Along with nearly 5 million of my fellow television watching Aussies, I was swept along on a tide of mass football hysteria, when a red haired athletically built 25 year old young woman named Cortnee Vine scored the winning penalty goal. This enabled the Australian Matildas women's football team to rocket into the semi-final to face an English side who were the current European women's football champions. This was the first time that an Australian women's football team had reached a FIFA Women's World Cup semi-final in the World Cup's 32 year history. But we Aussies didn't give up on our team when they were subsequently beaten by the English and then by Sweden, for the bronze medal. Instead our supportive fascination with this 23 member Australian squad has continued on.

My interest in the Matildas has continued to grow as I learned that the goal scoring redhead Cortnee Vine, although now playing for Sydney Football Club in the Women's National Football competition, was originally a Clontarf Beach State High School student, who had lived at Mango Hill and played for Redcliffe's Peninsula Power Football Club from 2010 to 2015, where she no doubt honed her footballing skills. Her Physical Education teacher at Clontarf Naomi

Gomersall remembers her as a modest, happy student dedicated to football. These comments were echoed by her Peninsula Power football coach in the early days, Paul Dunne.

And yet another great footballing bonus rolled Redcliffe's way. Another member of the current Matildas squad grew up in Redcliffe as well. Teagan Micah attended Redcliffe State High School and as a teenager also played for Peninsula Power Soccer Club. Teagan is currently reserve goalkeeper to regular Matildas keeper McKenzie Arnold, having played in a number of games. She now plays for Liverpool in the English Women's Premier League.

But Redcliffe women's football and the Peninsula Power connection with the Matilda's didn't start with either Cortnee or Teagan. Over a near decade long period Kate McShea, a Redcliffe born and bred youngster worked her way up through the women's footballing ranks from a start with Peninsula Power through to the stand-in captaincy of Australia's Matildas. Other ex-Peninsula Power women's players to represent our country are Larissa Crummer, Melissa Feuerriegel, Brittany Whitfield and a number of others. Proving that the Redcliffe Peninsula is truly a cradle of Australian women's football.

Get ready for a sky-high weekend with two action-packed days full of live entertainment, rides, good food, and even better kites.

The Redcliffe KiteFest is returning to Pelican Park on the 16th and 17th of September, providing locals with non-stop fun and entertainment.

MBRIT Spokesperson Natassia Wheeler said that locals need to get ready for the biggest and best KiteFest yet.

"We're thrilled to announce that Jj from CoComelon and the beloved PAW Patrol will be headlining the Sesame Lane Mainstage, both treating our eager audience to two incredible daily shows. Brace yourself for

an exhilarating experience with International Kite displays, carnival rides, over 150 market stalls, aerobatic displays, and free and low-cost workshops," Natassia said.

This year, Redcliffe KiteFest has partnered with Aqua Warrior to offer a weekend filled with aquatic adventures.

Festival goers can fly kites within the Public Kite Flying Zone, but this year, Redcliffe KiteFest will feature its largest contingency of international kite flyers from Malaysia, Indonesia, Belgium, and New Zealand.

I reached out to Chee Wan Leong, the international kite flyer for Malaysia, and he told me all about his history with kites.

"I had always been fascinated by all things that fly. My earliest memory was when Dad made a kite for me when I was five. I was fascinated by how he built it with bamboo and paper.

I always wanted to express my art uniquely...over the years, I honed my kite skills, dabbled with all forms of kites, and finally settled on a design unique to me. This year I will debut

two new single-point, high-aspect kites in Redcliffe," Chee Wan said.

One of Leong's kites is titled 'Mantha,' which is a flying manta-ray with a 5m wingspan. The second kite is titled 'Raptor,' and is a "overkill bird scarer" with a 5.5m wingspan.

You won't want to miss this year's KiteFest!

"We believe in making KiteFest accessible to everyone, and as part of that commitment, we offer complimentary entry for carers with a valid companion card," Natassia said.

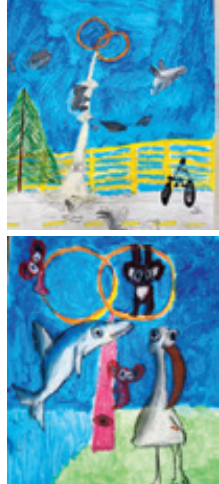

HUMPYBONG SCHOOL ART SHOW HONOURS REDCLIFFE

Redcliffe's landmarks will be brought to life by local students in one of the biggest school art shows on the Peninsula.

The annual Humpybong State School Art Show returns this month to showcase more than 1400 student artworks, covering a space of approximately 1000 square metres in the school's assembly hall.

Humpybong State School Arts Specialist Susan Gossow said this year's show would feature paintings, drawings, mixed media, weaving and a large installation of Redcliffe's well-known landmarks.

