Queens Beach North in Scarborough will play host to the inaugural Brissie Big Air Kiteboarding Competition.



**F**or the first time on the Peninsula, male and female competitors of all ages will be able to test their skills and courage in this new event which plans to become an annual competition on the Peninsula.

David De Witt — president of Kiteboarding QLD and NT Inc. says, "We are thrilled to be staging this event in Scarborough where we are pretty sure the conditions will allow for some spectacular action for the competitors as well as for the spectators to watch."

The sport of kiteboarding is certainly attracting competitors of different generations - the youngest competitor is just eleven years old and the most senior is in his late sixties.

During the event, competitors will have ten minutes in each round to show off their skills.

Kiteboarding is known for its amazing aerial jumps and, in this event, competitors' leaps will be measured by a high-tech device called a 'WOO'. The current world record is an incredible 28.9 m above the water.

David de Witt adds, "If we get the right conditions, I expect that this world record could be broken."

Kiteboarding is now an official Olympic sport, and featured in the latest Youth Olympics held in Argentina in this year.

It surely won't be long before this high adrenalin, action-packed sport will feature in the main Olympics Games.

There are over three thousand registered kiteboarders across Australia. In case you're wondering why it is called 'kiteboarding' versus 'kitesurfing', well it's one of those technical things.

As David de Witt explains, "Back in the day, there was plenty of conjecture over the name. Many of us migrated into the sport from Windsurfing, so I guess that's where the kitesurfing label came from. We are well and truly 'kiteboarders' these days."

Be sure to get down to Ocean Beach North, Scarborough on 10th November\* from 12pm to 4pm to check out the spectacular sport of kiteboarding and to find out for yourself, if that world record is actually broken.

**\* This event is weather dependant and will be held on the first windy day, either 10, 11, 17, 18, 24 or 25 November.**

# RENT IS RISING ON THE PENINSULA

**R**edcliffe Musical Theatre are performing the Pulitzer Prize and Tony Award winning musical *RENT* at Studio 102, Redcliffe in November.

The show is co-directed by company president, Madeleine Johns and Jean Bowra, who directed the highly successful Mod Musical 'DOWNTOWN' earlier this year.

The story of *RENT* follows a year in the life of a group of impoverished young artists and musicians struggling to survive and to be creative in New York's Lower East Side, under the shadow of HIV and AIDS. It covers a wide variety of contemporary themes including love, sacrifice, mortality, addiction, overcoming adversity and paying the rent.

If this sounds slightly familiar to classical buffs it's because *Rent* is loosely-based on Puccini's famous opera, 'La Boheme'. The idea for the musical came from playwright Billy Aronson and he collaborated with Jonathon Larson, who wrote the music and lyrics. *Rent* opened in a small New York theatre, in 1996, and despite Jonathon Larson's sudden death, the musical was a hit with the audience and critics alike, and soon moved to Broadway, where it is still running.

"This is theatre at its best – exuberant, passionate and joyous."

Jonathon Sweeper, well-known for playing the title role in 'Barnum', portrays Mark Cohen in *Rent*. Mark narrates the story in *rent* and is a struggling Jewish-American documentary filmmaker. His roommate, Roger Davis, is a once successful, but now struggling musician. Jesse Ainsworth plays this ex-lead singer, rock guitarist who is also HIV positive and a recovering junkie. His love interest, Mimi Marquez, is played by Rebel Bliss. Eric Illustre plays the anarchist professor, Tom Collins.

*Rent* has become a pop-cultural phenomenon, with songs that rock and a story that resonates with audiences of all ages. The production team will pay homage to its realism by telling this story with truth, dignity and realism.

# Remembering the fallen

**I**t's been 100 years since the guns fell silent on Europe's Western Front, at the end of the First World War.

Known at the time as the Great War, it remains one of the costliest conflicts for Australia.

"From a population of fewer than five million, 416,809 men enlisted, of whom more than 60,000 were killed and 156,000 wounded, gassed, or taken prisoner." (source: [www.awm.gov.au/articles/atwar/first-world-war](http://www.awm.gov.au/articles/atwar/first-world-war)).

