KiteFest is back for 2018 and this time it's more colourful, exciting and **fun-packed** than ever.

Come along and fly your own kite, be amazed by kites of every shape and size, and experience the fast-paced and family-friendly entertainment at Pelican Park, Clontarf, on August 25 and 26.

This year, for the first time, KiteFest is taking the fun into the evening. When the sun sets, another party begins — KiteFest After Dark.

Illuminated kites, funky stage entertainment and a huge jet ski stunt show, topped off with a fireworks finale is in store for this year's brand-new night-time component.

Moreton Bay Region Industry and Tourism (MBRIT) chief executive Shane Newcombe is very excited for this year's event.

"Redcliffe KiteFest brings tens of thousands of people from all around South-East Queensland to the Moreton Bay Region. We're excited to show them the beauty of the local area," Mr Newcombe says.

"This year, the festival features a fantastic, all-new fireworks show on Saturday. It's sure to be a hit for everyone involved.

"Visitors have been asking for this sort of evening program for years and we've certainly delivered with KiteFest After Dark."

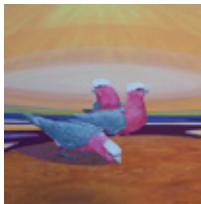

During both days of KiteFest, adrenaline junkies can enjoy Jet Ski stunt shows, aerobatic displays, live music and loads of live entertainment.

There are also many options to keep the whole family entertained for the weekend. Roving performers will travel around Pelican Park during the day, entertaining everyone they encounter.

"It's the ultimate kids' weekend. Kids can enjoy the range of low-cost activities and entertainment, all full of fun and colour," Mr Newcombe says.

Be amazed in the Kite Flying Arena, where the best kite-flyers from around the world will be dazzling crowds with their kites and skills from 9am to 4pm both days.

The Public Kite Flying Zone will welcome kite flyers of all ages to come and take to the sky above Pelican Park with homemade or store-bought kites during the weekend.

A kite-making workshop will be operating so if your little one hasn't brought along a kite, stop by and create one for \$5.

Kids will love the live shows by Justice League and PJ Masks on the main stage or visit Flutter the Fairy and the Magician at Fairy Land.

Festivalgoers can also soak up the best views of Bramble Bay when they sit and relax for a drink from the bar or snacks from various food vans.

Moreton Bay Regional Mayor Allan Sutherland says KiteFest is a spectacle that must be seen to be believed.

"Nothing captures a child's imagination like having their feet on the ground and their dreams in the clouds," Mr Sutherland says.

"This is an enormously popular event that I hope to see grow even bigger and brighter in the years to come, so come on down and enjoy the wonder."

Mr Sutherland says a highlight of the new evening program will be the illuminated and neon kite display dotting the night sky.

"What happens when a Jet Ski stunt show combines with a huge fireworks display? Well, you'll find out at KiteFest After Dark.

“**The incredible crew at the Redcliffe Kite Club have put together a night-time kite display with a neon twist, which will be a sight not to be missed.**

"And the evening will end on bang with a huge fireworks finale igniting over Moreton Bay."

Tickets are now on sale. Adults tickets \$10, children tickets \$5 and family passes (two adults and two children) \$25. Saturday's ticket is valid for entry into KiteFest and KiteFest After Dark.

Take the stress out of finding a park and head straight to the Redcliffe Showgrounds, where a free regular shuttle bus will be running between the festival all weekend.

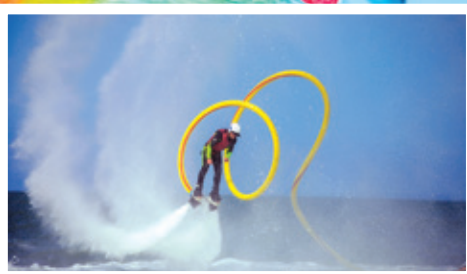

Redcliffe Rest Stop For Fur Seal

Our foreshore presented a perfect place to pause and rest recently, for a juvenile Fur Seal found on the rocks near the Redcliffe Lagoon.

Layne Mathers was working at the lagoon at the time. "I saw a lot of people gathered around so I came down to have a look, and there was a little fur seal coming out of the water; he climbed up and sat on the rock, and looked exhausted," Layne said. "He was there from around midday until 5pm and I just kept the crowd at bay. I'd finished work by then but I wasn't going home until I knew he was alright".

The Long Nose (New Zealand) Fur Seal has been known to visit our area before, notably in 2015 when a seal spent several days in and around the waters at Scarborough. Both New Zealand and Australian fur seals reside in cooler waters, and they are very similar creatures.

Mathew Davis, a marine scientist and founder of Australian Coastal and Marine Ecology, an environmental consultancy based in Scarborough, was called to attend the incident. "We were monitoring the animal and keeping in touch with the guys at RSPCA and the Department of Environment and Science. It's come in for a rest, quite exhausted; at the end of the day it just swam away."

