YOUTHS HIT THE AIRWAVES

n a world where social media and streaming seemingly rule the information superhighway, 99.7 Bridge FM is turning its dials to help give young bayside residents a voice on its airwaves.

The Voice of Youth Program - on air every second Thursday during school terms - is giving school students from the region a hot mic to discuss the issues and news that affect their generation.

Voice of Youth co-host Selina McPhee - who facilitates the program alongside co-host John Muldowney - said the program had proven a huge success with young residents already.

"The idea was born from an idea to offer the youth of our community a chance to voice their views," she said. "Every show features a different school, with three students - Grades 10,11 or 12 - from the participating school taking part.

"The students choose topics they wish to discuss and suggest songs they would like in that hour."

The program is also a lesson in how broadcast radio is produced, from ideation through to the talent and content on the airwaves.

"We meet with the students for a pre-production

tour of our studios and go over their topics to build their confidence and help with their preparation," Selina said. "It is important that they realise it is about them and their views. We are only there to guide the hour. It is there to give THEM a voice.

"A lot of students are nervous, but this dissolves quickly. It is very rewarding to see how the students enjoy the experience."

Topics tackled so far include the good and bad of social media; the lack of women's representation in science, technology, engineering and maths fields; and the importance of hobbies and strong social connections.


The feedback from the community had been incredible, Selina said. And there are plans to expand.

"It's been very positive. We have been inundated with positive feedback from not only the students themselves, but the teachers and schools involved," she said.

"The program will be ongoing. All schools in the northern suburbs of Brisbane and Moreton Bay will be approached to participate - firstly public schools and then private schools, and we hope to include home-schooling students as well in the future.

"We are working on bringing the program out as a podcast."

Pickleball - The fastest growing sport that's serving up a tonne of fun

ave you tried pickleball yet? Well, if you haven't, there's no time like the present! Chris Novic, Head Coach for Focus Tennis & Pickleball Academy at the Redcliffe Tennis Centre, explained that while the sport has been played in Australia since about 2015, it's been the talk of the town for the last three years.

For those who have never heard of it before, Chris explained that pickleball is a paddle sport that you can learn in minutes and play for a lifetime.

"It brings together elements of tennis, badminton, and table tennis," he said. "It's a fun sport that can be played both indoors and outdoors and can be adapted to both singles and doubles."

Pickleball originated in the United States in 1965 and became a recognised sport in 1972.

"Three friends started it by playing on a badminton court in

their backyard," Chris said. "It's gained popularity over the years because it's so easy to learn and play and it's suitable for all fitness levels as it doesn't require as much movement compared to tennis, badminton, or squash."

As the fastest growing sport in Australia, it's easier on your body than tennis or squash.

"It offers a good aerobic workout without too much stress on the joints and muscles," Chris said. "It improves bone strength, increases muscle mass, controls joint swelling and pain associated with arthritis, and it does wonders for your mental health."

Chris has been playing Pickleball for about three years and coaching for 12 months.

"Skill development is a simple process," he said. "It's very forgiving, so beginners can be on the court playing a game very quickly after they first pick up a paddle."

At the moment, Chris explained that the sport seems to be most popular with adults over the age of 35, but he's trying to change that.

"I'm trying to promote it more in schools," he said. "I'm hoping to offer lessons to juniors which will help continue to grow the sport in the future."

Chris is encouraging everyone to come down to the club and give it a go.

"First timers can book in for a free session and are able to borrow paddles,' he said. "Our players and members are such a nice bunch of people and are more than happy to help."

MAGIC IN THE AIR ON BROADWAY... BY THE BEACH

his year's Moreton Bay Anywhere Festival will close with a big finish - a spectacular performance of the best Broadway anthems set right on the beach.

More than 50 local performers from Redcliffe Musical Theatre and ROAR Academy will belt out the biggest Broadway hits at the free finale event, Broadway By the Beach, to be held in the Redcliffe Outdoor Amphitheatre on Sunday, 4 June.

Redcliffe Musical Theatre president and ROAR Academy principal, Madeleine Johns said the event would be something to remember.

"It has always been a dream of mine to perform a 'Best of Broadway' style concert with the beach as our backdrop," Madeleine said. "This idea has been brewing for some years and we are thrilled to be offered the opportunity to bring this destination event to Redcliffe and to the Anywhere Festival.

"Broadway By the Beach will be a highlight of the festival for many reasons – the number of performers, the location, the choice of repertoire, the calibre of the performers, the fact that we will be closing the Moreton Bay Anywhere Festival – and did I mention the location?

"The Amphitheatre is such a unique outdoor

venue. I have wanted to run a production at this venue for some years and this was the ideal opportunity. A celebration of musical theatre outside next to the iconic vista of Redcliffe beaches."

The audience will be dazzled by showstoppers from Redcliffe Musical Theatre stars like Erickson Illustre, Matt Leigh, Georgia Burnett, James Reid, Meg Kiddle, Kaley Jones and Colin Rhys-Jones, and ROAR Academy All Stars such as Anthony Van Stam, Lucas Van Stam, Sienna Randall and Zoe Hitchcock.

