See the big rigs line up to support children with life-limiting conditions and their families, when the 9th annual Brisbane Convoy for Kids rolls into Redcliffe on 3rd November.

All money raised from this year's event, which starts at Forest Lake and finishes with a Family Fun Day at the Redcliffe Showgrounds, will be donated to Hummingbird House. This hospice in Chermside provides end-of-life care, support, moments and memories to kids who need it and their families.



Steven Rowley, President of the Brisbane Convoy for Kids executive committee, has seen the event grow over the time that he has been involved. "It's grown hugely over the last couple of years and last year was amazing; we managed to donate \$40,000, and we are hoping to raise more money with an even bigger event this year," Steven says. "There were 420 trucks and 40 other vehicles in 2017, and we're aiming for more than 500 trucks this year."

The convoy will reach the Deagon Deviation between 9:30 and 10am before following the foreshore towards the showgrounds. People are encouraged to wear the theme colour of jade, and line the foreshore to watch the spectacular sight of up to 10km of pristine trucks, utes, vintage cars and motorcycles passing by.

Everyone is welcome at the Family Fun Day from around noon. The huge Truck and Ute Show will be the main attraction, and visitors can also enjoy free rides, a licensed bar, food trucks, auctions, market stalls, live local entertainment and a fireworks display in the evening!

General Manager of Hummingbird House, Dr Fiona Hawthorne, says, "The convoy of rigs and

Local community group Pine Rivers Musical Association Incorporated (PRIMA) are staging a lavish musical production of the Oscar-winning film, *Shrek*, to the Redcliffe Cultural Centre this October. And it promises to be a hit with audience members of all ages.

PRIMA President, Stacie Hobbs explained the differences between the movie that audiences know and love, and the musical she has lovingly crafted for the stage.

"It's a musical based on the original movie, and follows the original plot, but with awesome and heartfelt songs," Stacie said.

"I think [it] is actually better than the movie, [because] there is such an incredible theme of accepting yourself and others for who they are."

The process of producing and rehearsing a musical is a huge task, with many different cast members to manage, costumes to source and sets to create.

"This show has so many crazy characters, it's been such fun watching our cast discover their version of all of the zany fairy-tale characters.

"It's also a big show to produce, with hundreds of costume pieces involved, so it's a full-scale production and all stations go for the whole time!"

Featured in the experienced cast are seasoned musical theatre actors; including Nathaniel Currie who will play Shrek, and Lucy Bardsley as the



beautiful Princess Fiona. And there isn't a Shrek without Donkey, with actor Zach Price working hard to fill Eddie Murphy's inimitable role.

Stacie's favourite moment in the production is a song called "I Think I've Got You Beat".

"[It's] a duet between Shrek and Fiona fighting about whose life is worse than the other," Stacie said.

"It's both devastating and hilarious, and it really builds upon their relationship far more than the movie."

Stacie described the timeless appeal of this modern classic, explaining, "Shrek is that perfect combination; it's something kids will love, but parents will enjoy it just as much."

"I think there is such a lot of love for Shrek, as I know how much I loved it as a kid when it came out, and I love it just as much now!"

Softball Queensland Masters Tournament set to return to the Moreton Bay Region in 2019 and 2020

Over 3,000 visitors will make their way to the Moreton Bay region when Redcliffe Softball Association hosts the 20th annual Softball Queensland Masters Tournament.

The tournament is one of Australia's largest single sport participation events for Masters, and will see over 1,800 competitors and over 1,500 spectators converge on the peninsula.

The scale of the tournament is so extensive that it will be held across a number of venues in the complex at Talobilla Park.

Over a hundred teams from across Australia competed in the 2018 tournament, with similar numbers expected for the following years.

Softball Queensland's General Manager Sue Nisbet said that the tournament is a fantastic opportunity for our masters' softballers to get together in both a competitive and social environment.

"The Softball Queensland Masters Tournament presents an annual opportunity for our wider softball community to reconnect with each other and also celebrate the game that they love to play so much.

"We sincerely thank Moreton Bay Regional Council for supporting Softball and this event, and also the other sporting organisations for providing their facilities, ensuring the tournament is held in this region."

