## Bushfire Appeal to Benefit from **Fireworks** Cancellation

oreton Bay Region Council has received positive feedback from the community for their decision to cancel their planned fireworks display, in support of those affected by the bushfires in so many parts of Queensland.

The announcement was made via a Facebook post, which has been shared thousands of times and garnered approving comments.

Mayor Allan Sutherland, said that it's all about Australians supporting Australians. "It just doesn't sit well with me, or the other councillors, to sit around watching fireworks while other people have their houses burning down."

"We think the money should go to the Bushfire Appeal rather than going up in smoke."

"We will still support community groups with funding for events, just not for fireworks" Cr Sutherland said.

The council has banned ALL fireworks, as part of the complete fire ban, which is effective immediately. The following events will still go ahead but without fireworks: North Lakes Christmas Carols, Sunday 1st December; Scarborough Christmas Carols, Sunday 8th December; Pine Rivers Christmas Carols, Sunday 15th December.

At the of going to print, Moreton Bay, Fraser Coast and Gold Coast City are the only confirmed councils to cancel fireworks in support of bushfire victims although many Facebook comments express hope that other councils will follow their lead.

## Redcliffe Wins Hearts of 'Great White' Film Makers

ollywood glamour visited Redcliffe in early November, with the actionpacked survival thriller, 'Great White', being filmed at the northern end of Queens Beach. Although the location was chosen for the scenic attribute of its uninterrupted horizon, the film crew couldn't have predicted the warmth and co-operation of the local community.

Pam Collis, one of the movie's producers, said filming in Redcliffe was a very happy on-location experience.

"On the first day here, we found a box of fruit near one of our wagons. We couldn't find who ordered it, but our caterer cut it up for our afternoon tea."

"The next day there was another mysterious gift of fruit left. On the third day we staked out the spot, but they somehow still delivered a box unseen."

Then I found a receipt from 'Discount Fruit Barn Rothwell' and phoned them for more information. The manager of the Fruit Barn was sending the gift boxes as a 'Thank you' to us for bringing more business to the area. In my 25 years of filmmaking, that's a first."

"The local council was great to deal with and the local people were very considerate and respectful. Even builders would take time out from construction when the crew needed quiet for a shoot." Pam said.

'Great White' is inspired by true events and taps into our primal fear of the deep ocean and its apex predator, the Great White Shark.

American actress, Katrina Bowden, of '30 Rock' fame, stars alongside Australia's own Aaron Jakubenko, who featured in Tidelands. The pair play seaplane operators who become stranded out at sea and must make their way to land whilst being hunted by two huge sharks.

Director, Martin Wilson, said they will give the audience a unique experience, by keeping it as real as possible.

'Great White' is planned for release in 2021. Keep an eye out for this suspenseful movie that combines horror and thrills with our age-old fascination for deadly predators.

While the movie itself is scary, it's comforting to know that the cast and crew found filming in Redcliffe such a heartwarming experience.

eter and Frank Green are a father and son duo who have been surrounded by music and musicians their entire lives. Still playing gigs locally, aged 91 and 70 years old respectively, they are yet to show any signs of slowing down.

"Both my parents played piano and violin and were involved in music, hence we children were taught music also," Peter said.

Frank played drums in semi-professional bands throughout the 60s and 70s both in New Zealand and England, where he appeared on radio and local TV.

Peter and Frank moved from New Zealand to Australia over 20 years ago, and have continued their musical journeys locally.

I became involved in soccer on the Redcliffe Peninsula [and am a] life member of the Peninsula Power Soccer Club and also played in a number of bands at the Boat Club, Redcliffe RSL, Redcliffe Leagues Club, the old Palace Hotel and the Belvedere Hotel," Frank said.

Frank concentrates on British and American pop music from the 60s and 70s, along with Country Rock and Blues, while Peter's acts perform popular dance and jazz music from the 40s, 50s and 60s.

"I am the leader of 'Frank's Rebels' playing guitar and singing 60s and 70s music, together with a keyboard/harmonica player and a bass quitarist," Frank said.

Peter plays alto saxophone and is a member of the New Groove Jazz Ensemble, a 20-piece swing band from North Brisbane.

He also leads the Peninsula Jazz Group, plays in two groups who entertain aged-care homes and runs a weekly jazz musical class - a very busy 91 year old!

As well as being heavily involved in the local music scene, Frank and Peter also enjoy many other aspects of their seaside lifestyle.

Frank enjoys the quiet lifestyle by the sea, waterfront cafes, pubs and clubs, friendly people, shopping centres and movie theatres all within a short car ride.

Peter said. "The Redcliffe Peninsula is a wonderful area for a quiet lifestyle and the people are so friendly."



# Snakes Corne

taff at a Northside pizza shop got a big surprise recently, when they found an eastern brown snake curled up in their kitchen.

