MEXICO MANIA TO FIRE UP

Jetty Fiesta

This year's Jetty Fiesta will bring in the final weekend of the Redcliffe Festival with a piñata-rattling bang as community members don their sombreros and awake from their siestas with a Mexican-themed extravaganza.

On Saturday, September 9, a bevvvy of Mexican musicians, dance troupes and entertainers will take over Redcliffe Jetty with one of the region's biggest street parties, bringing a tonne of free fun for families and visitors alike.

Moreton Bay Region Industry and Tourism chief executive Shane Newcombe says Jetty Fiesta has become a huge event on the community calendar and promises the traditional Fireworks Finale will be unlike any other seen in previous years.

“ Jetty Fiesta has grown to become one of those unmissable community events,” Mr Newcombe says. “Each year the Fireworks Finale gets bigger and better.”

Apart from a stack of food vendors, twilight markets and street entertainers, the main stage entertainment promises a huge line-up of Mexican talent.

El Mad Mariachi will bring their maniacal rhythms and grooves with a big four-piece sound, and following them will be Mariachi Trio Sabor, who will deliver Latino dance grooves for all to shake their rumps to.

Dance troupe Mexico en la Piel is set to deliver a dose of Mexican culture through their authentic foot-stomping moves and traditional, colourful dress, while African-Cuban salsa ensemble Chukale will finish up with a huge performance of hip-quaking, soul-shaking music.

“There will also be slackline workshops on



the beach from 4.30-6.30pm,” Mr Newcombe says, “and a spectacular [fire show] just before the huge Fireworks Finale at 8pm.

“We can’t wait for families to see what we have in store with plenty of free and low-cost entertainment.”

AFRO-CUBAN BEATS TO HIT THE STREETS

If you've found yourself in a mood that requires a groove, then you'd be mad to miss out on the headline act at this year's Jetty Fiesta.

They've supported Grammy-nominated artists, graced stages across the nation from Woodford Folk Festival to Darling Harbour and just about everywhere in between. They know how to fill a stage with 13 sharply dressed soul-shaking musos, but for Chukale, an Afro Cuban Salsa Ensemble, the Jetty Fiesta is an opportunity to bring their sharp-dressed, fine-tuned Latino beats to the Peninsula.

Percussionist and lead vocalist Gustavo Cereijo says the band formed in 2005 and while the much-loved group have played at the festival before, people looking for a good time need look no further for a truly authentic stage show.

"We're a hugely energetic band, and I have to make mention our wonderful singer, Ivania," Gustavo says.

"She's an incredible Cuban singer, a beautiful voice."

The band has played alongside such acts as the legendary Afro Cuban All Stars and eight-time Grammy Award winner Chucho Valdez and has recorded with likes of Buena Vista Social Club singer Felix Baloy and flautist Polo Tamoyo.

And with Gustavo's deep history in the Afro-Cuban and roots scene across Australia and overseas, there's no doubt audiences are getting the real deal.

"I feel like an ambassador for this music in Australia," he says.

"I trained in Cuba and managed tours for some of the best, like the Afro-Cuban All Stars. I worked throughout Sydney at some huge festivals, managing tours for some incredible acts out of Cuba so I've been a part of this scene and the beautiful music we make for many years now.

“This music is just so honest and authentic, people at the Jetty Fiesta can expect a high-energy show that will fit right in with the Mexican theme on the day.”

Chukale will play on the Main Stage at 7pm and 8.15pm. The Jetty Fiesta is on Saturday, September 9 from 3-9pm along Redcliffe Parade and at Redcliffe Jetty.

The Four Nations Rugby Festival is a Veterans Rugby Queensland event and is the third and final major event for Veterans Rugby in 2017. The spirit of this 'Golden Oldies' sport is epitomised in the motto Fun, Friendship and Fraternity, and this international catchphrase is the central theme of not only the Festival but every game of Golden Oldies Rugby.

Veterans Rugby Queensland started out as the Queensland Over 35's Association, which was established in Brisbane and outlying areas in the 1980s as a not-for profit organisation to administer 'Golden Oldies' Rugby, as it was then known. They were responsible for the general day-to-day organisation of 'Oldies' rugby, the rules that governed the game, and its promotion.

The veteran's games encourage socialisation, family values and an all-inclusive approach to playing rugby for life. Veteran Rugby Clubs, who form part of Veterans Rugby Queensland, are heavily involved in all aspects of junior, senior, and elite rugby.

"We give back to the game, as much as we can, to grow it across all ages and demographics," says Mal Hedley of The Redcliffe Rugby Union.

"We also support our own, especially through our commitment to the values of Australian mental health support group, Beyond Blue, helping our [members] to identify and safely deal with men's health issues such as depression, mental illness and the like."

