ANZAC DAY

2018 SERVICES

Anzac Day heralds the time of year when we turn our thoughts to the sacrifices made by those who have fought or are fighting to protect our Australian way of life.

Redcliffe will play host to commemorative services to both thank those serving members, past and present, and remember those who paid with their lives.

Residents and visitors are encouraged to attend the Dawn Service, starting with the march at 5am. The service will run from 5.30am to 6.10am at Anzac Place.

The annual Anzac Day parade begins from Mon Komo Hotel heading towards Anzac Place and starts at 9.30am, with the mid-morning service taking place from 10.30am to midday.

Additionally, a service will be held at the Woody Point Hall from 8.30 to 9.00am.

Cheryl Barrett, Vice President of the Redcliffe RSL, has revealed some of the details of the upcoming services.

"Commodore Allison Norris will be the Reviewing Officer this year and she will be attending both the Dawn and Mid Morning services.

" We will also have the granddaughters of Private Joseph Payne attending as the Dawn Service will be dedicated to him this year on the 100th anniversary of his passing 25th April 1918."

Private Joseph Payne fought in the Villers-Bretonneux battle in France on 25th April 1918, ultimately dying of wounds sustained in that battle.

A local favourite, poet Rupert McCall, will also be regaling attendees with one of his odes at the Dawn Service.

Cheryl welcomes public involvement in all commemorative services held on the Peninsula.

"The public are welcome to join the mid-morning parade and march on behalf of a loved one.

"They form up behind the Serving and Ex-Serving members and are also able to lay a wreath."

With 2017 attendance figures estimated at 30,000 for all services held on the Peninsula, it pays to plan your day and arrive early before popular vantage points are filled.

JETTY MARKETS SET FOR BIG EXPANSION

Redcliffe Jetty Markets is expanding to include corporate stalls, demonstration areas, food trucks and youth activation stations to interest the young and young at heart.

Redcliffe Jetty Markets director of operations, Matthew Harris said the expansion will be gradual to incorporate more activities, food and fun for market visitors.

"We're excited about the opportunity to grow as a business and provide an avenue for other local businesses to flourish as well," Matthew said.

"While not forgetting our heritage or our stature in the community, we're excited to move forward with Redcliffe.

"Winning the market category of Triple M's Brisbane's Best Award last year reinforced our vision to grow and become the best market in Australia.

"With the expansion, we will be incorporating corporate stalls, demonstration areas, food trucks and youth activation stations.

"We want to provide a platform for people to visit that will give them options for whatever they're looking for.

"At the end of the day we know we wouldn't be where we are today without our local and regular

visitors. We have grown with them and hope to continually do so moving forward.

"By expanding we don't want to lose our community identity, we want to offer continuous platforms for everyone to experience new concepts, stalls and people by incorporating cooking demonstrations, fitness activities, plant maintenance demonstrations and youth activation spaces for everyone to get involved," Matthew said.

The expansion will begin on April 8 and be rolled out over the next 12 to 18 months to build on the current successful layout.

There will be a designated small food truck area with a rotating schedule; an area for live demonstrations like cooking, plant maintenance and emergency services; community spaces including youth spaces and street art areas; corporate areas that support recreational lifestyle choices like 4x4, camping and caravan displays; more market stalls; a children's area with activities or a petting zoo; and possibly car exhibits and small shows like hosting the Corvette Club or classic Australian muscle cars.

ROCKIN' 4 THE HOMELESS

Rock n Roll For Food & Love

Rockin 4 the Homeless is rock and roll at its best with 25 bands on three stages and 11 hours of great Australian music, all for a good cause.

The Hoodoo Gurus are the headline act at Rockin 4 the Homeless at Dolphins Leagues Club on Saturday, April 28 in support of Redcliffe Breakfast Club.

Event director Dan Nebe said the concert is in its fifth year with all funds raised going to the Breakfast Club.

