

How to Keep Upright is a highly successful Smart Rider Roadcraft course run on Saturday, the 5th of August, in conjunction with the Queensland Police Service.


The course is currently open to riders of all experience levels, teaching riders how to brake effectively, master slow speed turns, choose the best riding gear, and improve their confidence while riding.

he Soweto Gospel Choir has thrilled and inspired audiences worldwide and now they are set to raise the roof in Redcliffe.

The triple Grammy award-winning choir will celebrate the music of protest and freedom when they perform their latest show, Hope at the Redcliffe Entertainment Centre this month.

Choirmaster, Shimmy Jiyane said Hope was a special show for the Soweto Gospel Choir.

"These are the songs that we grew up on; that inspired us and that keep inspiring us," Shimmy said. "Hope showcases how the power of song and the power of performance can inspire and soundtrack real change."

The show opens with a performance of South African freedom songs, before moving on to Martin Luther King's 1950's America and renditions of the protest music of the Civil Rights Movement, including works by James Brown, Sam Cooke, Stevie Wonder and Aretha Franklin.

The Soweto Gospel Choir formed in 2002 and includes the best talent from churches in and around Soweto, South Africa.

A founding member of the choir, Shimmy began as a dancer and now performs as a lead tenor.

He said all the songs from the show were amazing and had a strong message of hope

that resonated with people across the world. "The best thing is that we get to perform for different audiences all over the world, and we get to share our great music, culture and tradition," Shimmy said.

"It's always powerful to see that gospel music touches people everywhere and is a shared language for hope."

The Australian tour starts with shows in Western Australia before heading to Redcliffe for the first Queensland performance.

"We're going back to Queensland once more, and it feels great because the last time we were there it was amazing, but it's been too long between visits," Shimmy said.

"Australia is our second home and we feel great and blessed every time we tour there. People are so loving and friendly and they show their support for us big time. Their joy is something we can always feel as we look out at the crowd. It is our hope that the audience finds the show as reviving and uplifting as we do in performing it."

had put in a dreadful day, and the thought of being simply stewed or baked alive in Brisbane made one think of getting away."

So said a suffering city-dweller in The Queenslander in 1902. The answer to his dilemma? "Why not go down to Humpybong on the Emerald?" He was by no means alone in looking to Redcliffe for a bit of summertime recreation, and the proprietors of the Emerald, the Humpybong Steamship Company, were ready to assist in the fulfilment of this desire.

The Emerald was commissioned in 1900 and took her maiden voyage to the peninsula in August of that year. She, "gaily decked with bunting", was seen off in Brisbane by a large crowd of interested spectators and greeted on arrival at Woody Point by "three rousing cheers". The honoured guests for this first sailing were treated to luncheon and, on the run back to Brisbane, "afternoon tea and other refreshments".

From then on, the Emerald was the vessel of choice for Brisbane holidaymakers heading to Redcliffe. There were scheduled weekly sailings (daily in holiday periods) and she was also available for charter. The destination ("that most charming of watering places") and the comfort of the boat contributed to the vessel's popularity. Equipped with a "handsomely upholstered" saloon, a ladies' cabin and a "splendid bar", the

Emerald also boasted lavish catering. As a 1908 passenger reported, "an excellent breakfast is provided" with the menu offering "whitebait a la Francaise; grilled steak and onions; and cold pressed ox tongue". It is perhaps as well that the "lavatories ... befitted a first-class vessel"

Like most businesspeople, the vessel's owners were not above a bit of politicking. As reported by The Weekly, the Redcliffe Divisional Board held a special meeting aboard the Emerald in 1902, as the guests of Mr Hayes (both an owner of the ship and a member of the divisional board) to discuss urgent repairs to the Redcliffe jetty and other matters pertinent to "the convenience and safety of the public and the steamer itself". An inspection of the jetty was followed by "an excellent luncheon" after which the board discussed and agreed to the necessary repairs. No doubt the cheque for £30, being the steamship company's "annual due to the board" helped to offset the cost of repairs to the jetty.

The Emerald continued to convey Moreton Bay excursionists until 1911, when she was sold to a Western Australian company and started a new life ferrying holidaymakers between Perth and Rottnest Island.

Gustav the Great

eing passionate about all things arty means I am constantly reading about art history and current art news. And, I'm not the only one! Recently one of my adult (Art So Lively Academy) students shared news about the record breaking art sale of a

Gustav Klimt painting. It is entitled Lady with a Fan and sold for \$A161 million, putting it as the most valuable painting ever sold in Europe! A Hong Kong collector successfully purchased it at a Sotheby's auction.

It was Klimt's last painting and was still on his easel when he died aged 55 in 1918. The last time this painting was put up for auction was in 1994 and it fetched just over \$A17million. In 30 years its value has increased nearly ten fold!

