CONNECTING WITH THE *Spirit World*

Charmaine Wilson is a world renowned Australian medium who is visiting the Redcliffe Cultural Centre to engage an audience with spirits from their past.

Recognised for her unique skill as a medium, Charmaine Wilson was the winner of Channel Seven's inaugural season of *The One*, in which several psychics participated in trials to challenge their abilities. Having lived through a lot of personal heartaches with the loss of loved ones, including her brother and four-year-old daughter in tragic accidents, Wilson is a compassionate and understanding reader, who sees it as her job to support clients through the grieving process.

"It's my job to alleviate the fear of death and help people through the grieving process. From the minute I walk out on stage, I'm engaged with spirits who take me right to their person. They will often give me lots of personal details and even a special memory that connects the spirit to the person. It's usually something unique, so the person knows it's really them," says Wilson.

Since 2002, Wilson has been dedicated to providing accurate information about the spirit world to her clients. In 2005 Wilson was awarded the Australian Psychic of the Year award and Queensland Psychic of the Year in 2009 for her gift and efforts. Having worked in Redcliffe before, Wilson says she loves visiting and working in our area.

“Come in with an open heart and mind. The idea of the event is to help everyone understand that the spirits are there. It's never ‘goodbye’ when a loved one departs; it's only ‘see you later’. I'm here to give you the comfort and knowledge that the spirits are always around,” says Wilson.

“Expect to see a lot of readings in the audience. Even if you don't receive a reading, everyone will see [the] connection between spirit and audience members and I'll show everyone how to survive the grieving process and come out the other side.”

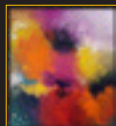

When Australian entertainer Mark Andrew Tabone comes to town, Legends follow – the likes of Dean Martin, Tom Jones and Elvis Presley to be precise.

For one night only, on Friday, April 21, the Melbourne-born impersonator will be bringing his acclaimed Legends Showcase to Mon Komo Hotel.

It is a show that Elvis Presley's own right-hand man, close friend and road manager for nearly two decades, the late Joe Esposito, has called "absolutely fantastic".

“ It brought back so many memories,” Esposito said. “[Mark sings] from the heart just like Elvis did.”

The two-hour Las Vegas style musical spectacular features a ten-piece band and four showgirls.

The first part of the show “takes the audience back to those early concert years,” said Mark Andrew.

His quick costume changes during this segment see the return of Dean Martin, Buddy Holly, John Lennon, Tom Jones, Jim Morrison and Austin Powers.

“The second half leaves audiences spellbound.”

This is the part when Mark presents his classy and uncanny portrayal of Elvis Presley.

Indeed, if Elvis is your thing, this show is not to be missed, Australian award-winning stage, television and screen actor Vince Colosimo has said.

Mark spent most of his childhood in Europe and began to perform at eight years of age.

He appeared on ‘New Faces’ upon his return to Australia in 1983, and formed Rock n Roll band Blue Suede Dudes in 1992.

A trained actor with a flair for capturing the essence of renowned characters, Mark featured as Buddy Holly in a 1995 Legends Revival Concert at Dallas Brooks Hall.

But it was when Elvis Presley's own friends and entourage, including manager Joe Esposito and long-time girlfriend Linda Thompson, jumped onto his bandwagon that Mark's talent gained global acclaim.

“It was incredible to work with and be accepted by Elvis Presley's own entourage,” said Mark.

Mark travels with his band and fiancé Lisa Curry, former ironwoman and competition swimmer.

“We work hand in hand, Lisa as keynote speaker and I as an entertainer.”

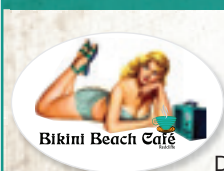

ANZAC

This Anzac Day, members of the Redcliffe community will once again rise to pay tribute to the lives of those fallen in battle as well as those serving in the Military.

Redcliffe in Remembrance

The Dawn Service will be held along Redcliffe's serene foreshore, as the sun rises over the march, which will begin at 5am, followed by breakfast at 6am. The Main service and march will take place at Anzac Place at 9.30am, followed by an outdoor 'Two-up' bar in the Redcliffe RSL Loading dock car park. Two-up is a traditional Australian gambling game involving flipping pennies, a game that has been played by Australian diggers throughout the ages.

2017 marks the centenary of some important events that took place during World War I.

“Something unique to our services this year which we will be talking about in speeches is the attack on Beersheba, which occurred 100 years ago this year,”

says Robert Kingston, a representative of Redcliffe RSL's Anzac Day organising committee.