Madeleine said they would be selecting the best musical numbers from top Broadway shows including The Phantom of the Opera, Les Miserables, Wicked, and Jesus Christ Superstar.

"We will pick at least one song from each and throw in a few additional extras," she said. "Most songs will be performed with appropriate staging and we plan to have an ensemble of singers on risers to the left of the stage, so that should look pretty spectacular."

Viva La Musica will be accompanying the performance with a small orchestra, under the musical direction of Rhonda Davidson-Irwin, who will also play flute.

ver three decades, Redcliffe's Dennis Austen has made his name as a successful local real estate agent, but he was born into a family of renowned brass band players, which produced several New South Wales brass band champions. Although Dennis learned to play the tenor horn aged eight, he quickly broke the family brass band tradition.

As an adult, he started work in Sydney's old PostMaster General's Department with some success, but a strong entrepreneurial spirit drove him into buying vacant blocks of land in Sydney's Blacktown and selling them at a good profit. Spurred on, he joined a finance company where he learned the in's and out's of the finance world. Obtaining a dealers licence, Dennis commenced selling motor vehicles in Queensland, which motivated him to move his young family to Queensland and to Redcliffe.

With a friend, the pair opened four real estate offices on Brisbane's northside to cope with a growing real estate market. A downturn saw the pair part company with Dennis returning to a job in a New South Wales colliery.

But the old entrepreneurial business spirit returned and its call saw Dennis and his family return to Redcliffe, where they purchased Redcliffe's late iconic Monsignor Frawley's home at Scarborough. He rejoined his old real estate friend and together they continued the original real estate partnership, which only ended with his partner's retirement.

Always one to demand a fair go, Dennis ventured into local politics, forming RAG, a ratepayers association a decade ago. He followed this by forming a political party called Community First, which fielded five candidates in a recent Council election. They polled an average of 35% of the votes.

Although now into his seventies Dennis, along with his wife Margaret, five children and seven grandchildren and his pride and joy, a 2006 Jaguar S motor continues to involve himself in real estate and attend local trivia club meetings.

Will he retire?

"Maybe one day! But they'll probably have to carry me out!" he laughs.

"We sent a very ordinary phone recording of our songs and a few months later, we were in the studio with him," Jon said.

Oleander Grove have now released their album to the world, following a successful show at Picnic Hill.

"We were proud of our performance and the crowd was amazing," Jon said. "They seemed very engaged in our performance and received some people at the front of the stage singing along to our songs, which blew us away."

Executive manager of Redcliffe Area Youth Space, Amy Mayes said she was thrilled when Oleander Grove chose Picnic Hill to launch their album.

"They really engaged the audience through their catchy tunes and relatable lyrics," Amy said. "I still have their song Blue running through my head."



LIVING WITH CHUCKY - MOVIE REVIEW

hat if you grew up with a killer doll. For writer and director Kyra Elise Gardner that's exactly what she did.

Her father was the makeup artist and head puppeteer who literally helped bring a killer doll named Chucky to life.

The titular Chucky has been starring in his own film franchise for over 30 years so Kyra was curious to see how her Dad has been spending his time.

Which led her to create this documentary and was also a great excuse to meet the cast and crew involved in the franchise. Like any good documentary it has a purpose.

Kyra has grown up hearing about the crew but has never had a chance to meet them. So, she set out to interview all of the key contributors to find out why Chucky means so much to them. Including the film's creators, crew and stars.

Initially the film brings you up to speed on the premise of the franchise and then takes you on

a blow-by-blow journey through each film. Even though there are massive diminishing returns with the Chucky sequels, I'm always fascinated with how bad films are created. It helps you understand the decisions people made and what they were hoping to achieve.

These films have been surrounded with some controversy which I would have liked to see explored more but I can understand the reason for leaving some elements out due to their sensitive nature and the fun tone of the film.

You don't necessarily need to be a Horror aficionado to enjoy this doco, although it would definitely help as Horror nuts will lap up all of the backstage secrets and on set stories.

If you have an interest in the filmmaking process it offers great insights into the techniques and skills used. Although be warned, if you're more on the squeamish side, there are moments of blood and gore that could be a bit too much for the more discerning viewer.

On the whole this is a solid documentary exploring people's fascination and love for the horror genre, in particular, a little doll named Chucky.





magine if the love of your life wasn't real. Worse than that, what if someone had not only created an entirely fake persona but strung you along for 10 long years?

This is known as 'Catfishing' where a scammer creates an identity to trap people into a relationship based on a lie. The purpose is usually to exploit their victims for money or sex, but this case is far more bizarre. If this story was made into a film, you wouldn't believe it.

The podcast was created by investigative journalist Alexi Mostrous who decided to help catfish victim Kirat Simran uncover who she'd been communicating with for all these years and ultimately why.

Now your assumption might be, 'I'd never fall for that'. You may want to reconsider when you listen to the lengths that the perpetrator was willing to go to. Developing a whole network of around 40 fake people to corroborate their story and manipulate Kirat.