The sacrifice of those who gave their lives has not been forgotten and the centenary of the signing of the Armistice will be commemorated with an event at Jamieson Park, Scarborough on Saturday, November 10 from 10am.

Redcliffe RSL vice-president Cheryl Barrett says this year is a significant anniversary.

"It's so important to mark this occasion," she says.

"All those young men, if they didn't go (to war) we wouldn't be the country that we are today."

"Really, we are living on the back of their trauma and it's important that we always remember that — especially for young people to realise that nothing is ever free; everything has a price."

The commemoration event will feature a re-enactment of the signing of the Armistice treaty by students from Grace Lutheran College, an aerial "dog fight" with planes from the era and a skirmish demonstration by re-enactors from Fort Lytton.

Cheryl continues: "There will also be four canon shots fired to commemorate the Armistice signing," Cheryl said.

"We'll have static displays from the cadets, we'll have bell tents there set up like a World War I camp, old vehicles and the Rising Suns army band.

"A Major-General from Enoggera Barracks will be there and a Group Captain from Amberley."

The Light Horse Association and the French Foreign Legion Association will also take part in the day.

The Redcliffe RSL will host its usual Remembrance Day service the following day, Sunday, November 11, at 10.45am at Anzac Place, Redcliffe Parade, Redcliffe.

"We wanted to have this big event on the Saturday, so that everyone could still go to their normal Remembrance Day services on the Sunday," Cheryl said. "We hope everyone in the community will come along."

# Hot Rods for the Homeless

**W**hat's that rumble in the distance? It's the sound of all the hot rods roaring their way to the Redcliffe Showgrounds for Hot Rods for the Homeless!

Hot Rods for the Homeless is a car and bike show to be held at the Redcliffe Showgrounds on Saturday 24th November.

CEO of the event, Rohan Robertson, is looking forward to welcoming over 250 participants and 1000 visitors to the showgrounds.

Rohan is excited to share the incredible vehicles, talented bands, and exciting range of food trucks with all the visitors to the show.

"The spectators can walk around the display vehicles and talk to the owners about their vehicles," Rohan explained.

"We will also be having raffles and auctions on the day."

With many trophies and prizes to be awarded, for categories such as Best Muscle Car, Best Hot Rod, and Best Club Display, there is sure to be plenty to enjoy, for spectators of all ages.

"The event is run entirely by volunteers, to support the homeless in our community," Rohan explains.



"[It] is fully funded prior to the day and all of the money raised at the event, goes directly to the cause.

"The Breakfast Club is run by an amazing team of volunteers, who use fundraising events, such as Hot Rods For The Homeless and donations, to buy food for meals and to pay the rent for their hall and storage facility."

The Breakfast Club is a volunteer-run organisation that provides a very important service to the Redcliffe area. It relies on the kindness of the community to assist with their mission to help the homeless in the local area.

"The Breakfast Club has been running successfully for almost thirteen years and currently serves around 1,500 meals a month," Rohan said.

"Guests can enjoy a full, cooked breakfast and beverages — all for free. Some of the guests are homeless, others are on low or fixed incomes and struggle to make their money stretch.

"[The] Breakfast Club offers much more than food. For many guests, the most important thing is the chance to mix with other people in a friendly and welcoming atmosphere."

Although this year marks the first Hot Rods for the Homeless event, there are plans to run it annually.

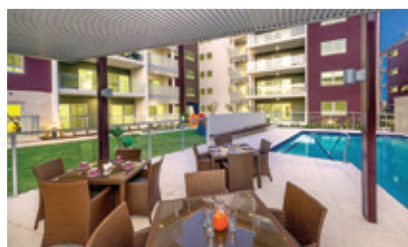

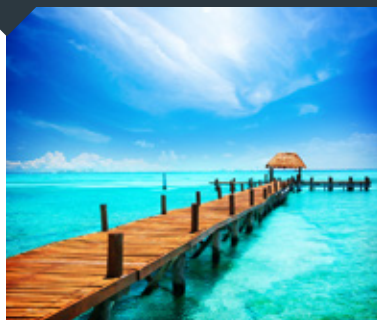

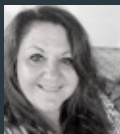

# PAVING THE WAY:

SCARBOROUGH'S MILLION-DOLLAR REDESIGN



**P**lans to rejuvenate the Scarborough streetscape are a wrap as the Moreton Bay Council puts on the finishing design touches for the near million-dollar makeover of the northern end of Landsborough Avenue between Bunton and Rock Streets.