"David will share how he was able to use DNA testing to unlock important links in his family tree and connect with relatives he mightn't have otherwise known.

"These events are always popular, so I encourage anyone interested in attending to book their place as soon as possible."

NEW MARINE RESEARCH VESSEL FOR OUR BAY

Australian Coastal and Marine Ecology, an environmental consultancy based in Scarborough, has recently launched a new research vessel, which will operate in and around the waters of Moreton Bay.

Mathew Davis, a marine scientist and the founder of Australian Coastal and Marine Ecology, says that the boat will provide a much-needed resource for the region.

"Sea World on the Gold Coast and Sea Life on the Sunshine Coast can act as first responders to marine fauna incidents, but until now there was really nothing in this part of the bay to deal with things like that," Mathew says. "In terms of marine research there is no limit to what we can do; fish surveys, coral surveys, seagrass monitoring, dugong and dolphin monitoring."

"The unique thing about our region is that we have just about every type of marine habitat that you could imagine right on our doorstep, and in my opinion, there is not enough research happening around this," Mathew says.

"We've got Moreton Bay Marine Park, Hays Inlet fish habitat area, Ramsar Wetlands — which are internationally protected wetland environments, lots of freshwater systems, Wallum Froglet habitat and other protected areas. It's all right here. We've got one of the largest populations of dugong in the world; there's huge data collection opportunities in that alone."

With such a rapid population growth in the Moreton Bay area of south-east Queensland, it's important that our understanding of the impacts of such development on the environment also continues to grow. Mathew sees his business, including the new research vessel, as being in a great position to contribute to this knowledge.



We're not activists and we're not interested in getting in the way of development because it is essential; we just know that we can do it better," Mathew said.

"We want to be known for providing this type of environmental support locally. My goal is to establish a world-class marine science centre here in Scarborough, including rehabilitation facilities for turtles and other marine wildlife that need it."

We hope that Mathew's goal becomes a reality one day soon, and we can all learn more about our wonderful waters of Moreton Bay!

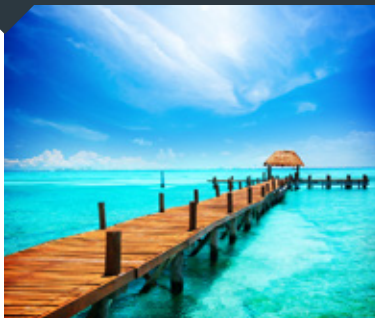

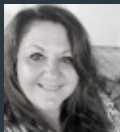

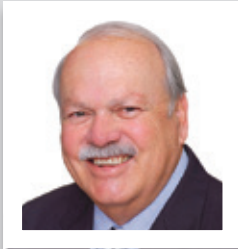

1 Keep your Hearing Aid Clean and Dry Daily

For the hearing aid to function properly, there must be no obstruction in the sound input (microphone) or in the sound outlet. Very often an obstruction is caused by earwax or moisture issues. The Arts and Crafters Market is hosted by Moreton Bay Arts Council (MBAC) and will be held at the historic Old Redcliffe Fire Station hub on Saturday, August 4. Moreton Bay Arts Council president Janice Charlish says the market is a great chance to support local artists, crafters and performers.

The market runs 10am to 3pm and includes 30 market stalls and crafters tables on the lawn of the refurbished community arts hub on Oxley Avenue.

Janice says 20 of the stallholders are local talent from the Redcliffe and Moreton Bay region including painters, potters, wood crafters, jewellers, textile artists, mosaic, shell art, knitters and more.

Redcliffe Arts Society will open its studio doors and gift shop and present a new exhibition in their gallery.

Redcliffe Pottery group will also open their studios and shop. Back by popular demand is the group's limited-edition offer of \$10 soup in a bowl (you keep the bowl).

“ This is a great way to support artists and crafters and help them to become sustainable,” Janice says. “You can meet the makers and find great, affordable gifts for yourself or a friend.”

In addition to markets, there will be several arts demonstrations running throughout the day.

“Redcliffe Art Society members will be demonstrating in the open studio and selling their work,” she says.

“Artist Christina Coetzee will be putting on a first-time demonstration of drawing with a Cola Pen.”

Market goers will also have the chance to sign up for a Yarn Bombing a Tree project with MBAC.

“Yarn bombing's main motivation is to bring life, warmth, and a feeling of belonging and community,” Janice says.

“As a starting point, we will gain permission to cover a tree trunk with knitted or crocheted squares.”

You don't need to know how to knit or crochet, simply attend a workshop at Redcliffe Jetty creative space once a month, starting August 18.

The first project will be presented at the next market on November 24.

While wondering the markets you can stop to enjoy choir performances and dance along to the Hillbilly Bush Band.