From that kitchen in Samford, all the way to the sandy bayside beaches, snake season officially started heating up in October/November.

Northside Snake Removals catcher, Nico de Rooy, said the pizza shop staff did the right thing by keeping their distance and calling an expert.

"It was in the kitchen, when they called me," Mr de Rooy said.

He said that during this year's peak snake season, they've seen more activity in the area.

"The snakes were moving around more than normal, with the extra heat and lack of water.

"Most of the males have been out fighting for females and are now in the breeding stage, if not already finished. This time of year is when we will start seeing baby snakes emerging.

"Places snakes will hide or be found are in bushes, amongst yard rubbish and clutter, near pools looking for water, rock walls or out in the open if they are moving around."

However residents have nothing to according to the snake catcher.

"They're (usually) out in the open, in gardens and at front doors," Mr de Rooy said.

"If you see a snake, (and it is safe to do so) send a photo, so I can see what it is.

"Stand back, don't move around, they usually just move on. The majority of people who get bitten are trying to catch or kill them.

"Everyone is brought up to fear snakes, but it is not necessary; if you stay clear of them, they're pretty safe."

Mr de Rooy said he got into the industry because snakes "are incredible creatures".

I'm trying to save and help as many as I can, because people have the wrong opinion of them," he said. "They're so different from every other animal and very misunderstood.

"I've always been fascinated by them and watching Steve Irwin when I was younger."

Mr de Rooy said he's had a lot of calls to catch snakes this year, "I have been busy as there has been a lot of eastern brown snakes and Red bellys around the Northside of Brisbane recently."



# **Local Artist Ready** for First Exhibition

newcomer to art, Bianca Baptista is a self-taught artist who has been painting since September 2018, and who finds a new passion and joy in creating each of her artworks. Her collection, Katia Art of Living, will be on display at The Foyer Gallery from December until February next

"A year ago, when I was forced to take a break from a successful career in IT for health reasons. I discovered art creation to be an essential part of my road to recovery," Bianca said.

Katia is a fictional character Bianca read about as a teenager, who was incredibly brave in the face of difficult times. Bianca found herself drawn to the character again when she started painting.

"It was then that I found Katia in almost everything I painted. Through her, I was transported to whimsical places in my mind and encouraged to be bolder and stronger. She became an aspirational version of me and I'm still painting her a year later," Bianca said.

The "Katia Art of Living" name began as a way for Bianca to share her paintings and their related back stories online.

"Art creation doesn't exactly align with a corporate IT career but I've 'come out of the closet' as an artist since then." Bianca said.

When asked what she hopes people get from her paintings, Bianca said, "if it were possible, they would look at my paintings and be transported like I am when I paint. Failing that, I hope that they connect with the stories that are only hinted at in the labels."

Bianca's last painting or her current work in progress is typically her favourite but beyond that, she says having to pick a highlight from her collection would be like having to pick a favourite child.

"Having my paintings exhibited in a gallery for the first time is the highlight for me. Being accepted was a huge boost to my confidence," Bianca says.




The managing representative of the trio, Gregory Brown, said the event incorporates high-energy and amazing harmonies that will create a night of entertainment.

# Fresh catch with a hilarious history.

t's one of the most popular eateries for locals to throw down the anchor and snap up some fresh seafood, but the building that houses The Boat Shed in Scarborough has had a history that would make a pirate blush, according to owner and chef, Brian Rawnsley.

"The shop actually used to be a butcher shop years and years ago, and I believe there was even a brothel upstairs," laughs Brian.

"The owner had a Catholic priest from up the road perform an exorcism to remove the evil spirits from the place. It became a typical fish and chip shop in the 1970s with pinball machines and more.

"Robe and Ben Britton purchased the shop in 2001, when they renovated and named it The Boat Shed. They sold it to me in June 2003."

Since then, Brian has focused on affordable, fresh food and a family-friendly atmosphere for the community.

"When I took over, I opened with a new menu and format, deciding to simplify our food so we could focus on quality and presentation. My philosophy was to see restaurant-quality food at takeaway prices," he says.



"Both my boys grew up working in the shop, and we've always employed locals and friends."

It's no surprise that the locals love the laid-back fare - Brian said seafood and hospitality runs firmly in his family.

"My father owned a fish and chip shop in Newcastle and my brothers and I would go fishing in the mornings and afternoons, selling the catch in the shop," he says.

"I am a qualified chef, having worked at the Hilton, Marriott, around NSW, and working all around Australia cooking with my wife for several years."

Most of all, Brian said The Boat Shed offers a great local dining experience that customers come back to time and again.

"We pride ourselves on being clean, and we want to allow people to see their food being prepared in front of them," he says.

"Our food is cooked to order and never precooked, we are very fast. Our food is unique and our presentation is one of a kind."

