# Classics ON SHOW

**American sports car royalty will take centre stage at Pelican Park this month.**

More than \$3 million worth of the US's most iconic sports cars will be on show at the Corvette Classic on Sunday, July 29.

There will be a wide range of Corvettes displayed for judging, ranging from models dating from the 1950s (C1 series) to the most modern 2017 model (C7 series).

"Some Vettes are in the original condition, and others have been modified to suit the owner's tastes," she says.

It is a special day out for the whole family, as passionate Corvette owners share their love of cars with the next generation.



Corvette owners always tell stories about how they first saw one as a child and they couldn't wait to own one. We hope to inspire a new generation of Corvette enthusiasts this year."

**R**unners, walkers and spectators will take to the streets of Redcliffe this month for Queensland's most scenic and longest running fun run, The Jetty 2 Jetty.

Now in its 33rd year, the event caters to all ages and fitness abilities and consists of four different races ranging from three kilometres to the 21-kilometre half marathon.

Kicking off on Sunday, July 22 at Crockatt Park in Woody Point, the first race will be off and running at 6.45am, with the final race at 9.15am

Moreton Bay Region Industry and Tourism CEO Shane Newcombe says it is an excellent event for the local community as well as local businesses.

"Everyone really gets involved in the Jetty 2 Jetty," he says.

"On race day you'll see thousands of locals lining the course sidelines with painted signs cheering on runners.

"It's a great atmosphere, and just as festive is the post-race brunch - Redcliffe's cafes and restaurants fill up with participants as they celebrate their achievements with a big hearty meal post-race."

Following the picturesque Bayside waterfront, the course is a drawcard for participants who can take in one of South East Queensland's most scenic seaside stretches while completing the fun run.

"The most unique element of the event is the spectacular view - there's nothing else quite like it," Mr Newcombe says.

"Second to that, there is just a fantastic energy on race day.

"Experienced racers encourage first-time runners, and the support crews are on the side, cheering on all the participants."

Mr Newcombe says there really is something on offer for everyone, whether participating in the run itself or not.

"After the race (or before) participants can browse and shop through the Peninsula Private Hospital Healthy Living Expo for the latest activewear, footwear and information on health services," he says.

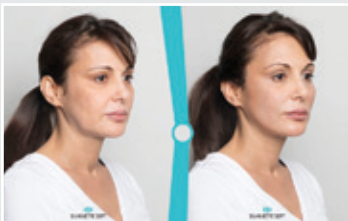

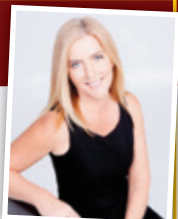

# Cracking Craft Fair Hits Redcliffe

**T**hen the Redcliffe Quota Craft and Gift Fair at Redcliffe Showgrounds on July 7 has the perfect selection of home-made and hand-crafted goods to satisfy your crafty inclinations.

And, of course, it's all for a good cause.

Quota International is a non-profit organisation empowering women, children, the deaf, those who are hard of hearing and speech impaired in local communities around the world.

Quota International's Kay Smallhorn says the fair helps the organisation raise money to achieve their mission.

"The fair and the stallholders, and the public it attracts helps to raise the club's purpose and profile in the community," she says.



The event is one of our major fundraising events of the year and the funds we raise assist many community groups, including Cartmill & Pender Riding for the Disabled; QuoCKa Reading in Redcliffe's Primary Schools; Jebb House, supporting victims of domestic violence; The Breakfast Club; Chameleon House for homeless youth; Meals on Wheels; Hummingbird House; Hear and Say Centre; Mummy's Wish; and Share the Dignity."

Kay says fans of craft and hand-made goods will have plenty to browse and buy, with a stack of stallholders signed up to take part. And there's even an incredible lucky door prize up for grabs.

"The community has been very supportive of the fair with 400-500 visitors annually," she says.

"We can fit 30 stalls into Webb Hall, and they cover a variety of products including children's clothes, jewellery, cards and card-making materials, jams and pickles, children's cloth storybooks, wood-turned items and toys, knitting, crochet, macramé, mosaic and pottery items.