"We run this event each year to help the Breakfast Club which is not funded and run entirely by volunteers," Dan said.

" The Breakfast Club provides 1,500 free meals to the homeless and people in need each month. Their services include breakfasts three days a week, dinner two evenings a week, an outreach van that gives out blankets, food and care packs and the Breakfast Club Hub that is open two days a week.

"People can go to the hub to charge their phone, do washing, have a shower and the volunteers can connect them with support services.

"They can have a coffee and a feed and feel like they've got somewhere to go. The most important thing is the chance to mix with other people in a friendly and welcoming atmosphere.

"Some of the people are homeless, others are on low or fixed incomes and struggling to make their money stretch. The ages of people attending range from babies to people in their 80s.

"All the money raised goes to the Breakfast Club, 100% of every dollar. There are no agent fees or commissions or costs and the event is always fully funded prior to the day.

"Last year we raised almost \$67,000, more than the first three years combined.

"Rockin 4 the Homeless is growing, it's on a roll. It's a freight train that we can't stop and why would we," Dan said.

Local bands include including Diana Anaid, Team Utopia, Ben Candom, Sabrina Lawrie and The Hunting Party, Amanda Emblem Experiment and The Gastons.

Doors open at 1pm and the music goes until 1am followed by an after-party downstairs until 3am.

Rockin 4 The Homeless is on at Dolphins Leagues Club on Saturday, April 28. Doors open at 1pm.

TRAVELLING DURING THE GAMES?

With the 21st Commonwealth Games on our doorstep, Brisbane's rail network will get a real workout! If you're planning to use Redcliffe's new rail line during the Games, make sure you check the latest timetable.

Queensland Rail Chief Executive Officer, Nick Easy, says the network would be deploying all available resources to meet unprecedented demand on the Gold Coast line during the Games, as well as ensuring all South East Queensland (SEQ) commuters maintained access to services.

Mr Easy said to deliver a higher frequency of Gold Coast line services during the Games, service changes would be required across the remainder of the SEQ network. "In order to meet significant demand on the Gold Coast line during the Games, it's important we allocate trains where they're needed the most, which is to and from the Gold Coast."

Most of the impact of this extra demand will be felt on the south side of the city, however, all services across Brisbane, including on the Redcliffe line, will be affected.

"Trains will continue to operate on all other SEQ rail lines throughout the Games period, however, will operate at a reduced frequency from 30 March to 20 April."

This is a great time for Brisbane, make sure you know all about how to get around during the rush hour!

GET YOUR GIGGLE ON!

The old adage that laughter is the best medicine definitely holds true for local Bowen Therapist **Tenielle Dorling** - she believes it so much that she now teaches people how to do it!

Tenielle discovered Laughter Yoga some time ago when a friend invited her to a class, and since then she's been a great advocate for its ability to benefit all sorts of people.

"When my friend who is a yoga instructor invited me, I thought 'Who doesn't like to have fun?' So I went along to try it out and found that it was awesome!" Tenielle said.

"I have an infectious laugh, and everyone that was there enjoyed it, I don't know if they couldn't help laughing at me, or with me, but either way when a training course came up a few weeks later, I was in!"

Tenielle says that laughter yoga is really good for depression and anxiety, as well as being a great physical exercise.

"It's a cardio workout that you don't even realise you are doing. It's really just about laughing, child-like behaviour, silly things and more laughing."

The concept of Laughter Yoga began in India in 1995 when Dr Madan Kataria followed up some research that showed the body couldn't tell the difference between real laughter and fake laughter performed willingly.

...A better you, **TODAY!**

"It raises endorphins, it lowers blood pressure, it increases your core muscle work including the muscles that are around your organs, and it massages these organs," Tienielle said.

"When we don't laugh, we're not putting those endorphins out there; we can be really unhappy, and we can start fake-laughing, and we can change our whole attitude, our whole day."

