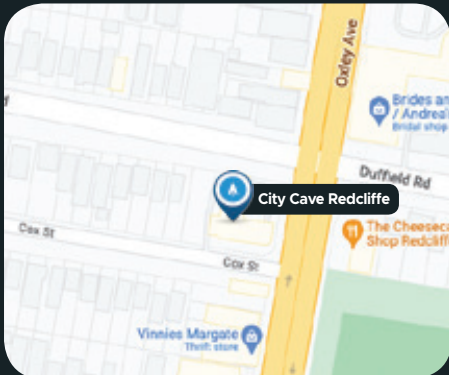

Brisbane to Gladstone

Local skipper competes in national race

The iconic sporting event held every Easter, is about to set sail for another year and local skipper, Michael Andrews, is gearing up to compete for a third time.

Growing up around boats on the waters of New Zealand, Michael recalls sailing on his father's homemade yacht. He now sails with the Moreton Bay Boat Club and has done so for the past seven years.

"I've been sailing since I was a child growing up in Christchurch NZ. My father was a keen home boat builder and sailor and inspired me to get out on the water as often as I could growing up," Andrew said.

"We sailed in Lyttelton Harbour on my father's

homemade trailer yachts and later my own trailer yacht.

"I have been sailing with the Moreton Bay Boat Club since moving here seven years ago, and am currently the principal race officer, helping organise and run the racing programme."

Michael first competed in the Brisbane to Gladstone race in 2021 with a crew of six.

"We have done the last two races, the first in 2021 with six crew in very strong winds and big seas, and we were all very happy to arrive at the finish intact - boat and crew," Michael said. "Competing in the B2G was a big step up for me from shorter races within Moreton Bay."

With a national audience, the race, which can take up to 40 hours to complete, requires a well organised schedule to stay on track, and to keep the crew safe.

"Routine is important, and we maintain a watch system of two hours on, two hours off so there's always one person in charge of the

boat while the other gets some much-needed rest or makes a meal," Michael said. "During our watches we concentrate on sail settings, navigation, looking out for other boats, shipping and making the regular "Sched" calls to race control to let them know our position on the racecourse, and that everything is ok."

The yachts set sail near Sandgate, and follow close to the Redcliffe foreshore before heading toward Tangalooma, then follow the shipping channels to exit the Bay.

Keep an eye out for Michael and his crew onboard his boat 'Jenesis'.

An initiative by the Redcliffe Area Youth Space, Picnic Hill has become a much-loved event in the community's calendar, however due to Covid-19 and significant weather events, it has had to be postponed for the last couple of years.

With the aim of providing an afternoon of family fun, Project Officer, Cathy Doyle, said the event was born out of a need to raise funds.

"On a daily basis we work with young people who are dealing with multiple complex issues such as homelessness, domestic violence, alcohol and other drugs, mental health, family breakdown and education and learning difficulties," Cathy said.

"Picnic Hill directly supports our young people, not only by the funds raised, but also by providing employment and training opportunities.

It also supports the local community by providing opportunities for local food vendors, musicians, artists and creators to be involved."

Event goers can expect an afternoon of delicious street food, food trucks and live music. There will be interactive activities, local art on display and even lawn games the whole family can enjoy! And for those who are feeling thirsty, there will be a bar selling ice-cold craft beer and ciders.

New to the event this year will be Makers Alley, a market space where young and emerging creatives can showcase and sell their work.

The afternoon will provide families with a place to unwind and spend quality time together, enjoy local talent and local food, while supporting young people.