Following community calls for the update and extensive input in March, the Council planning team



merged two prior design options into Option 3 which was presented at the final community consultation, in September.

Division 5 Councillor, James Houghton, expects the update will cause the region's 3.6 million annual visitors to take notice while energising local businesses.

"I'm thrilled to be announcing that Scarborough will get a fresh, new feel, following community concerns about the safety and aesthetic of Landsborough Avenue.

"These works will include coastal tree plantings, new seating and pathways, a new landscaped median strip, and the construction of new parking bays — which is great news for locals and visitors alike," Cr Houghton said.

The \$965,000 upgrade will also feature a new pathway with a raised pedestrian crossing from the corner of the Pirate playground and park across to the carpark and facilities.

Work will include the removal of old planters and will substitute uneven pavement with exposed aggregate and coloured concrete finishes that will match work already undertaken on the southern end of Landsborough Avenue. Other improvements include new street furniture, lighting and upgraded wayfinding signs.

After a contentious community debate on how to best maximise parking, Cr Houghton explained that the "nose in" option should win the day over "reverse in," citing the need to be consistent with the rest of the street which is either "nose in" or "nose to tail". To allow for the extended parking, the plans will move the Translink bus stop further south.

"We've consulted broadly with the community and business owners about what they want to see, the works they thought were needed, and we received plenty of comments and opinions, which will help to inform the final design," Cr Houghton said.

Council plans to complete the design work by the end of 2018 with construction split into stages to minimize traffic disruption. The Foreshore path and carpark upgrades are to be delivered mid-next year before Christmas with the second phase commencing during the 2019/2020 financial year.

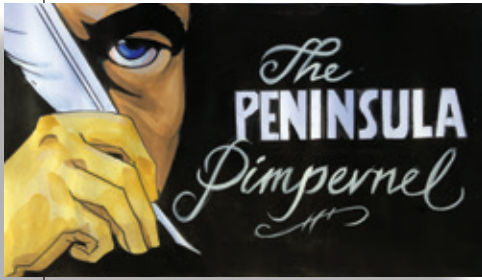

# Millennium Magic

**A**round the turn of the millennium and a couple of years beyond, a cultural excitement gripped the Peninsula. The new Redcliffe City Art Gallery had just opened and the standard of local art and craft work was far exceeding all expectations. Redcliffe artists of all persuasions were winning awards and prizes, like never before. This excitement translated into the community and the lead role, which until then had been taken by Council, was in danger of being overshadowed by new innovative art and craft events, planned and organised by passionate locals, keen to put Redcliffe, front and centre on the national stage.

Rod Sherwin, together with his team of unpaid volunteers, operating from the picturesque Scarborough Fair Art Gallery, was one of the first to run a series of major art exhibitions. Rosslyn and Doug Kennedy with their volunteer team continued the hype, at their Seaside Artists Gallery in Beach Street Kippa-Ring. Woody Point, with the Jasu Gallery artists volunteer group, headed by matriarch Lola McFarlane, added to the exciting mix.

Complementary to this, was the first ever international crafts event to be held on the Peninsula. The 2001 City of Redcliffe

Excellence in Craft Awards was organised, run and largely paid for by the late Joe Hurst and volunteers. It attracted an international and local field of superb craft persons with 130 entries, competing for \$15,000 in prize money, an Australian record amount at the time. In 2003, the Redcliffe Arts and Entertainment Awards and Festival, a week-long, five venue celebration of both the visual and performing local arts and crafts, attracted record participation and was another successful event organised by unpaid volunteers.