"The stallholders we encourage and support are almost entirely from the Moreton Bay Council Region, and the club wants to encourage the public to support these talented craft people in our own region.

"And this is the third year that Newport Mooloolaba Apartments have donated a wonderful family two nights' getaway valued at \$800.

It's located at the former Sacred Heart Memorial Church, nestled in Corscadden Park on Anzac Avenue.

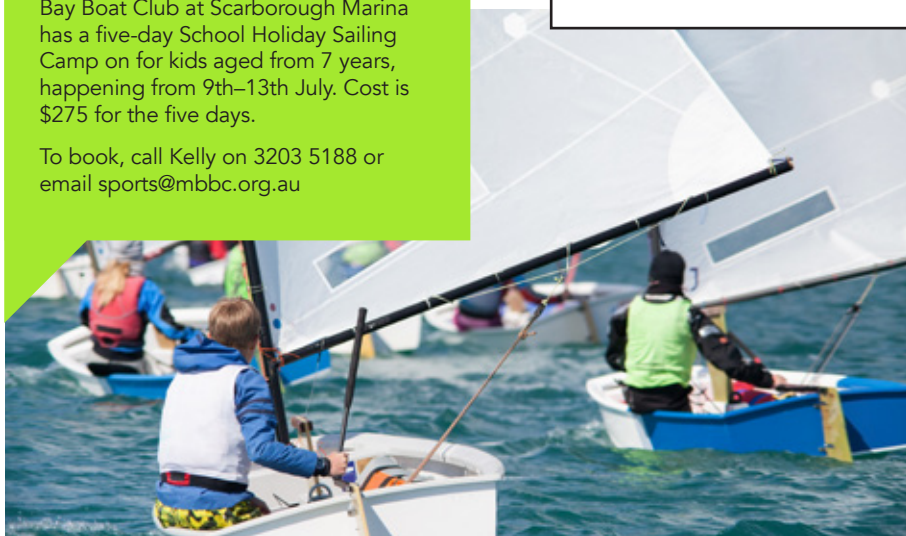

“ This year we are hoping to attract up to 60 senior entries, and we have already had commitments that suggest the junior fleet will be at least the same as last year,” he said.

"We have indications that we will have competitors from as far south as Forster and from Bundaberg in the north."

Members of the public can mingle with crews as they rig the boats for the races each morning, and boats will be visible along the Redcliffe coastline during the marathon on Sunday.

"On day two, the fleet is forced to go up the coast inside of the Garnet Rock light," David said.

"The sails on the water look spectacular from the shore."

"This regatta is a real test of mariner skills. Tides, seas, wind, and weather all have to be taken into account in this format if a person is to succeed."

## Early Redcliffe.

**A**lthough Redcliffe can claim bragging rights for becoming Queensland's first European settlement in 1824, it took another 38 years before permanent European settlement was established here.

In July 1862, Thomas Petrie purchased about 30 hectares, paying 54 pounds, fifteen shillings for the freehold title. Nine other people joined him at that sale, purchasing another 20 blocks of varying sizes for an additional 837 pounds. These land sales, initiated by the Queensland colonial government of what was called the Redcliffe Agricultural Reserve, continued up until April 1883. Around that period, records noted that there were at least thirty little townships on the Peninsula.

Although the government of the day saw the Peninsula as little more than a farming area, many later land purchasers had no intention of farming, and instead subdivided their land into smaller building blocks and created estates or mini townships with names like Humpybong,

Beaconsfield, Dover, Newhaven, Tramore, Williamstown, Sorrento, Whitecliffe and Belvedere. None of these estates survives today, most only remembered by streets named after them.

The 1880's was the period of the Peninsula's great land boom. The land speculators of this period promoted the eight kilometre Peninsula beach front from Scarborough to Woody Point as being as good as any seaside health resort in Britain or Europe. This was reinforced by a number of medical practitioners, and so the Redcliffe Peninsula enjoyed the unprecedented attention.

Sir James Garrick and Thomas Petrie can lay claim to being the first Europeans to discover the delights of the Peninsula as a seaside resort, resulting from regular picnic parties, which Garrick hosted in the 1870's. It is claimed that these events also resulted in the eventual construction of Redcliffe's first road, originally called Brisbane Road, now Anzac Avenue.