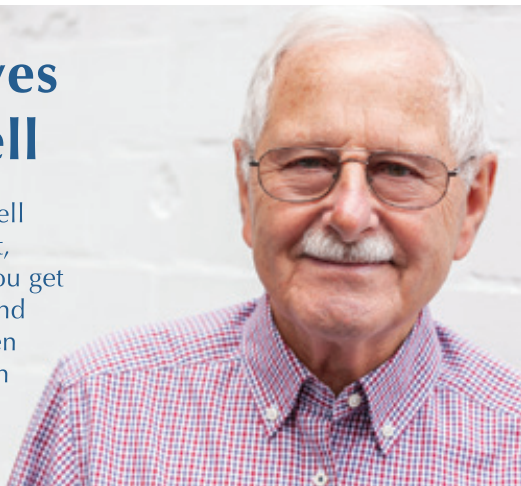

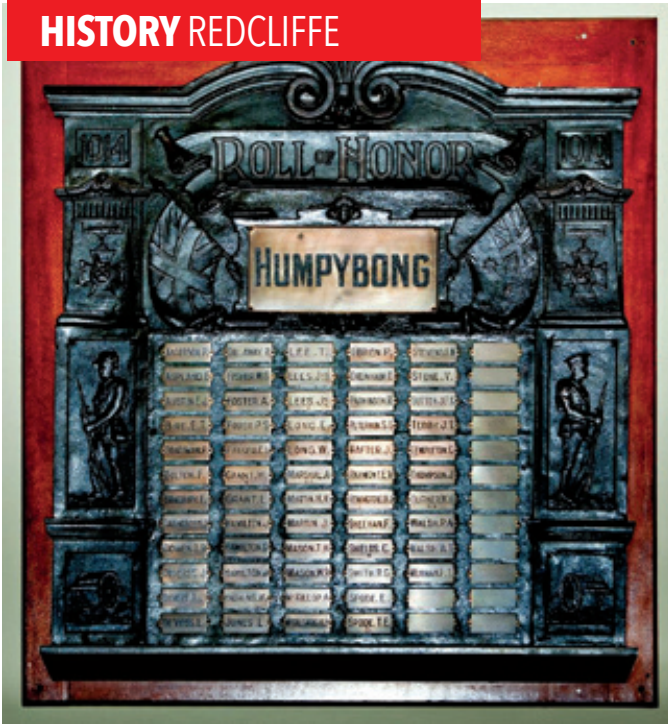

Humpybong Roll of Honor

Humpybong answers the call

It is safe to assume that in early 1914 most of the alumni of the Humpybong State School were untroubled by the political and military posturing about to spill over into open conflict in Europe. Soon, though, many old boys of Redcliffe's first school would be catapulted into a war the horror of which would have been undreamt of in whatever history they were taught at Humpybong.

The long roll call of Humpybong veterans lists, inevitably, those who would not return. One of these was Herbert Grant who, as an 18-year-old labourer, enlisted in January, 1916. He was the youngest son of Annie and Walter – a baker and later Mayor of Redcliffe – who lived in Sutton Street. Herbert saw action in Egypt and then

France, where he was killed in action on 14 March 1917, a sad end for the boy who, in 1909, had received the first prize for general progress at the Humpybong school prizegiving.

William Haskins, grandson of a convict, was a member of a pioneering Peninsula family. He enlisted in October, 1916 aged 26 and fought in France. His stint in the trenches was characterised by equal parts luck and courage. Wounded in the advance on Proyart in 1918 he nevertheless, having had his wounds dressed, continued the advance with his company. Wounded for a second time, he engaged an enemy machine gun then, in the absence of stretcher bearers, carried out of the battle another wounded man, taking the soldier two

and half kilometres to the regimental aid post. For these exploits he was awarded the Military Medal in 1919. He returned to Redcliffe in 1920 but later had a leg amputated as a result of war injuries.

Another Military Medal recipient was William Hamilton, one of three brothers who enlisted in 1915 and fought in France. The MM citation records that William "showed wonderful judgement, coolness and bravery" under fire. All three Hamiltons returned safely from the war.

Not so the Shields brothers, Charles and Donald, both of whom served in France and died there, Donald in 1916, aged 20 and Charles in 1917, aged 28. Other Redcliffe brothers who served were the Spodes, the Masons, the Longs, the Cowens and the Oxenhams.

Thirty-six of the 58 men listed on the Humpybong Roll of Honor were students of the Humpybong State School and four old Humpybong boys died in the war. This is at once a proud record, a dreadful toll and a sad indictment. Lest we forget.

Written by Damian Castellini and his partner Michelle Jones (of Pip and Pete's Antarctic Adventure) this book is, according to Mr Castellini, "about a girl who befriends a large huntsman spider—after some initial discomfort, of course."

A tribe of unexpectedly charming characters spring forth from the pages, which have been self-published on ethically-sourced paper.

Interestingly enough, the idea for the plot was inspired by a dream and also by a slight bug phobia that the co-authors both share.

"We had to overcome the latter during our

gardening ventures, and I find that stories are ideal tools for helping one to confront their misconceptions," Mr Castellini said.

He said that the tendency for kids to show curiosity toward creepy crawlies was something to be encouraged and there were more drafts of this ilk in the pipeline.