# **Juniors Set Sail.**

n a massive coupe, Humpybong Yacht Club will be hosting a major junior sailing event. Girls and boys aged seven to twelve years old will battle it out in the waters off Woody Point, in the Queensland State Optimist Championships.

Yachting Queensland president and Humpybong Yacht Club's Discover Sailing principal, Matthew Johnson, said the racing was a key component and fundamental reason as to why they were here.

"Going to these regattas is also so much more about a social aspect for these kids and learning to interact with other sailors," Matthew said.

Optimist is the national junior class where they teach kids to sail. The optimists are two-metre white hulled dinghies, which the kids will sail over a course of about 400 to 500 metres in length.

The kids need to be a member of an affiliated sailing club within Australia, and a member of a state association.

There'll be three separate divisions. The Open Fleet and Intermediate Fleets will sail further out into more open air, while the Green Fleet for the beginners will stay closer to shore, in front of the clubhouse.

One local to cheer on is Nessen Carmody, who won the Intermediate division, back

in September, at the Queensland Youth Championships. Nessen will be competing in the Open Fleet at these championships.

Matthew said the Green Fleet race is a much shorter course with simplified rules, and the coaches sit alongside the sailors, talking them around the course the whole way.

"A couple of years ago we had an eight-yearold girl who took her teddy bear, so she had her teddy bear crew with her," Matthew said.

All fleets will be close enough to be visible from the jetty and foreshore, especially since the kids could be decorating their hulls with crazy wild designs.

This will make the Woody Point waterfront, with its established facilities, a great place to spend the long weekend.

# One Day Fun Days – Luna Park

he Redcliffe foreshore is full of life, with markets, shops, restaurants and cafes to suit all tastes. But did you know that it also used to be home to Luna Park?

The mention of Luna Park almost invariably leads to thoughts of Sydney's harbourside fun park. But we once had our own.

In September 1944, two businessmen, Scott and Worth, entered into an agreement with the

Redcliffe Town Council to establish a Luna Park, and they took out a 12-year lease. With WW2 raging, many servicemen, especially Americans, took their leave on the Peninsula, which ensured that the park thrived.

The end of the war saw the end of this boom. The park had a series of owners in the years that followed and some fared better than others.

The park contained a merry-go-round, which was a landmark on the Redcliffe skyline until 1954; aero rides; a slippery slide; horse-oplanes and a miniature train. It was a popular rendezvous for teenagers. In the lead up to Christmas, for several years, a King and Queen of Luna Park competition was held, which drew huge crowds.

Sideshow alley had Hoop-la, knock'em downs, skittle alley and a shooting gallery, testing the skills of young men trying to impress the ladies.

A hexagonal building, constructed back in the 1920s, was converted in the 1950s into a cafe and a boat pool was also constructed in the 50s.

Not all was fun and games, though. Tragedy struck on New Year's Day, 1947, when Beryl Bateman, a 20-year-old single woman from Coorparoo, fell 15-feet (over 4.5-metres) from the chair-o-plane, when a chain broke, and she was killed on impact with the rocks below.

In 1950, then-owner, Harold Buchanan, could no longer justify the long hours he spent running the park, as there was so little return. Redcliffe Town Council sold the park to the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Brisbane. Father (later Monsignor) Frawley revamped the neglected and run-down park and turned it, once more, into a fully operational fun park, returning good profits, which aided the construction of Catholic schools in the area.

"I was always interested in fun parks," Father Buchanan is reported to have said.

"I loved the noise and atmosphere and enjoyed selling tickets to the people who got such obvious satisfaction from the rides and games."

The council did not renew the lease in 1965 and Luna Park closed in 1966.

Wouldn't it be fun to have our own Luna Park today?

ome of you may know about, or have read my articles on Tilapia before; well here is a reminder. Now is the time to go and catch a few! They are very active and are breeding in the warm weather.

These "canes toads of the waterways" are in almost all of the creeks, ponds and water catchments in our area and are causing havoc to our local native fish populations. They are good fun to catch on light gear and great for kids to learn about fishing and identifying pests in our environment. These fish must be euthanised and disposed of, away from the water, as soon as practical and cannot be let go, taken home or eaten!

My preference is to catch them with garden worms, on a size 8 hook under a small float. The float, being visual, is a lot more exciting for the kids than just throwing out the line and waiting. My rig has a sliding float with a rubber band stopper that slides up and down the line for the desired depth. Most of the time it's only about 30cm deep.

There are now some very popular local "pest" fishing competitions being held to get rid of these fish and to reintroduce natives, such as Australian Bass with the proceeds.

Please make sure you can fish the area you choose; there are a few parks with "no fishing" signs. If you are unsure, don't hesitate to contact me for places to fish.