Food, including a sausage sizzle, waffles, pancakes, cakes, fudge and hot and cold drinks will be on sale.

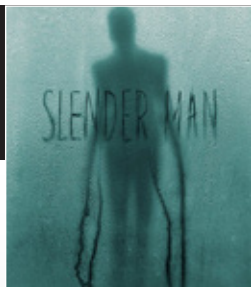

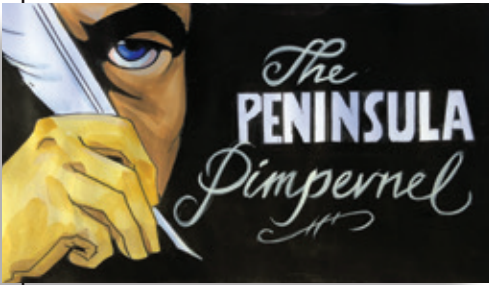

The Elusive Royal Charter.

The interest in the search for the solution into the loss of Redcliffe's City status has generated a good deal of local interest. At the centre of this interest is the existence of a Royal Charter, which allegedly granted Redcliffe it's city status in 1959. In that year, HRH Princess Alexandra, as part of a tour of Queensland, visited Redcliffe and as legend goes, presented the Mayor of Redcliffe Town Council with a Royal Charter, proclaiming Redcliffe as a City.

But despite initial enquiries, no one seems to know where the Royal Charter is located.

Redcliffe lost it's city status in 2008 when the State government amalgamated the Redcliffe City Council with the Pine Rivers and Caboolture Shires. The Royal Charter's importance lies in the possibility that a government cannot overrule the Charter's power, once it has been granted. Thus Redcliffe's city status would remain intact.

Nevertheless, three Redcliffe individuals have worked tirelessly to find the whereabouts of the elusive Charter. The first, Cr. James Houghton, whose father Jim, was Mayor of Redcliffe in 1959 searched Council and Redcliffe Museum records. Scarborough barrister John Jones searched the United Kingdom's Privy Council website examining over a thousand or so royal charter grants. Margate photographer Barry Tuton spent two days scanning the internet and scoured copies of 1959 Redcliffe Herald newspapers and government gazettes of the same period.

However preliminary results, suggest that the Royal Charter is going to be harder to find than first thought. Barrister Jones' long search for our Redcliffe charter, drew a blank. To cause further confusion, Barry Tuton found a report in the June 1959 edition of the Queensland Government Gazette, which stated that Redcliffe was granted city status by the Governor of Queensland.

What has become of the elusive Royal Charter? Did it ever exist or was it just an old wives tale? Or is there a more sinister reason behind its alleged disappearance?

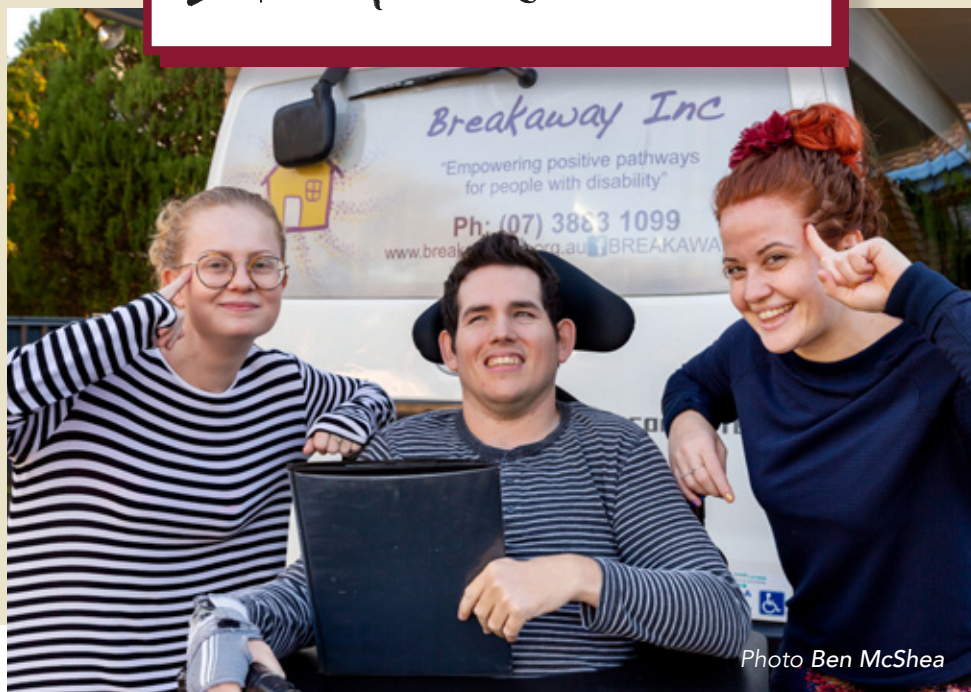