The winner of the Four Nations Festival will take home the Kenny Cup, which has been named after a veteran player who passed away earlier this year. There will be plenty of entertainment, food and drinks available, ensuring it will be a great day out for the whole family.

Peninsula's Past In the Present

It's been 193 years since John Oxley sailed into Moreton Bay and cast his eyes on what is now Redcliffe, deciding it would be the ideal location for a new penal settlement.

if your inner historian is hungry to see what the European arrival to the Peninsula looked like, right down to the traditional garb worn by the sailors and the Aboriginal inhabitants who called the area home all those years ago, Redcliffe Remembers — the final event of this year's Redcliffe Festival — is the perfect family-friendly day of celebrations for you.

On Sunday, September 10 from 8am, the waterfront precinct along Redcliffe Parade will be packed with market stalls, wandering performers, buskers and food stalls, along with a raft of free, family-friendly entertainment including the historical re-enactment of the European arrival and the Indigenous welcome.

The re-enactment is now famous, according to Moreton Bay Region Industry Tourism chief executive Shane Newcombe, who says the historical aspect to the day of celebrations puts the Peninsula's past firmly in focus for people who may not realise the area housed Queensland's first penal colony.

“The whole community pays tribute to decades past,” he says. “It’s an important element and event on the Redcliffe Festival calendar and an incredible way to close the festival.”

There's a huge line-up of entertainers for the event, including alt-rock act Silk N Oak, Little Stevie and the Tail Fins, Taleena Peck and the John Abbott Band. And you'd be mad to miss Peninsula locals Ruby Reds & The Red Rockettes who will be bringing a burst of classic 1950s and '60s pop and rock classics to the main stage.

For those who want to rev up their engines, Mr Newcombe says the Revin Up Redcliffe part of the day will combine a high-octane collection of custom and classic cars from Studebaker Car Club, Corvettes Down Under Car Club and Vintage Speedcar Association Queensland.

“And the 2017 Miss Redcliffe Festival Pinup Pageant returns,” he says.

“Rockabilly ladies will take to the stage chasing the crown of Miss Redcliffe Festival 2017.”

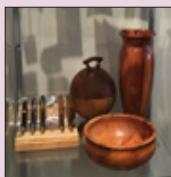
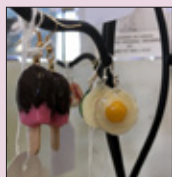

MOUSETRAP THEATRE: 'THE 39 STEPS'

For those of you who love a good comedy/thriller, that was originally a 1935 film by Alfred Hitchcock, are in for a real treat with Mousetrap's latest offering of John Buchan's 'The 39 Steps'.

The play itself is set in 1935 as per the original film, but with a twist, it only has a cast of four. There is one who plays the hero Richard Hannay, an actress who plays three women with whom he has romantic entanglements, and two other actors who play every other character in the show, e.g. heroes, villains, men, women, children, and even the occasional inanimate object. This often requires lightning fast quick changes and at times for them to play multiple characters all at once. Thus the original film's serious spy story is played mainly for laughs, and the script is full of allusions and puns on the titles of other Alfred Hitchcock films including Rear Window, Psycho, Vertigo and North by Northwest.

'AGNES OF GOD'

Redcliffe Musical Theatre Depicts Intriguing Battle Between Faith and Reason

If you enjoy watching the unfolding of a drama that takes you out of your comfort zone, you won't be disappointed with Redcliffe Musical Theatre's production of AGNES OF GOD directed by Richard Rubendra and produced at their new venue THEATRE 102.

The stage play concerns three main characters: Martha, the psychiatrist; Miriam Ruth, the Mother Superior; and Agnes, the novice. There are no other characters on stage, and all three roles are considered demanding for the actors playing them.

Agnes is accused of giving birth to a child and strangling it — even though she has no memory of the impregnation, ensuing pregnancy or birth. Livingstone tries to discover the "truth" of how Agnes became pregnant and why she killed the child — but Mother Miriam Ruth implies the birth was a divine miracle and that delving too deep into Agnes psyche might needlessly destroy both the miracle and Agnes faith.

“The Moreton Bay Regional Council Art Collection has grown significantly over the past nine years, through purchases, generous donations, and acquisition of works through awards such as 15 Artists,” says Cr Houghton.

There are over 300 works across diverse media including sculpture, video, and paintings that reflect the vision, diversity and character of the region. Craig says the feedback from the local community has been overwhelming.

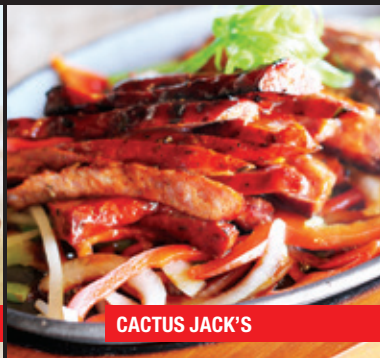
"Craft Burgers & Beer was founded in Clontarf, and we appreciate all the amazing support the community has so far provided," he says.