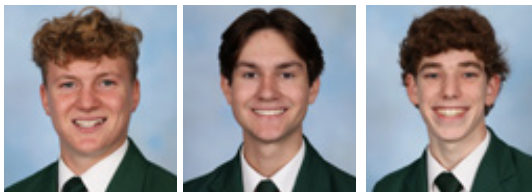

ARTFULLY REDCLIFFE

An old newspaper article recently caught my attention, as one of my very long term students, had just shared a photo relating to the article. At the end of last year, this student finished tuition with Art So Lively after nine years and is now a young adult studying architecture but still interested in all things artistic.

She painted a scene on her parents' back verandah on a plain wall, creating an optical illusion of a rustic doorway and plants. It added such interest to the outside space.

The newspaper headline stated Paint It like It isn't and this is just what Sarah had accomplished using an old technique called Trompe-l'oeil. A French term for painting the illusion of three-dimensional objects (super realistically) on unconventional two-dimensional surfaces, the intention is to trick the viewer into thinking these objects are really there. It's not a new practice, having its origins date back to Greek and Roman times. Fascinating!

The 17th century master painter, Caravaggio used the technique in his painting entitled Supper at Emmaus, where he painted the guests leaving

the canvas and coming into the viewer's space. Pere Borrel used it very effectively in 1874 in his painting Escaping Criticism [pictured].

In fact 'Trompe-l'oeil' painting became very popular with 17th century Dutch and Flemish painting schools embracing the art form with relish. Samuel Dirksz van Hoogstratten became known as a master of this art form by publishing his book The Visible World.

More recently, the art form was used in the classic film Singin' in the Rain, which showed Donald O'Connor dancing up a wall, which in effect was created by the film producers using a large Trompe-l'oeil mural. Interior decorators sometimes employ skilled artists to add exciting, quirky illusions of things that are not present in an otherwise ordinary interior space. Some tourist attractions also use large scale illusory art, which allows visitors to 'selfie' themselves within fantastic scenes.

Please note this wonderful art form is not a skill that can be learned in half-a-dozen art lessons. It's a painstaking process that requires a high level of skill and oodles of patience to Trick the Eye of the viewer into truly believing one is looking at three dimensional reality rather than a two dimensional image.

CRUSADING FOR KOALAS

Feeding in Tree

Looking out for Koalas might not sound like a difficult task, given the cuteness of this furry and beloved native species, but local group Queensland Koala Crusaders (QKCs) has been working incredibly hard on all fronts to protect these animals in our own backyard.

Environmental conservation in Moreton Bay is supported by QKC through outreach to government representatives and other organisations, as well as through the implementation of hands-on efforts like planting trees for koalas and other species.

According to QKC President Linda Barnes, the team has been active in the Peninsula region over the past 14 months, including spearheading discussions with local Clontarf residents regarding plans for a pedestrian overpass and several other initiatives.

"We're most proud of establishing a positive connection and dialogue with members of Council, with the ecology and conservation teams and being given a seat at the table to help influence policy and support the region's growth plans and support for all wildlife," Ms Barnes said.

Ms Barnes said that The Green Infrastructure Network Delivery Program, which seeks to

facilitate faunal movement and re-establish habitat, was a highlight for the team.

"We discussed the objectives that some of the Council members have for establishing a wildlife corridor along east-west waterways, involving local landowners and offered our support and participation," Ms Barnes said.

According to Ms Barnes, QKC has another important function in encouraging residents to help with tree plantings and in educating people about koalas and how to best protect them.

"There is so much the average citizen can do. We can reduce our driving speed in koala habitat and where koalas are likely to be on the ground, and we can be on the lookout for sick and hurt koalas and call the nearest rescue group," she said.

Ms Barnes encouraged people to educate themselves on the behaviour, threats and conditions affecting koalas.

"Our website and other groups like ours provide all kinds of information about koalas. People can donate and/or become a member. Help us be a louder voice for the koala," she said.