The softball fields at Talobilla Park are named after Betty Paxton (OAM), who had an active role in the inception of Redcliffe and Districts Softball Association and has volunteered tirelessly for the organisation.

Moreton Bay Regional Council's Spokesperson for Parks, Recreation and Sport, Councillor Koliana Winchester, said council was thrilled that

the region was named home of the 2019 and 2020 Softball Queensland Masters Tournament.



This announcement reinforces our region’s ability to secure major sporting events and competitions and we owe it to our investment in developing top-notch venues,” Cr Winchester said.

Division 5 Councillor James Houghton said the 2018/19 Budget was about investing now to ensure future generations would continue to enjoy our region’s active and healthy lifestyle.

“I know locals will make every player, official and spectator attending the Softball Queensland Masters Tournament feel so welcomed in Moreton Bay that they’ll want to come back every year,” Cr Houghton said.

Melanie Meatheringham, the owner and instructor of Aquaventures, began offering the course as a way to harness kids' adventurous energy and give them a taste of a sport they could enjoy for the rest of their lives.

"I wanted to get more kids into scuba diving," Melanie said.

"It is such a great sport and great for building confidence.

"It opens up a whole world of adventure and I really believe it's a great hobby for kids to be involved in."

The try-dive experiences run for approximately one hour. This gives kids an opportunity to learn all about the equipment that scuba divers use, as well as experience what it's like to breathe and swim underwater.

"[The experience is] pool-based and gives kids the opportunity to learn the skills a scuba diver

would learn and also have lots of fun and play games underwater,” Melanie said.

Children aged 8 and over can discover what it's like to take their first breath underwater and be weightless like an astronaut.

The many benefits of scuba diving are well-documented, such as the obvious benefits to physical health and mental wellbeing, but children in particular can develop a lifelong passion for marine conservation and become real champions for how best to preserve our beautiful waterways.

Melanie outlined the traits of the children who generally get the most out of the experience.

“Kids with a sense of adventure, looking to take part in a non-competitive sport and those with a love of the ocean,” Melanie said.

The Bubblemaker sessions will be held at Dolphins Health Precinct in October. In addition to this course, Aquaventures offer a range of different sessions and courses for children, adults and even families.

“We offer snorkel and scuba diving session for kids, and can also do family and adult programs on request,” Melanie said.

“During the Seal Team [course] we have two hour long session every day for five days.

“Each day we learn new underwater skills and have lots of fun and games.”

With tickets selling out in minutes the last time the course was offered, you had better act quickly to snap up a space at this popular activity!

We are lucky to live in a very special part of the world. However, did you know our community is about to celebrate a silver anniversary?

The 25th anniversary of the Ramsar Convention in Moreton Bay!

Ramsar? That sounds like one of those tech terms—but Ramsar is actually a town in Iran – so why would we be celebrating that? Let me explain.

In the 60s and 70s, global concern started to grow around the loss and degradation of wetland habitat for migratory birds. In 1971,

DID YOU KNOW?

Mangroves store up to 50 times more carbon than most trees, they help stabilise the shoreline and are important in filtering nutrients and pollutants. Moreton Bay's Ramsar sites are home to around eight Australian species of mangroves.

Australia was one of seven nations to sign an agreement to conserve and wisely use wetlands across the globe. This happened in the small Iranian town of Ramsar – hence Ramsar Convention. Since then, 90% of all countries have signed up.

Why is this important? This beautiful blue-green jewel we live on is interconnected in ways we would not even imagine...

Take for example, the Red-necked Stint. This tiny migratory shorebird weighs just 30 grams, and completes a 25,000 km round trip to sit-out the Siberian winter in Moreton Bay. Can you imagine that? An amazing, seemingly fragile species, flies half way around the world, to rest and feed in our own backyard.

These international visitors can be found in Moreton Bay from October to March, alongside

the Alaskan Bar-tailed Godwit (flying non-stop across the Pacific to get here) to take up residence alongside our own home-grown Pied Oystercatcher.