You may laugh at the idea that this stuff would take off, but there are currently thousands of Laughter Clubs in over 65 countries around the world; it really seems to be infectious.

Tienielle sees the benefits of laughter yoga being applicable in a range of environments, from corporate settings to high schools, in aged care facilities and youth care. "It teaches people how to release anxiety and stress; everyone can benefit."

LEARN HOW TO MAKE GRATE CHEESE

Are you a fromage fanatic? Do you consider yourself a bit of a cheese connoisseur? Malt 'N' Bay Brewing Supplies and Soul Harvest Wholefoods have teamed up to host a delicious beginner's Italian cheesemaking workshop in Margate on Wednesday 18th April from 6 to 8pm.

Co-owner of Malt 'N' Bay Brewing Supplies, Hannah Ritchie said the demand for the course came directly from their customers.

"We sell cheese making kits and had been asked if we conduct classes — this is the first in Margate.

"Soul Harvest [has] a suitable venue in Baynes Street for workshops and they had asked if the community had suggestions for topics, thus the class booking."

During the workshop, participants will learn the basics of cheesemaking, from the type of milk to use to how to age a fine cheddar.

AERIAL ANTIQUES

Warwick Woinarski has spent much of his adult life up in the air. As a kid he built model aircraft; he left home at 16 years old to chase his dream of flying and started by washing aeroplanes in hangars. Warwick became an aircraft engineer early and got his pilot's license when he was nineteen. He bought his beloved Tiger Moth in 1973 at the age of 23, and he's flown it ever since.

"Aeroplanes are just good fun," Warwick said. "The Tiger Moth is a lot of fun but it does take a lot of skill because it's an old aeroplane. When I became a pilot for the airlines I would bring my

pilot buddies along on the weekend for a go and often they couldn't fly it."

"It's a bit like taking someone who can drive a modern car and asking them to operate a Model T Ford; it's just a different machine."

After 42 years of flying and maintaining the Tiger Moth, Warwick knows it inside out and upside down. In fact, being one of the country's most experienced aerobatic pilots, he really does know this plane upside down! Warwick conducts joy-flights from Redcliffe Aerodrome, and tells me that many of his customers are keen for an adrenaline rush!

"Eight out of ten joy-flights, people want aerobatics," Warwick says. "I'm probably one of the most current aerobatic pilots in the world, because every single weekend I do it, and have been doing that for years. Nothing too spectacular, just loops and rolls, maybe a Cuban Eight which is a sort of backwards loop, and then finish off with a stall-turn where you go straight up and then stall it, one wing flips over and then you come back down. That's usually enough for most people, but I never get any complaints!"

Everything is original in the Tiger Moth, but the engine is reconditioned regularly. Warwick is a licensed aircraft engineer and CASA has given him the required approval to over-hall Gypsy engines, which his plane carries.

"I love flying, but I really enjoy the mechanical side too," he tells us.

Warwick is a true devotee of the air; there's not too many people who discover their passion in their teenage years and are still doing it for a living into their sixties.

So if you feel like a high-flying adventure one weekend, pop out and see Warwick and his wonderful antique Tiger Moth. He may just turn you head over heels!



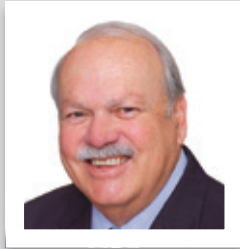

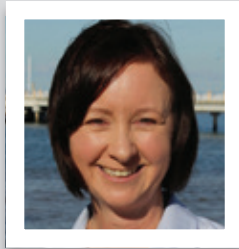

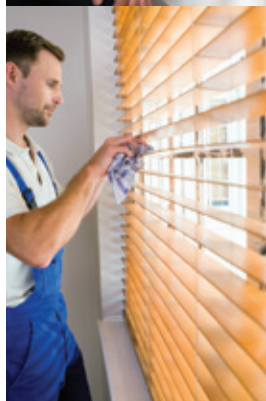