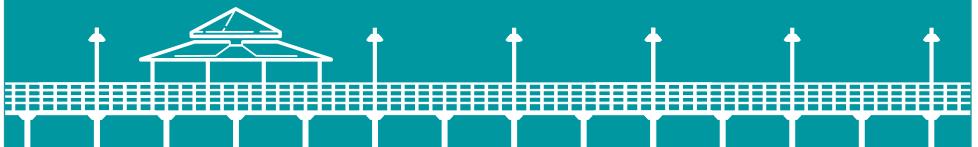

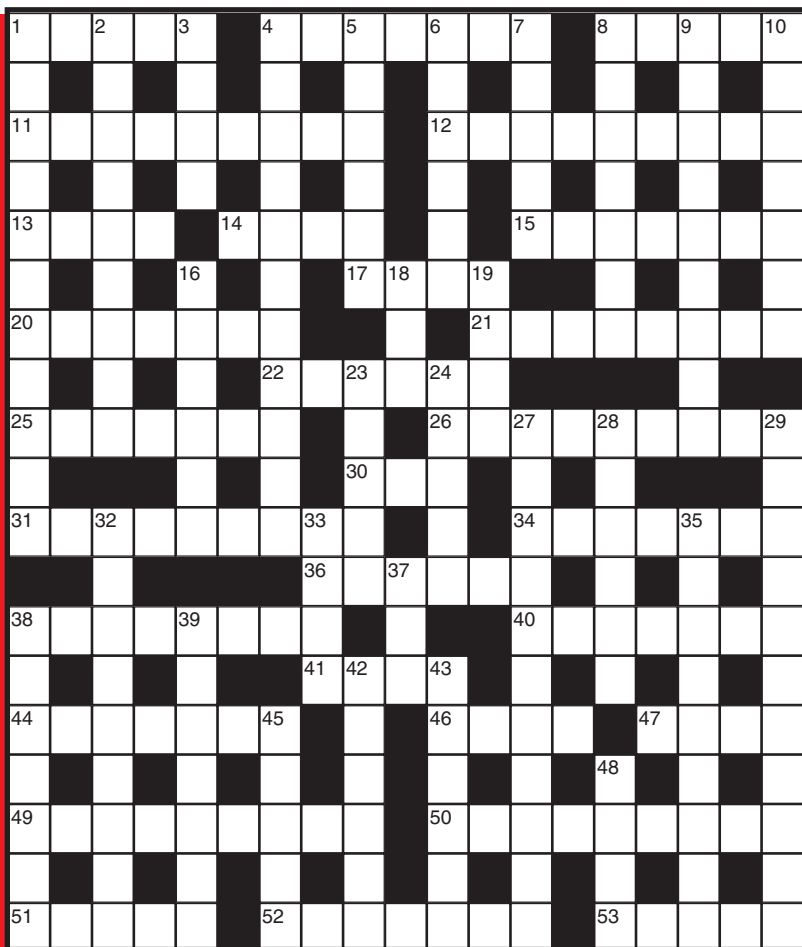

Beating Bowel Cancer with Black Tie Gala

At just 38 years old, Rachel Bernardo was in for the shock of her life when she learned the crushing news that she had stage three bowel cancer.

When a trip to her GP for intermittent stomach cramps 12 months earlier led to being told it was just constipation, Rachel didn't think much else of it until she experienced such extreme pain and bloating one day that she took herself to emergency. It was then that doctors discovered a large tumor on the side of her bowel.

"It's so important to listen to your body and get checked," she said. "I had never heard of young people getting bowel cancer before. The only other symptom I had was tiredness - but I'm a

mom to three young kids so that was just normal."

Now that Rachel has had surgery and started chemotherapy, she is not only focusing on her own health, but is on a mission to educate others on bowel cancer in young people and is advocating for the screening age to be lowered.

"In Australia, government screening tests are not available for people under 50," she said. "Had I done one sooner, my cancer could have been caught earlier. Raising awareness about this disease and its effects on younger people has been both satisfying and purposeful for me."

With the support of her fiancé, her three daughters, extended family and friends, Rachel is feeling optimistic about the future and is using her story to make a difference.

"I'm very excited to be spearheading a Bowel Cancer Fundraiser Gala this July with all proceeds going to Bowel Cancer Australia," she said. "Bowel cancer is Australia's second deadliest cancer and a leading cause of death in Australians aged 25-84. Unfortunately, research and treatment for this disease are quite underfunded."

Making friends with everyday anxiety



WITH **TANYA FISHER**

Anxiety comes to visit us when it feels like we need to be told something. For example, I'm here to remind you about that important conversation you're having on Monday. You know that conversation is coming up but anxiety wants us to 'do something' about it.

It's in the doing something that makes a difference because if you try to blow it off the thoughts will keep coming back. Yet on the other hand, if you give unto it, you can very quickly move into worry and it takes over.

The secret, I have found, is to make friends with anxiety. To acknowledge it is here and listen to what it needs to tell you. The trick is not to be anxious about being or feeling anxious because that's when it will hook you in.