And these birds are just part of the reason Redcliffe Environmental Forum (REF) is celebrating in a big way – cue the Moreton Bay Wetlands Expo.

Moreton Bay gained Ramsar status in 1993, so to highlight this 25th anniversary and celebrate our beautiful bay, REF has gathered together the crème de la crème of enviro people for an Expo.

So, on Sunday, 21st October, head to Deception Bay and take a wetlands walk with University of Queensland experts, hear talks by scientists from the Department of Environment and Science, and chat with volunteers from Wildlife Queensland, Coralwatch and around a dozen other exhibitors. It promises to be a feast for the senses, with touch tanks, marine audio experiences, and great activities for the kids.

Female Black- and Grey-headed flying foxes are in the final stages of pregnancy regionally and are expected to give birth during October and November. Upon advice from Council's nominated flying fox expert (Dr

Les Hall), Council will cease any new works or high-impact activities, such as weed tree removal in or adjacent roost areas until around April 2019, or until juveniles are considered independent.

However, where low-impact maintenance such plant watering and monthly weed control have been scheduled at colonies regionally, these activities will continue provided no undue disturbance is caused to the colony. Environmental Services will continue the monitoring counts throughout this period and liaise with residents adjacent to colonies. The latest colony data is available at www.moretonbay.qld.gov.au/flyingfoxmonitoring. On the same note, Council conducts yearly Ibis controls, which includes the removal of nests and eggs, but no chicks are disturbed. I point out to residents that Ibises are protected under the State Wildlife Legislation, but can be moved on. The easiest way for this to occur is to remove the food source, so once again I urge residents not to feed these foragers.

From 1st November this year, Queenslanders can return their recyclable drink bottles and cans to earn 10c refunds. With 2.4 billion containers used in Queensland each year, everyone has an opportunity to benefit

The company appointed to run the Container Refund Scheme, not-for-profit group Container Exchange, have implemented 230 refund points ahead of 1st November.

This scheme will reduce the impact of plastics and waste on our environment, which is particularly good news for Moreton Bay and our regions wetlands.

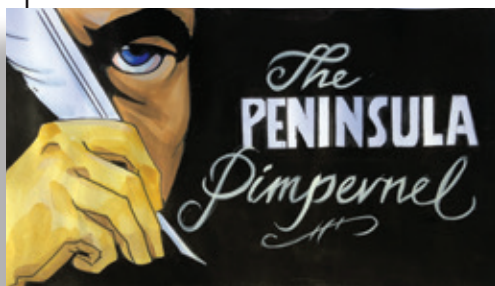

The 194th anniversary of the birth of the first European baby in Queensland has just passed. The baby, Amity Moreton Thompson, was born in an army tent near the mouth of Redcliffe's Humpybong Creek on 21st September, 1824. Her mother, Mary Thompson, was the wife of Robert Hay Thompson, a soldier in His Majesty's 40th Foot Regiment, which had been sent to establish a convict settlement there.

A male child, Charles Moreton Miller, born to the settlement commandant Lieutenant Henry Miller was the second and last European child to be born at the fledgling settlement, as the Red Cliff Point location was abandoned a few months later, in favour of Brisbane.

News of the two births greeted the New South Wales governor Sir Thomas Brisbane on his visit to the settlement. Legend has it that he was so pleased with news of the births that he granted each of the children five hundred acres of Peninsula land. Neither the Millers nor the Thompsons are known to have taken up the governor's generous offer, before permanently leaving the colony.

However in 1889, Amity, then aged sixty-five and living in England, wrote to the Secretary for Public Lands in Queensland, enquiring about her granted 500 acres. On checking the records, officials couldn't find any trace of grants being given to either Amity Thompson or Charles Miller.

Recently, Margate's Barry Tuton and fellow Ipswich historian Sharon Racine tracked down Sheila Barton, who is a direct descendant of Amity Thompson. Sheila would like to know whether the story of the grants was fact or fiction. The mystery of the grants remains unsolved.