Plans for a new multi-storey carpark at Redcliffe Hospital are underway, with planning and community consultation set to begin in the coming weeks.

Member for Redcliffe Yvette D'Ath said parking has long been a big issue at Redcliffe Hospital. "We hear stories about patients missing appointments because they can't find a park and staff having to park off-site and incurring parking fines while they are caring for patients.

"But there is no space on the hospital campus and to expand parking access without encroaching on the community, we have to build up," she said.

Right now on site, there are close to 700 car spaces. The Hospital and Health Service estimates up to 225 additional spaces are needed just to cater for existing demand at Redcliffe.

Minister for Health and Ambulance Services Cameron Dick praised Mrs D'Ath's advocacy for her local community.

“I want to thank Yvette for bringing this matter to my attention,” Mr Dick said. “She’s been knocking on my door about a car parking solution since I became the Health Minister.

Mr Dick said an on-site multi-storey carpark at the Redcliffe Hospital would offer a greater level of safety for staff, patients and families, however, the caveat is that this is an expensive operation.

The key question on financing is whether to use health investment to pay for the carpark or to ask for users of that carpark to contribute to the cost of the infrastructure through a reasonable tariff.

Mr Dick said visitors could expect to pay a maximum charge of about \$15 per day for car parking at the new multi-storey carpark, with concessions available for eligible patients, carers and staff.

Queensland Health would finalise a business case for the site and move into the procurement phase by mid next year with early works to commence soon after.

“The business case will consider forecast demand projections for this hospital and make sure we provide scope for any possible expansion,” Mr Dick said.

“That’s going to involve a lot of consultation with staff and consumer representatives, as well as the broader community.”

REDCLIFFE PARKRUN IS HERE!

Dust off your running shoes Redcliffe residents, you've got a great reason to get up on Saturday mornings.

Come this September on Saturday 16th at 7am, the internationally renowned parkrun will debut at Suttons Beach Park in Redcliffe as the 'Redcliffe parkrun'.

Parkrun is an organisation that operates weekly throughout the world. It is a 5km timed run for everyone of all running abilities. It is a free event held on weekend mornings purely run by local volunteers. Runners hold parkrun barcodes, and runs are timed with results emailed to each registered runner. Results are collated and appear on the website specific to that parkrun.

Local resident Troy Lum initiated the 'Redcliffe parkrun'. An active runner who has been a regular participant and volunteer at the Sandgate parkrun, Troy said, "There was always talk about why there was no parkrun in Redcliffe".

Troy's passion for running also extends to coaching running groups. He is surrounded by like-minded people who are passionate about running, and who have all wanted to see a Redcliffe parkrun begin.

With parkrun organised on a pure volunteer basis, it had to take a local to become the initiator, and after consideration, Troy became this person. Taking six months from first

approaching parkrun and going through the necessary processes with the local council the 'Redcliffe parkrun' is now within sight.

Due to Troy's initiation to start the 'Redcliffe parkrun' Troy has become the 'Event Director', though by no means is he doing this alone. Parkrun is very much a volunteer driven organisation.

“It's 100% run by volunteers”, says Troy. “Without the support of the local community, it wouldn't be happening. It's the perfect fit for me with my running background, and it's a great opportunity for me to be able to give back to the community.”

The Redcliffe parkrun will start at Suttons Beach Park. The course will run south first and then turn around where it will continue north encompassing a 5 km course. A risk assessment process has to be completed, and the course is approved by the parkrun organisation, meeting all safety conditions.

In early August, a background briefing was presented to Honourable Yvette D'Ath to commission and officially open the refurbished radio communications room and new radio equipment at the Coastguard Redcliffe base, Scarborough.

In late 2016, the Flotilla members supported the redevelopment of the radio room and installation of up-to-date radio communications technology using a store of fundraising savings.

Updates to enhance security, functionality and safety feature the installation of new specially tinted windows, led lighting, electrical circuits for a battery storage system, new cabinetry and a specially designed chart table.

A sound-proof door will compartmentalise noise from the crew room, while new professional digital radios meet the standards of the Brisbane Vessel Traffic Service and the base radio monitoring stations at Mooloolaba, Manly and Southport.

Installations also include a new computer system and touch screen, ergonomic supports for operators, industrial grade vinyl flooring, and a 'smart' TV set using AIS technology to help monitor vessel traffic.