He was born into a family with artistic leanings. His father was a gold engraver and many of Gustav's paintings include gold leaf, imbuing the work with an ethereal quality. He began his

professional career painting interior murals and ceilings in large public buildings and was awarded the Golden Order of Merit for his work, by the Austrian Emperor Franz Josef.

Austrian born Gustav Klimt was known as a symbolist painter. This means that he painted images that included certain motifs, shapes, colours and other elements that were symbols for deeper ideas. Klimt's paintings expressed underlying meanings not immediately evident. For example, the famous work, The Kiss, is said to represent the mystical union of spiritual and erotic love. The rectangular motif represents male and the circle female, two opposites and individuals merging as one with the eternal cosmos.

In his lifetime, Klimt created over 200 paintings but many were destroyed by the Nazi's during World War Two, because of the artworks so-called "indecent" subject matter. The Lady with a Fan has been described as an erotic masterpiece painted by an artist at the height of his powers with strong Asian influences originating primarily from Japan.

In the 1890's Klimt met fashion designer Emilie Floge and they fell in love. Emilie was to become his life companion. It has long been rumoured that his famous painting The Kiss is a portrait of Emilie and him together.

In 1918, Klimt fell ill with the so-called Spanish flu, which at the time killed nearly 5% of the world's population. Severe complications, including a stroke, developed causing his death in February 1918. An untimely ending for this brilliant artist.

he's a Barbie girl (who is having an existential crisis) in the Barbie world. Life isn't so fantastic. So she decides to head to the 'real world' with Ken because we've got everything sorted over here right?

The film highlights the paradox that is Barbie... and owns it. It would seem that they wrote a pros and cons list and tackled every item on it. Was Barbie an astronaut before women were allowed credit cards? Yes. Has she perpetuated unachievable body image stereotypes? Yes. Do they address both of these issues and everything in between - 100%.

Even Mattel, the makers of Barbie and this film, aren't safe, poking fun at their own lack of diversity hiring.

The narration from Helen Mirren, although brief, is one of the highlights. Punctuating moments with her dry British wit.

The message of inequality is prevalent in every line of this film and although it's an extremely important message, it could have been done without bashing you over the head with it for 2 hours.

Mums and Dads will love the nostalgia and the occasional double entendre. Girls and boys will have fun while hopefully absorbing her (not so subtle) message.

"We all dressed up in period costumes as we had Charlie Chaplin playing. Of course, dressing up is optional," he said.





Winter Whiting Sillago maculata

his time of year Winter Whiting, sometimes known as Trumpeter or Diver Whiting, schools up in sandy and silty areas in Moreton Bay. Of the few species of Whiting that appear locally the Winter Whiting and Sand or Summer Whiting are the only two that the majority of Moreton Bay anglers will see.

While "Winteries" have no size limit and a possession limit of 50, Sand Whiting have a limit of 23cm and a bag limit of 30 so it is wise to know the difference.

Basically Sand Whiting have yellowish fins and Winteries have dark blotches or spots along their back and sides. It is always best though to have a book or an app to help identify fish species.

When you find these fish they are quite easy to catch. The best bait I think is beachworms, with yabbies being great too. Live bloodworms are incredible, but expensive and a lot of work to acquire yourself. A few people also use fresh squid strips dyed red. I have caught them on the incoming tide at Hayes Inlet and quite a few times just drifting in the boat on the sand flats. They also make a great live bait catching Flathead and Snapper.

However post Covid, her busy world took an unexpected and dramatic turn. Passionate about her Redcliffe heritage, she was horrified to learn last year of the Moreton Bay Regional Council's plan to demolish the iconic Suttons Beach Pavilion.

"The Pavilion has always been a special place for me and my family. Our family celebrated Father's Day there for years. We even had my grandad's 80th birthday there." She remembered.

Faced with the prospect of its demolition, Jodie resolved to save the building by circulating a petition.

"The response was unbelievable. People not only responded by signing the petition, but volunteered to help as well," she said.

She formed a chat group and a Facebook page, which attracted more and more supporters, now numbering thousands and was branded The Suttons Beach Pavilion Preservation Group.

The media picked up her story and television and radio interviews followed. This coupled with a rally at the Pavilion attended by several hundred supporters attracted the attention of the Council , who announced the demolition's postponement and they commissioned an independent study into the building's safety, which when released revealed that the building was unsafe and demolition would need to be done.

Whilst the group was disappointed at the outcome, they were buoyed by Council agreeing to rebuild the icon, in a style befitting its former 1930's art deco style. Jodie and her group of stalwarts are planning a community farewell wake on the eve of the Pavilion's demolition.