Beersheba was the scene of the historic charge by the 4th Light Horse Brigade during the First World War, on October 31st, 1917. Australian forces successfully broke through Turkish defences, and the heavily fortified town of Beersheba fell, 43km from Turkish Bastion of Gaza. This opened the way for the outflanking of the Gaza-Beersheba line of defence and resulted in the retreat of Turkish forces into Palestine.

On the Sunday before Anzac Day, April 23rd, there will be a Cemetery Service. During this service, crepe paper poppies, handmade by Legacy Laurel Club members, are placed on the graves of beloved ex-servicemen and women.

Often the services held by Redcliffe RSL are some of the largest commemorative events in South East Queensland, so as past years have shown, we can expect crowds in the thousands this year.

It's All About You At Redcliffe's First Self-Healing Expo

In a world of Dr Google, advertorials, and symptom checkers that always seem to conclude: cancer, could it be possible that one person alone can solve our health problems?

The You Can Heal Yourself Expo might just have the answer, and it's coming to Hercules Road State School this month.

Event organiser and founding member of the You Can Heal Yourself Foundation, Wayne Pina-Roozemon, said the Expo was about "educating people as to the options they have on their healing journey".

“We're not anti-Western medicine, but we think people should be educated, take responsibility for their own health and make their own decisions.”

“Most of us are more than happy to hand over our entire health and healing journey to someone else, whether that's a homoeopath or chiropractor, without getting the facts or figures.

“But just because something worked for somebody, doesn't mean it will work for everyone.”

The Foundation works on the premise that all physical pain has an emotional basis, said Mr Pina-Roozemon.

“There's no point in fixing the physical aspects unless you look at, understand and deal with the emotional aspects.

“A primary example is The Biggest Loser [where] everyone goes through emotional hell



as they realise that mummy didn't love them and all sorts of other things.

"What ends up happening is that the barriers they've created come down and they lose the weight.

"The people who don't keep the weight off are, more often than not, those who haven't dealt with their [emotional] problems, or they may have more things to deal with."

Combining spiritual, physical and emotional elements, the You Can Heal Yourself Expo will include a variety of workshops, stalls and guest speakers.

"Medicinal Cannabis is a very big topic at the moment so Steven Parker, one of the frontrunners in this space, will be coming to discuss cannopathy," said Mr Pina-Roozemond.

Other speakers include Miessence certified organic skincare range founder Narelle Chenery and stem cell technology pioneer Ian Davies.

Those looking to overcome fear can participate in a fire-walking workshop on Saturday evening or take a selfie with a python at the live snakes exhibition.

Redcliffe has a packed calendar of festivals and joining the line-up this April is the Lifestyle on Water Festival, which celebrates all things boating, music, food and lifestyle on the Peninsula.

It has been an exciting time in the lead up to the inaugural event, with organiser Carl Richards expecting visitors from all over the greater Brisbane area.

"My Kitchen Rules' Tony and Lynne, and Dave [from Rob and Dave on My Kitchen Rules] also bring the local flavour, while Channel 7's Paul Burt will show off his skills.

"Our vision is to bring a totally different festival experience that patrons haven't had before."

Carl says he believes Redcliffe is developing into a foodie destination, but there is plenty more potential for locals.


"We would love to look back in a few years time and see the festival has helped to expose local businesses and become a food hot spot where visitors can experience the scenic offerings and local produce," he says.

"So Festival goers can indulge while taking in the sounds and experience of the festival.

"It's hard to choose one, but eggs benedict with a cappuccino and freshly squeezed juice is my breakfast staple," he says.

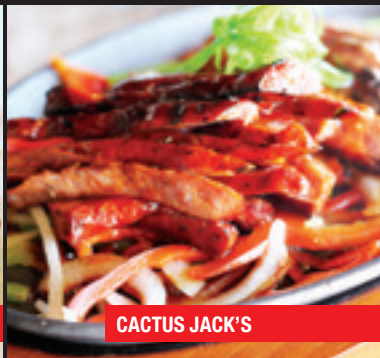

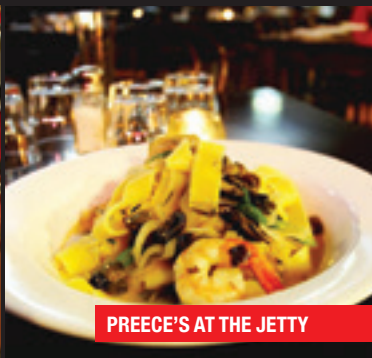

More prawns spotted with virus, but safe to eat.

Though the disease does not directly affect humans and the prawns are safe to eat, Whispovirus, known for wiping out entire farm populations in a matter of days, now poses a broader financial risk to the Queensland industry.