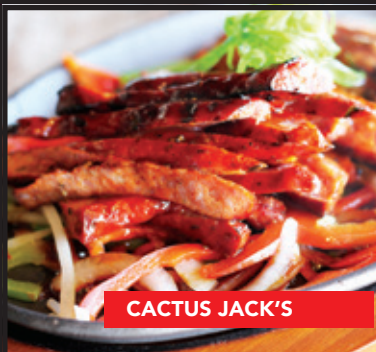

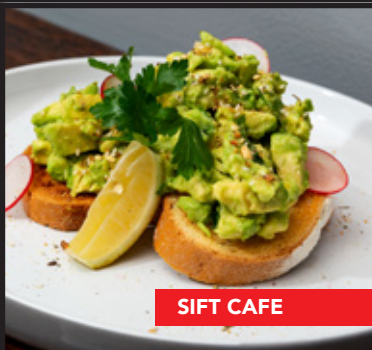

MUSICIANS WANTED FOR ANZAC DAY MARCHING BAND

Major Keith Hampton is putting the call out to all musicians who want to play in the 2019 Redcliffe Anzac Day marches.

When Keith attended his first Anzac Day in Redcliffe earlier this year, he was surprised there were no marching bands.

"I've never been in a march with no band. I was surprised considering the size of the marches and the services. The Redcliffe services are a wonderful expression of Anzac Day and remembrance."

"As a musician, I missed the marching beat."

Keith, who took up the role of Corps Officer at Redcliffe Salvation Army in January, approached Redcliffe RSL and offered to get a band together for next year's marches.

"I'm organising the Anzac Day Peninsula Band for the two Anzac day marches next year," Keith said.

"We already have 10 people who have expressed interest, so another 20 or 30 would be most welcome. We are inviting members of school bands and people in the community to come along and learn to march if they haven't marched before.

"We are going to rehearse for two hours on the first Saturday of each month, starting on October 6 at 10am, at Redcliffe Salvos, Ashmore Road. We'll march around the carpark.

"If you own a large instrument and want to march with a smaller one, we have plenty that you can use. Thanks to Redcliffe RSL, we've got two new marching snare drums, marching symbols and a marching bass drum.

"We're looking for any marching instruments but I've called it a band and not a brass band because it could be a concert band; one guy plays the saxophone.

"If you're a bit rusty, you can come along and practice. We've got until Anzac Day to get it right," Keith said. "As musicians, it's the least we can do."

Redcliffe RSL secretary Bill Stowers said Redcliffe RSL has had several bands to assist with Anzac Day marches over the years, including Ye Olde RSL Memorial Band, who plays at the services but can no longer march.

"Redcliffe RSL supports this endeavour [Anzac Day Peninsula Band] and has purchased some instruments for the band. We look forward to this project being a success," Bill said.

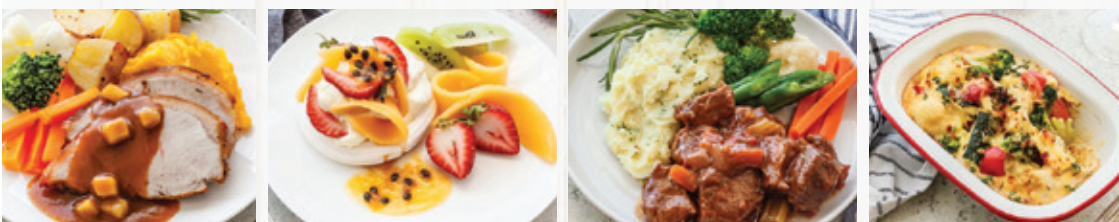



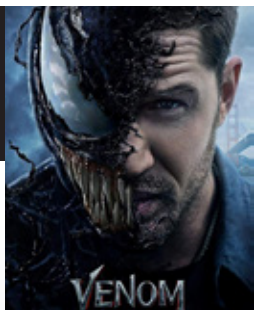
The Redcliffe Little Athletics Club meets for competition every Friday night at Langdon Park, Margate. Athletes also get the chance to compete in carnivals and regional events.

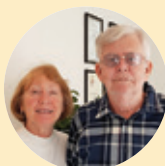

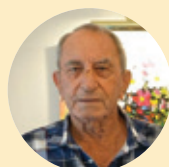