So in the space of 150 years or so, the Peninsula has grown from a few scattered farms with a population of just over 100 in the 1860's, to a modern, vibrant seaside location with a population of nearly 60,000.

The question is, what's next?

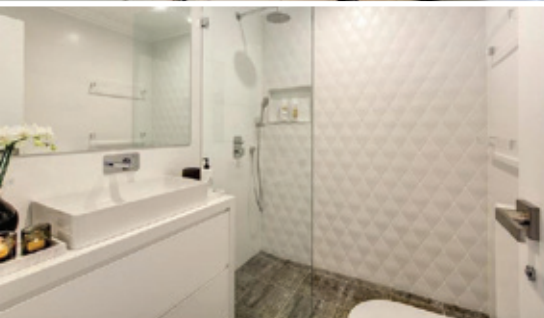

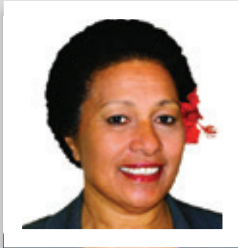

**A**lthough once inhabiting the entire peninsula, koalas can still be seen surprisingly close to the coast. There have been recent sightings in the neighbourhood of the Redcliffe Golf Course, as well as in the Nathan Road Wetlands area.

Koalas require a variety of eucalypt species in their home range in order to meet their dietary needs. Often this means they have to travel quite long distances. But sometimes that diversity can be found in a relatively small area, enabling a group to stay largely in one locality. This seems to be the case with our local populations, though it is possible they make their way westwards to other patches of bush.

The construction of the new Redcliffe Peninsula Rail Line had a dramatic impact on their habitat and ability to move about. Data suggests it was responsible for upwards of 280 fatalities during the three-year construction period.

Five dedicated fauna underpasses were installed by Queensland Rail along the length of the new train line. Unfortunately, cameras positioned at these underpasses were stolen, so there is minimal information about the usage of them by koalas or other wildlife. Other opportunities for crossings are facilitated by existing infrastructure such as drains and bridges.

It is possible that the two known groups close to the coast move and interact, either by using these crossings or by their own ingenuity; fraught with risky encounters with roads, dogs and other dangers.

While seemingly happy and healthy, these small groups will eventually suffer from problems associated with inbreeding, if they have no connection to other individuals for mating.

The Redcliffe Environmental Forum conducted a tree-planting day in 2016 at the end of Silcock St, Clontarf. Once the trees grow, they will provide additional food and shelter for the koalas in this vicinity.

Anyone living in areas where koalas are known to occur can assist their survival in a number of ways. Retaining existing eucalypts and making new plantings, watching out for them on the road, and keeping dogs inside at night will give them a better chance to succeed in urban environments.

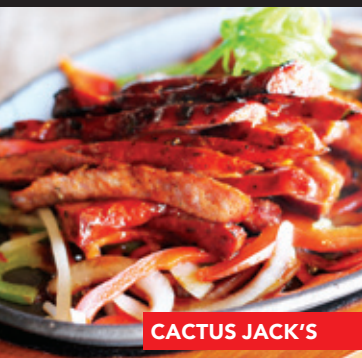

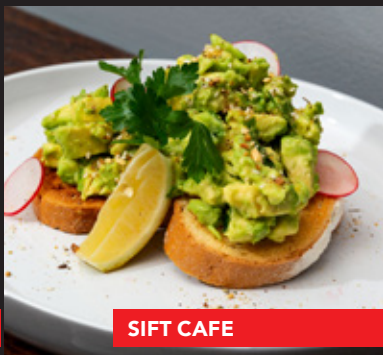

# Council Plans Big Spending in Bay Region

**M**oreton Bay Regional Council has announced spending on some big projects in the region in its 2018/19 budget. "This financial year Council will return an operating surplus of \$106 million which will be reinvested directly back into our community and into vital infrastructure," Council's Spokesperson for Corporate Services Matt Constance said.