The virus is impacting the income streams of over 100 families, having devastated four farms valued at \$25 million, over a quarter of the Queensland industry's annual value, according to the Australian Prawn Farmers Association and the Queensland Department of Agriculture and Fisheries.

The white spot syndrome virus outbreak, not to be confused with the parasitic protozoan that can infect aquarium fish, has prompted the largest ever emergency response to any aquatic animal disease in Queensland.

Agriculture and Fisheries Minister Bill Byrne reports that recent detections of the disease near the Redcliffe Peninsula and Deception Bay have led to the instalment of an expanded movement control order that replaces existing restrictions.

"After seeing the impact of this disease on the prawn farming industry in the Logan River region, we are taking immediate steps to contain the risk of further spread.

"A movement control order for the Moreton Bay region is being established with immediate effect," the Minister said.

Chief Biosecurity Officer Dr Jim Thompson said the continued response, which the Minister reports has already cost the Queensland Government \$8.645 million as at the end of February, is vital to "[safeguard] the state's multi-million dollar aquaculture industries."

"To ensure that fishing and the local trade in fresh Moreton Bay seafood can continue, the movement control area will also encompass the western borders of the Gold Coast City Council, Brisbane City Council, and Moreton Bay Regional Council," Dr Thompson said.

Dr Thompson advises that cooking destroys the virus and clears the crustaceans for travel outside of the containment area.

"People wishing to move these products out of the area whether for their own consumption or to sell in other markets, will have to cook them first."

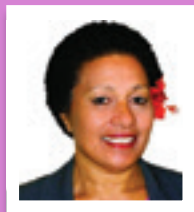
The good news is that Safe Food Production Queensland recommends that prawns impacted by White Spot are safe for consumption and do not pose any food safety issues.

Safe Food's Manager of Science, Dr Andrew Wilson explains,

“The consumption of affected crustaceans does not impact human health. White Spot is a virus that only affects susceptible crustaceans such as prawns, crabs and lobsters, and people are not vulnerable to the virus,” adding that cooking destroys the virus and consumers should retain confidence in Queensland's seafood market.”

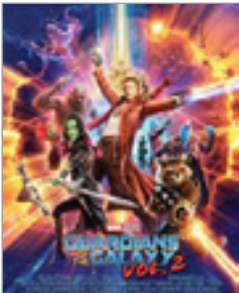

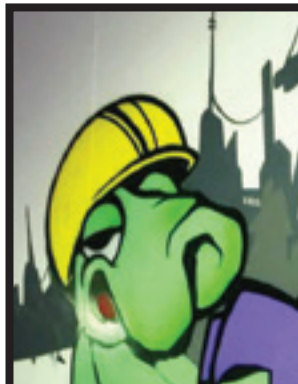

I feel [CanTeen] is quite a special organisation because it helps the children and families of cancer patients, even after their loved ones have passed," said Nicole.

CanTeen was formed in 1985 and is an Australian organisation for young people living with cancer — whether they are cancer patients themselves or the siblings or children of a cancer patient.

It was about two years ago that local artist Dan Krause from Street Art Concepts transformed the walls of an old service station (now Good Vibes) into Alice's Wonderland.

AN EPIC EXPEDITION

Picture this: Antarctica, 1914.

The temperature is below freezing, the winds are strong, and the seas are rough. The ship you are travelling on is trapped in the ice and after months of drifting, you are tormented by several days in open water, only to be stranded on an uninhabited island.

With food running out and disaster imminent, your only chance of survival is to paddle a leaking, wooden boat 1400 kilometres across treacherous waters to another island, where you will have to scale mountains and cross glaciers to reach help.

This was the fate of adventurer Sir Ernest Shackleton and the 28 men aboard his ship, the *Endurance*, 100 years ago. Shackleton had embarked upon his Imperial Trans-Antarctic Expedition from Buenos Aires, wanting to be the first person to cross Antarctica's interior. The tale of survival that followed has been described by Sir Edmund Hilary as "the greatest survival story ever undertaken".

The Redcliffe Museum is hosting 'Shackleton: Escape from Antarctica', a stunning exhibition on tour from the Australian National Maritime Museum. The display documents the story of Shackleton's ship and the subsequent rescue of those who were involved in the disaster.

Some highlights of the exhibit include stunning photographs, dioramas, rare and unusual artefacts from other expeditioners including Australian scientist Andrew Keith, as well as actual equipment, clothing and specimens from this extraordinary episode of Antarctic exploration.

The story of Sir Ernest Shackleton is one of incredible bravery, adventure and resilience and this exhibition certainly won't disappoint.

GREAT NEWS FOR REDCLIFFE

BRISBANE'S more affordable outer suburbs are being tipped as property hot spots in 2017.