All of these activities show how local artists, the community and the business world, with the support of Council, can combine to present extraordinarily high quality, satisfying activities, with minimal resources. Whilst the Moreton Bay Regional Council has now handed over most of its cultural and entertainment activities to MBRIT, it is important for the Council to continue to support and maintain its traditional connection with grassroots volunteer group representatives, such as the Moreton Bay Arts Council, the Redcliffe Art Society etc. Whilst money does help the wheels to turn, nothing can replace the dedication, effort and performance generated from true community volunteering.

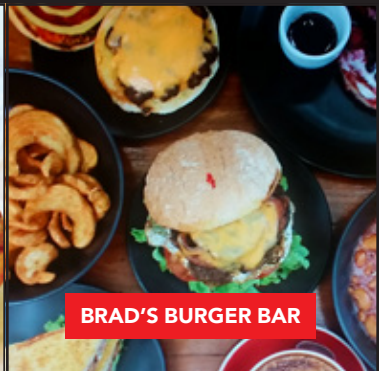

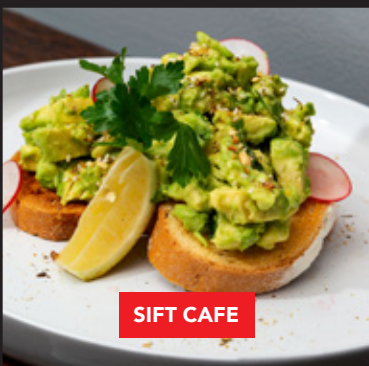

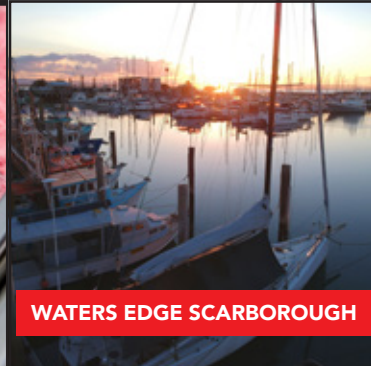

# Beyond Redcliffe

It's great to live in such a beautiful place as the Redcliffe region, but sometimes we all get the urge to wander. Luckily, South East Queensland has its own world of wonderful places to visit and they are right on our doorstep!

**I**f you're looking for a break but don't want to go too far, in just over an hour you can drive to a beautiful part of the Scenic Rim of Brisbane, Mount Tamborine. The name comes from an Anglicised version of the Aboriginal word 'jambreen', which refers to the native finger lime trees that grow in the area.

Detlef Hasenbein is a sustainable tourism advocate, who works with many Mt Tamborine tourism enterprises, through his business and website 'Discover Tamborine Mountain'.

Detlef tells us, "Not many people know that we were the first area in Queensland to become a National Park; that was in 1908. At the time most people didn't really know what national parks were about, so timber getting and agriculture continued in the park until the mid-thirties."

For coffee, food and wine buffs the Mt Tambourine town and region is a real gem; with an abundance of cafés, restaurants and wineries nearby, but the real appeal of the area are the

forests, streams and waterfalls, found in the surrounding national parks.

"It all depends what people come here for; some people come for the wineries and some people come for the bushwalking," Detlef says. "If you want to see waterfalls the number one would have to be Curtis Falls, it's easy to get to – just a twenty minute walk, and it's absolutely beautiful."

There's plenty of wildlife to see in the area, particularly around dusk and dawn, including the wonderful Albert's Lyrebird, marsupials such as pademelons and kangaroos, and many interesting lizards, birds and insects.

Mt Tamborine offers a complete escape, and it's not far from home. See glow worms in their natural cave habitat, take a walk high in the trees on the Rainforest Boardwalk, or visit some wineries, a brewery, even a distillery!

You could also simply pack a picnic and the family and settle in for a quiet afternoon in a park, just because it's good to escape sometimes!

# EASTERN OSPREYS- FEATHERED FISHERFOLK

**I**t's that time of year when an innate cue from Mother Nature urges birds to build nests and seek mates.

In the case of the Eastern Osprey (*Pandion cristatus*), this begins with a male and female arriving at a nest site. Osprey nests are huge unruly masses of branches, twigs and leaves, placed high in treetops, on rocky ledges or sometimes man-made structures such as utility poles. The nests are added to year after year by the current occupants.

