Twist, Shout, Swing

hat happens when you mix the legendary lyrics of The Beatles with the smooth sounds of swing, jazz, and a big band?

It's The Beatles Swing – show critics have described it as "Bublé meets the Beatles", fronted by ultra-cool crooner, Craig Martin.

Craig and his eight-piece Big Swing Band will perform their out-of-the-box take on Beatles classics at the Redcliffe Entertainment Centre. Craig describes the show as having a "contemporary swing and a very modern sound".

"I haven't turned the songs on their head, they're recognisable, but they've just got this swing jazz tweak to them, which people find interesting," he said.

Craig was born and raised in Liverpool, England, but his connection with the Fab Four goes much deeper than that. His "music education" was listening to his mum's Beatles records in the 70s and 80s, which taught him how to play the guitar and harmonise. Soon, he was performing in public.

"The Beatles were a massive influence – as a teenager I performed in clubs where they played," he said. "You get chills down your spine, thinking 'my God, John Lennon sang on this stage'."

Craig Martin and his Big Swing Band

Last year, Craig returned to perform at the famous Cavern Club in Liverpool, where The Beatles were discovered, describing the experience as "just fantastic".

He's also toured with the legendary Gerry Marsden – of Gerry and the Pacemakers fame – who was good mates with Beatles members and had a few stories to tell.

"I used to ask Gerry questions that no-one else would ask him, so I've got this great bag of stories and I put a few of them in the show," Craig said.

In the 90s, he discovered his love of a new style of music when he began performing with some small swing bands. He went on to sing with the famous Syd Lawrence Orchestra in the UK.

The Beatles Swing show combines Craig's love of The Beatles and swing music – a cool new take on some of the world's best loved classics.

OAM MEDAL FOR REDCLIFFE SONGWRITER

he patriotic music and poems of Redcliffe's Valerie Dawson have been recognised with a Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM). The talented 86-year-old recently received the OAM for her amazing contribution to Australia's performing arts as a singer and songwriter.

For more than 35 years, Valerie has been writing songs and poetry celebrating Australian culture, its places and people, as well as the nation's outstanding achievements in sport and global events. Her poetry includes tributes to Australian icons such as former Prime Minister Bob Hawke, and long-distance runner Ron Grant.

OAM recipient Valerie Dawson Valerie's passion for songwriting ignited in 1983 when racing yacht Australia II won the America's Cup for the Royal Perth Yacht Club.

"When we heard Australia had won, my husband suggested I write a song about it," Valerie said. "So I wrote one ... while I was doing the washing."

Valerie's America's Cup Waltz was the first of many inspiring songs and poems written in tribute to milestone moments and events in Australia's history.

Through her creative work, the mother of five and wife to the late Donald Dawson, has captured everything from the National Servicemen's Association of Australia's 50th anniversary, to the 2000 Sydney Olympics, the Queen's Diamond Jubilee in 2012 through to the 2018 Gold Coast Commonwealth Games.

As well as being formally recognised with an OAM, Valerie's work has been preserved in the National Archives of Australia. The keen writer also has two poems, Our Star Black Caviar and One in a Million Winx, on display at The Australian Racing Museum and Hall of Fame in Flemington.

Adding to her impressive portfolio of work, Valerie recently had a book of poems published called A Collection of Poetic Gems.

As well as capturing great moments from the past, Valerie said her work was a way of keeping memories alive for the younger generation and her family. "I like writing and I wanted to do it for future generations, so they can see what we achieved in that era," Valerie said.

The Redcliffe writer will be officially awarded her OAM at a special ceremony at the heritage-listed Government House in Paddington, Brisbane.

his year marks the 50th World Irish Dancing Championships in Dublin, where dancers from all over the world will compete. Local dance school, Scoil Ard Rince, will be there too, with two teams and eight solo dancers.

Breeda Peirce, principal teacher at Scoil Ard Rince, said competing was the ultimate test for Irish dancers and the toughest competition worldwide of any Irish dance organisation.

To qualify and compete for Queensland and Australia is always the ultimate goal for Irish dancers," Breeda said.

Scoil Ard Rince commenced classes on the Redcliffe Peninsula in 1991. Now in its 30th year, it's one of Australia's and Queensland's most successful Irish dance schools, providing Irish dance classes at all levels from preschool to open championship level. Many dancers from the school have gone on to tour with the major dance shows of Riverdance, Celtic Fyre, and Rhythms of Ireland, both in Australia and overseas.

Fundraising has begun to help students who have qualified for the world championships make it to Dublin. Fundraising efforts so far have included a trivia night on 15 February, where everyone got a team together to enjoy a fun night out while helping to support the Scoil Ard Rince dancers.

The Year of Opportunity for Peninsula Small Businesses

ur first event for 2020 was a huge success. It was attended by almost 60 local business owners to hear our panel speak on the opportunities for Peninsula small businesses.

Our panelists were Chamber of Commerce and Industry Queensland CEO Stephen Tait, President of the Brisbane Junior Chamber of Commerce Nathan Schokker, and Director of Open Architecture and the Moreton Maritime Alliance Michael Bailey.

With three very different viewpoints, yet all with the common goal of building more successful small businesses, the answers were varied and eye opening with the audience deeply engaged.