The project sourced, wherever possible, local trade labour and products. Many donated the cost of their time or materials to assist in the redevelopment and keep within the \$15,000 renovation budget. QF3 volunteers worked to maintain an overall minimal budget including tech updates, which totalled \$45,000 of saved funds by Flotilla members.

The result is an open, light, highly functional workspace which incorporates the latest in maritime radio communications technology, which will enable QF3 to continue to serve the Moreton Bay community for many years to come.

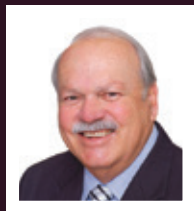

AIRTRAIN BEATS ALL FORECASTS

Nearly 10,000 residents of the Redcliffe region have chosen to catch the train to Brisbane Airport since the Redcliffe Peninsula Line opened in 2016, exceeding all forecasts for Airtrain in the region.

According to Airtrain CEO Chris Basche, the impressive results are due to the ongoing roadworks in the Redcliffe and Moreton Bay region forcing locals to consider alternative, more efficient means of travelling and getting to the airport on time by avoiding traffic congestion.

Mr Basche said, "Commuters in the Redcliffe and Moreton Bay region already travel a considerable distance to reach the Brisbane Airport. The Airtrain service allows them to bypass the stress on the roads, relax on their journey and even plan their trip in advance.

“We encourage more Redcliffe locals to beat the traffic and catch the train to the airport.”

The road delays in the area are expected to continue until construction is complete between late 2017 and early 2018.

To access the airport train stations, change at Eagle Junction. Regular commuters can simply tap their go card, while paper tickets are available at all QR train stations, or e-Tickets can be purchased from the Airtrain website. Airtrain services operate every 15 minutes during peak hour and every 30 minutes outside of peak times between 5.00am and 10.00pm.

To take advantage of Airtrain's services, customers should book online prior to their travel date. On the day, travellers will catch any Springfield line or Roma Street service to Eagle Junction, and upon arrival at Eagle Junction travellers should then move to Platform 2 where they can catch any airport bound service.

SEASIDE CELEBRATIONS: *Oxley/Flinders Memorial*

The thirties were a time of unprecedented growth on the Redcliffe Peninsula. A newly elected council, headed by Mayor Alfred Langdon, supported by Town Clerk L J Lucas, appointed a carnival committee after a suggestion that the Christmas season of 1930 should be made brighter for visitors by a series of organised carnivals.

As well as reviving the annual Humpybong Regatta which had not been run since WWI, it was decided to raise funds for a memorial to Lieutenant John Oxley. It was also felt that the memorial should honour Lieutenant Matthew Flinders who had named Redcliffe Point in 1799.

In December 1930 members of the festival committee met on the flat ground by the water's edge at Redcliffe Point, where it was believed that John Oxley had landed in November 1823,

to discuss the site of the proposed memorial. It was decided that the memorial should be erected on the cliff top overlooking this site to avoid the danger of erosion.

The December 1930/January 1931 holiday season began with a festival weekend with much frivolity. During this time, a re-enactment of Oxley's landing took place on the Esplanade before a reported crowd of over 1000. This was followed by the dedication of the site for the Oxley Memorial.

The following year it was decided that further action should be taken regarding the memorial to Lieutenant Matthew Flinders and Lieutenant John Oxley. Plans and costings for the memorial were submitted by M R Hornibrook and adopted at a public meeting. Work commenced on the memorial in late 1932, and it was unveiled on 26th December by Lieutenant-Colonel His Excellency Sir Leslie Orme Wilson, Governor of Queensland. Plain but dignified, the obelisk was designed by John Beeby and features four bronze memorial plaques. The wording for the plaques was provided by the Historical Society of Queensland.

A budget of \$400,000 for a property purchase in a capital city used to provide an array of options. However, with dwelling values continuing to rise, new research by CoreLogic shows a significant reduction in the proportion of sales occurring in this price bracket.

The research shows that across Australia, 31.2% of houses sold for less than \$400,000. By comparison, a year ago the proportions were recorded at 32.8%. A decade ago, 62.4% of all house sales were priced below \$400,000.

A decade ago only Sydney (35.5%) and Canberra (40.0%) had fewer than 50% of sales below \$400,000. Comparing that to the last 12 months, Hobart was the only capital city to have more than 50% (53.2%) of house sales below \$400,000.

CoreLogic research analyst Cameron Kusher said, "As dwelling values continue to increase,

we anticipate that over the next 12 months the proportion of properties selling for less than \$400,000 will further reduce and in the way that the rising number of sales of properties for at least \$1 million shows the deteriorating affordability, so too does the significant reduction in the availability of properties priced under \$400,000.

"Although the federal government attempted to address housing affordability in the budget this year, in order to improve housing affordability, clearly there is much more work to be done on both supply and demand drivers of the market."