In our area, one such nest exists at Osprey House Environmental Centre. A purpose-built nesting platform was erected in 2006, with a camera installed to monitor activity.

Over the last couple of months footage shows a young pair have set up home. New nesting material was collected and arranged, and the male began presenting the female with fish. Mating

occurred and two beautifully mottled eggs were laid. Staff were watchful, as it has been a number of years since a youngster was raised here.

Then, to everyone's delight, early in October a chick made its way out of an egg, followed two days later by a second one. The parents are parenting perfectly - shading the nearly naked hatchlings from the sun, and presenting them with small pieces of fish torn from their catches.

Ospreys are not our biggest raptor, but their fishing skills are exceptional. With a reversible outer toe, they grasp prey (big enough to be on a dinner plate), with two toes forward and two back - perfect for large slippery fish.

Little formal research exists on this species and there are many gaps in our understanding about them. They are recognised as indicator species, their presence suggesting the overall health of the environment. Pip Grant-Taylor is our local expert.

"If the habitat is perfect for ospreys and they were formerly present, then disappear, examination of the water quality would show conditions for a healthy fish population are absent," Pip says. "No fish, no ospreys. They are the feathered 'frogs' of the river, lake and sea systems, if you will."

Pop in and watch the latest imagery at Osprey House, Dohles Rocks Rd, Griffin, and enjoy the opportunity to view the intimate life of wild creatures at close range.

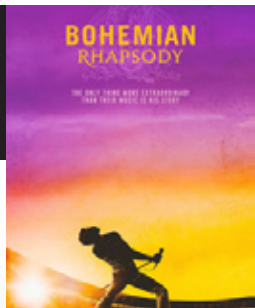

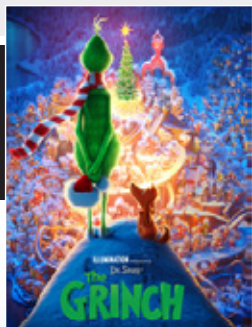

# Dancing in fetters

THE CULTURE  
OF CONVICT DANCE

**I**magine arriving in a strange land, having travelled for months, labelled a convict.

Between 1788–1868 160,000 convicts arrived in this country. They hailed from Woolwich, Portsmouth, Plymouth and Cork, with the most common of their crimes being theft, which carried a sentence of between 7 to 14 years.

Come and see what life was like as a convict at the latest exhibition at the Redcliffe Museum, titled 'Dancing in Fetters: The Culture of Convict Dance'.

The word 'convict' most probably conjures images of a life of drudgery and cruelty. This may well be correct, but another side also existed. Some physicians aboard the convict ships often encouraged dance.

Exhibition curator Dr Heather Clarke explains, "After some extremely bad voyages in the early days of transportation, surgeon superintendents were appointed to care for convicts, ensuring they received adequate food and exercise (including dancing)."

Voyages could last up to 183 days. They believed it was conducive to better health and a positive mental outlook to engage in physical activity. Dance encouraged social cohesion and cultural identity. The convicts also used dance

as a form of rebellion, a 'form of defiance to the authorities.'

Dr Clarke, a dance historian, has been working tirelessly to research this subject, having just finished her doctorate.

"The research covered everything about the convict experience from Britain to Australia, and then within the colony," says Dr Clarke. "The exhibition is a platform for my doctoral research at the Queensland University of Technology".

The exhibit displays a map detailing important convict sites, where dancing occurred, and an interactive video where you can learn some dance steps, see convict shoes, costumes, musical instruments, photographs and even some fetters!

Interestingly, it gives us an insight into the type of dance: boisterous, vigorous and more pertinent to the lower orders.

The dances were a mixture of what we now know as bush dance; it is fascinating to think of how our local dance has originated.

Redcliffe Museum is currently hosting this exhibition in partnership with Dr Heather Clarke. This exhibition is on until 18th November and is well worth a visit.
