equipment is welcome to discuss their needs with the club's experts.

Although it does not offer formal qualifications, RSCC, as an approved training centre for Centrelink clients, is able to offer training and support to members seeking to re-enter the workforce.

Whether it's using email, setting up an account on social media, shopping safely online, coming to grips with a new or updated operating system, or understanding how to make the most of "the Cloud", RSCC can help.

As part of a Skilled Queenslanders for Work program run at the Redcliffe Area Youth Space (RAYS), 14 young people aged 16 to 23 are putting their new skills to good use by creating a community garden beside Encircle Neighbourhood Centre.

RAYS support worker Kelly Raedler says the youth are gaining valuable work experience while building a garden community members and local businesses can share.

"All these guys have an interest in the trade or building sector, and have benefited from the Certificate I they just completed," Kelly says.

"They are enjoying the opportunities and challenges of designing, planning and building the garden; doing everything from gardening to carpentry and concreting."

The new community garden on Lamington Drive will include a children's section, eight large garden beds at various heights for easy access and smaller garden beds for herbs.

She says they have already had interest from local businesses keen to run a plot in the garden to grow their own produce.

PLENTY OF FISH IN THE SEA

Recreational fishing in Redcliffe is set to receive a boost through the introduction of several net-free Fishing zones in Moreton Bay.

This will mean anyone who throws in a rod will have a much greater chance of getting a bite.

After the review of the Moreton Bay Marine Park in 2008, there was a significant loss of access to the recreational fishing sector. The net free areas in Moreton Bay will assist with redressing some of the impacts of this review, as well as the environmental issues brought about by localised depletion from gillnetting. This will hopefully mean the reversal of the destructive impacts on fish stocks and marine ecosystems that have been observed as a result of gillnetting.

At the end of last year, several net-free zones were established off Cairns, Mackay and the Capricorn Coast. By the end of this year, the impact of these zones will be clear, paving the way for similar projects in Moreton Bay.

Sunfish Moreton representative, Judy Lynn, says we can hope to see the restriction zones implemented as early as the beginning of next year.

Essentially Moreton Bay will be net free, while still allowing the four fisheries that function in the bay and supply some of the retail requirements of the south-east to remain largely unchanged," says Judy.

"There will be no impact at all on the trawl sector or the crab fishery, and the ocean beach mullet fishery will become a clean mullet fishery, meaning they will take no incidental catch."


Environmentally, the exclusion of gillnets from several zones will have huge advantages to the marine ecosystems of Moreton Bay. "Gillnets tend to catch everything unexclusively, whether it be a dolphin or a sea turtle," says Judy. "This is why it is important to limit the use of these nets".

Judy believes the opportunity of recreational fishing is an extremely important aspect of life in our area. The implementation of these restriction zones will mean there will be a plentiful supply and a ready catch for recreational fishers with all levels of experience.

FROM THE ARCHIVES...

In May 2014, Judy Henderson Place contacted the Redcliffe Museum for information about the rescue of her father, Dudley Henderson, by Ella Warbrick.


She and other family members came to the Redcliffe Museum to link up with Daphne Gibbs (whose mother was a Warbrick) and two members of the Historical Society to find out more. As a result, a very interesting story was uncovered...

In October 1903, the Henderson family was holidaying at a well-known family guest house at Woody Point, Cambridge House. Research shows many advertisements for the premises appearing in the Humpybong and Weekly Advertiser: Cambridge House Private Boarding Establishment (first from jetty). Terms £1 per week or 4/ per day.

The Henderson family were regular visitors to Cambridge House and were well known to those members of the Warbrick family who managed it: Ella Warbrick, her sister-in-law Florence, and nieces Lucy and Ena. Ella, the hero of this story, came to Australia in 1895 to celebrate the wedding of her brother and never left. While assisting her sister-in-law and nieces to run the guesthouse, she became a well-known community figure at Woody Point.

On October 14 of this same year, Mr Henderson had gone to work in Brisbane when his two sons, Percy (13 years) and Dudley (11 years), decided to take their father's boat and row to Otter Rock, about 1.6 km off shore.

However while adventuring, the boat sprang a leak, leaving the boys stranded; they were in trouble and needed help!



Several people put their hands up to assist, but it was 24-year-old Ella who insisted on swimming out to rescue them. Mr Horace Bertwhistle, who was painting the roof of the Palace Hotel, also swam to the boys, but it was Ella who became recognised as the hero. As a reward for her efforts that day, Ella received The Royal Humane Society of Australasia medal.

An application to Moreton Bay Regional Council resulted in the unveiling of a plaque on a bench seat in Jetty Square to honour Ella's bravery on 14 October 2014 – 111 years to the day! Thanks go to Councillors Koliana Winchester and James Houghton for their support, and special thanks to Daphne Gibbs for sharing her heritage.

SAFETY PROJECT AT WOODY POINT



Detailed design on a \$1.3 million safety project at Woody Point will soon be underway.

Works to realign the intersection of Hornibrook Esplanade, Oxley Avenue and Caroline Street are expected to start in 2017/18, weather permitting.

State Member for Redcliffe, Yvette D'Ath said community safety was the main driver behind the project.

"We are committed to building and maintaining safer roads," Ms D'Ath said. This project is funded under the Queensland Government's Targeted Road Safety programs, which aims to improve road safety by implementing highbenefit, cost-effective treatments at known and potential crash locations.

Proposed Intersection Upgrade

The community voiced concerns about the complexity of the Hornibrook Esplanade and Oxley Street intersection, and we have responded.

The proposed works will provide a much simpler and safer site to navigate for the motorist and will involve:

Realigning the intersection of Hornibrook Esplanade and Oxley Avenue to a more conventional layout.

Clearer and simpler give way conditions on the approach to the intersection.

Safer right turn facility from Hornibrook Esplanade into Woody Point.

As a consequence of the above safety improvements, movements at Caroline Street will be converted to left in and left out only

The proposed concept for the intersection is currently being finalised. Community consultation on the preliminary design of the project is currently underway.

REDCLIFFE: MAKING A MOVE ON NEW TOWN PLAN

With the recent launch of a new town plan for the Moreton Bay Region, it would seem now is the time for developers and Redcliffe residents to make their move.

Key changes, which came into affect in September to comply with the State Government's new Planning Act 2016, include changes to the application process (for developers) from impact assessable – which required public notification of new projects – to code assessable (which only requires the proposed development to be assessed against the codes under which they fall, ultimately making for quicker approval and building times), density cap amendments, and an increase to proposed high-rise level developments.

Though the plan is already in effect, Council has a small window of opportunity in which residents and developers can still apply to have their projects approved under the old plan, something which architect and longtime Redcliffe resident, Alex Enborisoff would encourage you to do before cut-off on January 31st 2017, when the old plan will officially be retired. "It's a great opportunity now for people to increase the value of their property."

This is particularly important for those who live in areas earmarked for drainage investigations, as approval for development in these areas will not go ahead under the new plan until Council has resolved the underlying issue.

While this may seem good for commercial development, what about the unique community atmosphere of this old seaside town? Well, the new plan takes that into account too, with special lots set aside

for residents who do not want their quiet lifestyle impeded upon by the chaos of commercialisation.

The progress is to get Redcliffe on the map, so to speak, improve infrastructure, improve everything. To do that, you need population [and] to increase population, you obviously need to zone areas for redevelopment," says Enborisoff.