Following a special Budget Meeting in early June, Councillor James Houghton announced funding for several projects in Division 5 over the year, including over \$2 million for a new art gallery and community space in Redcliffe, \$500,000 towards the Scarborough Red Cliffs preservation project, and a \$5.5 million investment in the peninsula's biggest greenspace project — the 16.6 hectare Nathan Road Sports Precinct.

The Sports Precinct marks a reinforcement of local government support for activities that many residents are involved in on a regular basis.

“It’s a great result for sport and recreation in our community, local clubs, the dedicated legion of fans who cheer them on and the entire community,” Cr Houghton said.

"Sport and recreation have been huge drivers of economic development in our region, and this project will be no different, with hundreds of jobs to be created during construction and an ongoing benefit for local retailers and accommodation providers, once complete."

While providing two senior-grade AFL playing fields, the precinct will also support the growth of other sports in the area. A multi-purpose field will cater to various codes, and the project will also provide a clubhouse, player and officials change rooms and a playground.

Existing fauna and flora at the planned location will be protected through the inclusion of a conservation wetland on the site.

For many years, rough seas and strong weather had battered the iconic red cliffs at Scarborough, the site named by Matthew Flinders as 'Red Cliff Point' when he passed the area in 1799.



# BIG PLANS



Concerning the council's decision to fund the preservation, Cr Houghton stated, "This investment will go towards the design and construction of a 380-metre long armour rock protection along the bottom of the cliffs to stabilise and protect the landmarks and Landsborough Avenue."

Council also plans to spend \$400,000 to upgrade the Moreton Bay Cycleway at Scarborough, between Kennedy Esplanade and Landsborough Avenue.



Many locals and visitors utilise the path along the Scarborough foreshore to access the park, local shops and other parts of the peninsula.

"This project will widen the footpath to 3m to improve user safety and bring it into line with the rest of the Moreton Bay Cycleway," says Cr Houghton.

In other funding, \$2.39m is marked for investment in Redcliffe's cultural hub, with the expansion and upgrade of the Redcliffe Library, relocation of the Redcliffe Art Gallery and construction of a community space at the Redcliffe Administration Centre.

# Tanks for the Memory

Australia has a well-documented and regularly displayed interest in our military history. We respectfully remember and covet our trials and triumphs that have occurred through numerous wars, and we've evolved as a nation as a result.

One such national memory recounts the Second Battle of Villers-Bretonneux in France in April of 1918. During this battle, the Germans deployed two-thirds of their tank armoury in the first tank-versus-tank battle in history.

One of these A7V German tanks, The Mephisto, is the only surviving German tank from World War One, and now resides at the Queensland Museum. On 31st July at the Redcliffe Library,

historians Jeff Hopkins-Weise and Greg Czechura will be presenting a detailed account of the story of the Mephisto to coincide with the release of their new book 'Mephisto: Technology, War and Remembrance.'

"In 2008 Jeff and I brought out a pocket book about the Mephisto for the Queensland Museum," Greg tells us. "We always thought that it needed a bigger book and we probably just continued working towards it. We wanted to give a pretty broad perspective on it, briefly look at the First World War, the Western Front and the scientific and technological advances that led to getting out of the trenches; the two main ones being the use of gas and tanks."

"We've seen around 80 years of real refinement in tank design, but the early tanks involve some weird concepts. We've tabulated everything we could find about prototypes and design proposals, and there's an incredible range of designs there." Greg said.

Their book and the presentation that Greg and Jeff will be bringing to the Redcliffe Library will appeal to a wide range of people with a variety of interests. "There's a huge audience for this material; anyone with a general interest in WWI or Australian history, people interested in the art, or developments in science and technology of the period, military historians, history buffs," Greg says. "We've pulled together a lot of stuff, and we're aiming at a really diverse range of people."

Council has sought expressions of interest from suitable contractors, and this necessary part of the process is now drawing to a conclusion.

Councillor for Division 6 and Spokesperson for Parks, Recreation and Sport Cr Koliana Winchester said Moreton Bay Regional Council's Expression Of Interest process closed last week.

"Council officers are currently reviewing the responses received and hope to have an announcement regarding the outcome of the EOI in coming weeks," Cr Winchester said.