Next time you feel anxiety in your body or find yourself with some unhelpful thoughts, lean into it and acknowledge its presence. As strange as it sounds, this noticing can often reduce the feelings of anxiety because you are not fighting it! You've said, hello Anxiety, I recognise you are here, and you being here is a normal part of me being human.

Once you recognise it as just your brain reminding you about the issue e.g. the important conversation, you can spend some time preparing, taking action. Once that is done, I encourage you to thank your anxiety for reminding you but now you are moving on to something else.

If the anxiety comes back to remind you again, simply acknowledge that you're having those thoughts and feelings again about the issue and let those thoughts and feelings be, they will soon pass, that's what they do.

This is helpful for everyday anxiety however if you are experiencing constant anxiety or unhelpful thoughts, reactions and feelings please reach out for support. 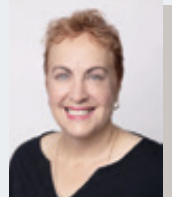

History Rediscovered

Opportunity shops are an unwitting source of being collectors of our history. The illustrated silver serviette ring is one such example. I found it among a small cardboard box of miscellaneous oddsments which I purchased for \$3, at one of my favourite Op Shops.

Oxidation had conquered this ring, which was almost unrecognisable, being covered in that dirty black coat that is attracted to unpolished silver. But after a quick polish with Silvo, the silver ring shone brightly. It also revealed its hitherto unrecognised historic origins. The ring proudly bore the crest of the Aberdeen and Commonwealth White Star Shipping Line and the name of the ship from which it originated. And that was the S. S. Moreton Bay. The ship made its maiden voyage sailing from London bound for Brisbane, in December 1921.

But her maiden voyage commenced disastrously as she collided with another ship in the Thames River and this was repeated again during her second voyage with yet another vessel. On both occasions her captain was blamed for the collisions. With the advent of World War II, she was requisitioned by the Australian Government and converted into an armed merchant cruiser and later into a troop carrier.

She took part in the Madagascar, North African and Normandy campaigns during which she had her third collision, this time hitting the quay at Algiers. This proved not to be her captain's fault, as she was abandoned by tugs, during an air-raid. In October 1940, she exonerated herself from her past errors by capturing the French Vichy liner Cuba, which was attempting to run an allied blockade.

After the war ended, she returned to commercial passenger service. She was scrapped at her U. K. birthplace in 1957. Her ship's bell which is held by the Victorian Mission of Seafarers Collection and my serviette ring, is knowingly all that is left of the sometimes proud history of S.S. Moreton Bay.

Working out who your most profitable customers (and products) are and what the most valuable activities you need to focus on and complete, can massively speed up the results you are after.

This approach helps you stop putting too much energy into the wrong customers and activities and instead focus on where you will get the greatest results.

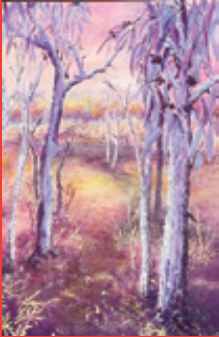

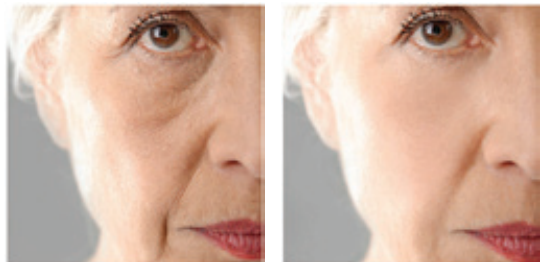

Here's a common question from a new patient: I was given two hearing aids from another place. I am not hearing well. What can you do to help me? Every case is different. However, generally these are the steps I follow:

1. An Otoscopy is done to confirm if earwax is obstructing the ear canal. If it is the case, Earwax Microsuction can remove the blockage and the hearing should improve.
2. Replace the hearing aid earwax filter (a monthly procedure). Deep cleaning the microphone and speaker unit can also make a significant impact to the sound quality.

Using the best practice approach, I perform my own testing, fine-tuning the hearing aid settings until the hearing aid output and frequency response match to the degree of hearing loss.



Including history taking and discussing further improvements, the whole process may take up to 45 - 60 mins. As an audiologist, it is very important to invest quality time to get the hearing aids programmed properly. By doing this, it benefits our clients every single minute the hearing aids are worn. It is definitely well worth it.