When you find out who's behind wasting a decade of her life you may reconsider if you even need social media anymore. Manipulation on an epic scale.





A MASTER MODELLER

7 year old Stephen Deacon, a Vietnam Veteran, turned master modeller, never believed he would succumb to skin cancer, but sadly that dreadful disease recently caused his death. He left his 95 year old grieving father John, his sister Sally and younger brother Michael, all of whom fondly remember the happy memories that Stephen created in his home in Scarborough.

To say that Stephen loved modelling is an understatement. His Home is filled with over 60 models, both large and small. Figurines, clocks, ships, boats, trains, buildings and planes all meticulously constructed by his expert hand. Antiques dealer Meade Murphy, who purchased some of Stephen's memorabilia including a stuffed crocodile, was overwhelmed.

"It was like stepping into a museum. The models are brilliant and they are in every room!" said Meade.

Sitting alone in solitary splendour is a glass cabinet, measuring over a metre long and nearly a metre high is a superb diorama model of Captain Cook's H.M.S. Endeavour being loaded at England's Portsmouth harbour prior to its epic journey to Australia in 1768

Stephen's father John wishes to donate the diorama to the Redcliffe Museum

"I know Stephen would have wanted to have the Redcliffe

Community own this important piece of Australian history and see the Endeavour in all its glory!" he said.

But Stephen's story goes beyond his modelling skills. The Deacon family have a rich seafaring pedigree. Generationally the family comes from seaside Portsmouth from where Stephen's grandfather and father proudly served on British warships. But in 1963, the family of father John, mother Patricia, 16 year old Stephen, 14 year old Sally and 4 year old Michael, tired of England's cold wet weather arrived in Melbourne and after a decade or so, the family found Redcliffe, where they remained.

Stephen, who had qualified as a fitter and turner was readily accepted into the Australian Army, finally becoming a Warrant Officer. He served in the Army for the next 23 years, including tours of duty in Vietnam. After leaving army service and patriotic to the end, he constructed a home flagpole and each morning would raise the flag with a salute. This ceremony only ceased when he was too ill to walk.

His ashes were scattered near Scarborough's seaside Moreton Bay fig trees, where his 93 year old mother Patricia's ashes had earlier been scattered.

During his lifetime Stephen also brewed his own beer. At his funeral sister Sally opened the last bottle of his home brew and tipped the contents over his ashes "Just in case he ever got thirsty!" she said.

am always delighted when I witness growth in students at Art So Lively, regardless of their age. The joy it brings is one of the main reasons I conduct classes. I was reminded of those feelings when I recently read about two very successful

London-based artists now aged in their eighties, who for the love of art have truly persevered and triumphed.

They first met in 1967 as art students and decided then to make a life and art together despite many obstacles. Their family backgrounds were anything but artistic. Branding themselves Gilbert and George, this quirky couple worked collaboratively

on everything. Their work was dismissed as rubbish at art school and after graduating, attracted much criticism (and attention) due partly to the then controversial subject

matter and issues exposed and explored. It was edgy and avant-garde. Unusual and provocative are words to describe the duo's work. They were not accepted.

Yet they persevered. In time their work attracted a significant international following. In 2007, the Tate Modern published The Complete Pictures, which included over a thousand examples of their art. They featured in a BBC art documentary and were the subject of numerous articles in British national newspapers. Several international solo exhibitions fuelled their populous fire. They possess honorary doctorates and continue winning awards, including the prestigious Turner Prize.

In life, they are seldom separated and together they recently developed and opened an art museum, which they now own.

What an unpredictable success story is theirs!
Disregarded as art students, weathering heavy handed commentary from the critics and at times questioning their own ability, Gilbert and George's perseverance and continued self belief overcame all the challenges those early days threw at the couple. Victory has been theirs.



here are many types of Rainbowfish in Australia and Papua New Guinea but the Crimson Spot Rainbowfish is my favourite. A stunning and peaceful addition to any aquarium or outdoor pond, these fish are frog friendly and eat mosquito larvae.

These little Aussies are loved throughout the world and kept and bred by enthusiasts in many countries including Germany, The Netherlands,

Austria and USA. It is a common belief that when first discovered, it was our local species that was thought to be so pretty that they were named Rainbowfish.

Found east of the Great Dividing Range in Northern NSW up to Baffle Creek just north of Bundaberg and in many of our local waterways including Caboolture River, the Pine Rivers and most probably in your favourite swimming hole or duck pond if it isn't infested with feral species like Tilapia and Gambusia.

A few Crimson Spot Rainbowfish in your home pond is all you need to get started as they breed very well in the warmer months. They are easily caught in traps baited with bread and vegemite and if you are quick enough, with a dip net.

A good friend of mine Steve Baines has written a children's picture book called I Believe in Rainbows. This is a great educational story about the plight of our little native Aussie fish and Rodney the Rainbowfish. It is worth looking up if you get the chance.

"The best fish for your pond are always local natives from your closest waterway."