Some of the biggest opportunities from our panelists included this being a year for local and state elections, and for our members and business owners to clearly articulate what they want from our representatives. In particular, the opportunity presented by Moreton Bay Strategic Plan for Redcliffe. This includes requesting masterplans be carried out for Scarborough Harbour and the Woody Point foreshore, enhanced jetty and pontoon facilities, barge and ferry facilities, a centre for ocean robotics and research, and even ocean baths.

The more 'outside the box' ideas the panelists discussed were finding ways to make the Peninsula completely self-sufficient from a power perspective through solar panels; changing the current government grant focus into a venture capital scheme funded by the government but administered by venture capitalists; and free high speed internet for everyone.

The key theme that came through from all the panelists was around that of coming together and collaborating more as a community, in particular with the millennial and emerging generations. History has shown that every generation has had an issue with the younger generation coming through – why not make this a different paradigm and find a way to understand each other and work together?

Our next event is on Tuesday 3 March from 6-8pm upstairs at Mon Komo.

This will be our Meet the Candidates event, an opportunity for local businesses to find out more about what the candidates' policies around small business as well as the future direction the council will be heading on various issues.

Why you need to focus on the questions, not the answers, as a business owner.

More often than not when we are faced with a challenge in our business, we get fixated on finding the answer to our challenges. If you think about it though, it's the question just before we get the answer that gives us the breakthrough we need.

One of the things I focus on with my clients is teaching them how to ask great questions. In fact, I get them to set aside 30-60 minutes a week to take time and think about certain questions.

Here are some questions for you try out some think-time with.

- What would you need to provide to your clients so they would be crazy to ever want to leave you?
- What if every client who bought from you in the past, still did. How do you make that happen?
- If you were to become a global leader for just one of your products or services, what would it be and why?

- Payments of \$1000 for adults and \$400 for dependents who have experienced injury, death of an immediate family member, destroyed home or significant damage to assets;

- \$50 million for the Bushfire Wildlife Habitat Recovery Package for animal carers;

- Assistance to volunteer firefighters, small businesses, and mental health support.

I'd like to thank the ADF personnel, reservists, RFS, volunteer fire fighters, and our local groups and community members for their generosity and fundraising efforts.







An Artist's Adventure Into Self

Margate artist Monica Batiste has been painting as long as she can remember.

"I loved drawing as a child, so my pursuit of art has been a natural progression," Monica said.

Recently she completed a 1.8m portrait of Redcliffe movie producer and author Richard Lancaster. Monica entitled the work 'The Storyteller. Portrait of Richard Lancaster'.

"I chose Richard for my subject as he is a catalyst for promoting the arts in Redcliffe, and encouraging artists to strive for excellence. He is also an artist himself," she said.

A ghostly image of Queensland's longest serving premier, the late Sir Joh Bjelke-Petersen, appears in the portrait's background.

"Richard developed a Queensland celebrity management agency 'Frontline Celebrities' in the 1980s and Sir Joh was his last client," Monica said. "Richard assisted him as a client during the tumultuous Fitzgerald Inquiry."

Monica said her painting process usually began with a lot of sketches and interviews. "I learn a lot about my subject this way," she said.

She describes her style as traditional with "contemporary fantasy realism".

I've always loved traditional art, impressionism and postimpressionism. I try to stay true to myself by making the mark that needs to be made no matter how afraid I am to do it.



"The fantasy realism I include in my paintings is how I see things, or how I want to see the things that are around us," she said.

"Being an artist is an adventure into oneself and displaying that self for the world to see. Sometimes we are judged for not making the kind of art that others think we should, and sometimes we are misunderstood. But all of art is art, and everyone deserves the chance to be heard.

"I seek to paint people that have made a difference to the world."

Monica studied art at the Atelier in Brisbane and has a home studio/gallery in Margate where her work is on display. She is also an accomplished yoga instructor and an author of several books on the subject. Monica is working on several film projects as well.

Netballers March into New Season

Redcliffe Leagues Netball Association will officially commence their 2020 season with a March Past to mark round one.

Competitions director at Redcliffe Leagues Netball Association (RLNA) Bianca Webb said the March Past was a traditional way of starting off the netball season.

"Every team marches past a tent of officials, where we usually have Luke Howarth MP, Yvette D'Ath MP, Bob Jones from Redcliffe Leagues Club and Cr Koliana Winchester," Bianca said.

"Some associations don't do it anymore, but we feel it's a real tradition and so we like to keep it going, as the teams have fun dressing up, making banners and having chants."

The RLNA is run by volunteers. There is an elected board with a branch structure rather than individual clubs. All branches have an appointed manager to liaise between the RLNA, players, coaches and parents.

There are approximately forty teams spread evenly across the branches. They consist of

NetSetGO teams for girls and boys aged five to 10. The junior teams range in age from 11 to 17 years. The competition runs for 14 weeks with the grand finals commencing at the end of August.

The NetSetGO allows kids of all abilities to learn basic skills at their own pace, while being supported in a fun, safe and social environment. Juniors play in organised competitive matches where they also have fun and get active while making friends.

"We also have social netball on Wednesday nights for anyone aged from 18 to 99," Bianca said.

Due to the RLNA being a member of Brisbane North Region, there's a development pathway through the Brisbane North Cougars, for players showing ability and commitment. There are also rep squads that go to state and metropolitan carnivals.

Bianca said they were always chasing grants, but had received some grants recently with the help of one of the parents.

"We are also looking for new sponsorships from people who would like to support our association and for anyone who'd like to help out to get in touch," she said.