Similar attractions currently exist on the Gold and Sunshine Coasts, and the park is expected to be a hit with not only residents but also with tourists travelling from near and far to visit.

At the time of publication, no specific information has been provided by Council regarding the anticipated timeline for the project, or whether we can look forward to making a splash at our own Inflatable Water Park by the time the warmer months arrive later this year.

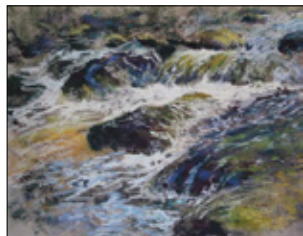

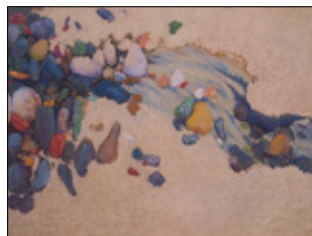

# Wild Palace:

## THE PALACE HOTEL'S PRIVATE ZOO

**M**r Harold Filmer purchased the Palace Hotel in 1926 for £4000. At this time Harold was a close friend of Mr Cavill, owner of Cavill's Hotel, Surfers Paradise. Mr Cavill had a zoo at the back of his hotel and probably had some influence on Mr Filmer establishing a zoo at the rear of his hotel at Woody Point in 1927.

# HISTORY

## THE REDCLIFFE ZOO

This zoo was owned by the Reid brothers and was situated approximately where the Redcliffe High School is today. It operated during the 1930s and early 1940s when it was closed as the brothers joined the armed forces for WW11.

It had emus, wallabies and big aviaries of parrots, etc. Mr Filmer would feed the birds and animals every day, and it was a sight to see the birds swarming over him.

The zoo was situated where the garages were later located and next to the woodshed where they cut and stored the wood for use in the kitchen.

The zoo closed about 1954 to make room for the extensions behind the hotel.

## MR AND MRS PERCY FROST'S PRIVATE ZOO

This zoo was located on the corner of Joseph Street and Dover Road, Margate. It was behind their home and occupied about 16 perches of land in Dover Road. The zoo had emus, wallabies, ponies and hundreds of birds. It was probably started during the 1920s and closed about 1964.

One of the attractions at this zoo was a large carpet snake and the visitors loved to have their photo taken with the snake around their body.

It was a popular zoo that attracted locals and visitors alike, having a large sign in Oxley Avenue proclaiming REDCLIFFE ZOO.

## SCARBOROUGH ZOO

This zoo was established after WW11 at the southern end of where the Southern Cross College is today. It was relocated in the mid-1950s from Cavill's Hotel in Surfers Paradise. It was simply referred to as the Scarborough Zoo, and its main feature was the magnificent butterfly collection. It was mainly snakes, birds and Australian animals. Mr Filmer of Woody Point could have influenced Mr Cavill to move his zoo to Redcliffe. It is not known if the star attraction at Surfers Paradise came to Scarborough. It was a six-legged cow!

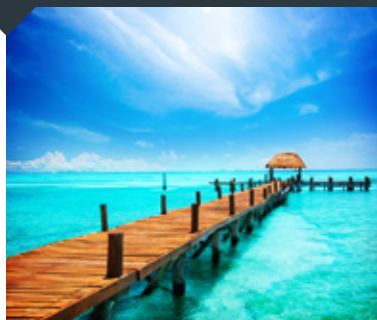

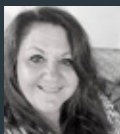

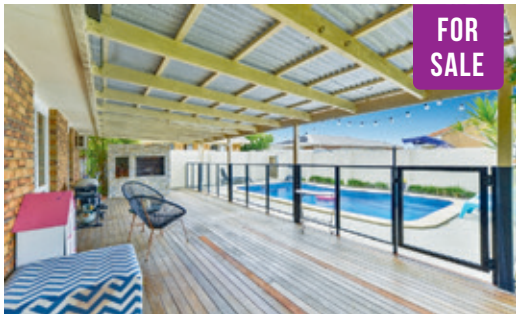