"This is a 3D installation made out of Woolworths brown paper bags," Susan said. "One-hundred and twenty-five students were put into teams of five or six and they chose a Redcliffe landmark to draw and paint on the bags. The tricky part for the students was that the bags had to connect. The students had to show not only their creative skills but also collaboration and problem solving."

The installation covers an area of approximately 10 square metres, with landmarks including Suttons Beach Pavilion, Humpybong Creek, Redcliffe Jetty, Woody Point Jetty, Redcliffe

Museum and the Hornibrook Bridge, complete with old toll booths.

The school is inviting the community to attend the opening night on Tuesday, 12 September for cheese and wine and an auction of community donated artworks. Andrew Reibelt, the owner of Image Property Consultants Redcliffe and Brew Buggy, will be the official auctioneer for the evening, with all money raised going towards the school's P&C.

"Mr Reibelt will auction six donated artworks from our local community," Susan said. "Items include paintings, photography and clothing. The four year 6 classes will also have their collaborative class artwork auctioned."

The art gallery will be open again for public viewing on Wednesday, 13 September and Thursday, 14 September between 3.30pm and 5pm.

The students have been preparing for the show all year, with half the school learning Visual Arts in the first term and the remaining half in the second term.

Susan said she would love the community to support the show. "Come to the Humpybong State School Arts Show and be blown away by the inspiring and talented work of our Prep to Year 6 students," she said. "You will not be disappointed."

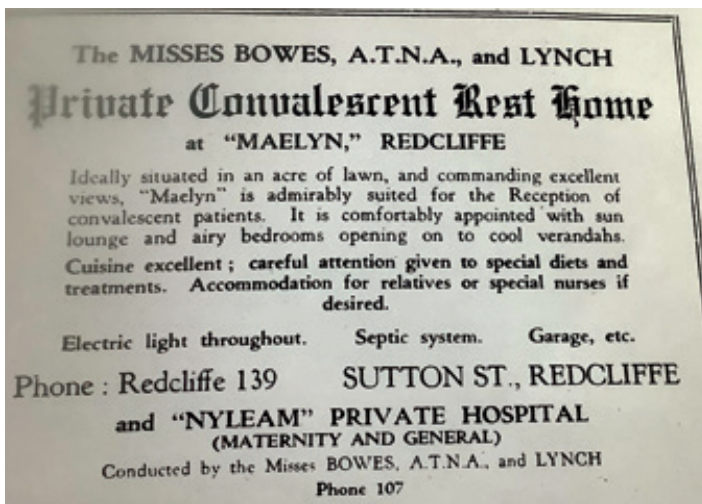

sale by a Miss Nelson, who listed it as a "BARGAIN ... fully furnished, piano, suitable for boarding house"; not bargain enough, it seems, because Miss Nelson remained there, still advertising "furnished rooms, use dining-room and kitchen", until 1918. In 1921, the Hotel and Boarding House Directory listed Ruby House under the proprietorship of Mrs J Phillips, offering rooms ranging in price from 10 to 20 shillings.

HISTORY REDCLIFFE

MAELYN: A HOUSE WITH MANY LIVES

Many of the grand old residences that once graced the Redcliffe peninsula have gone - demolished, destroyed by fire or removed to other locations. We know what many of them looked like but discovering anything about the lives they encompassed is more problematic.

One such house, named Glenallen, in Sutton Street, was built in the early 1900s by Captain James Stone, "one of Queensland's oldest and most respected pioneers". Captain Stone died at Glenallen in 1912. Listed for sale in 1913, it was described as "a commodious and well-built residence" with six large rooms, verandas all round and boasting a laundry, "18-gallon copper, 2 tanks and tennis court". The asking price was £750.

Glenallen then underwent a change of name and next appears in records for 1916 as Ruby House. No longer a grand family home but a seaside boarding establishment being advertised for

By the following year, Ruby House had become the home of Mr Hubert Elson and the headquarters of his transportation company, the Redcliffe-Petrie Motor Service, which conveyed passengers and goods between Woody Point, Redcliffe and the Petrie railway station, and provided the first bus service between Redcliffe and Brisbane.

After 1926 and several further changes of ownership, the house became, in 1931, a private convalescent home ("comfortably appointed, sun lounge and airy rooms ... careful attention given to special diets and treatments") run by Misses Madeline Bowes and Eileen Lynch who named the house Maelyn, a combination of their names. Misses Bowes and Lynch ran Maelyn until 1943, promoting it as an "ideal winter resort for convalescent invalids [and] elderly people". They sometimes made the extensive grounds available to the Redcliffe CWA for fundraising garden parties and fetes.

Wartime brought about yet another change for Maelyn. In 1942 it was the Maelyn hostel for returned soldiers and the next year it was rented by the Queensland division of the Australian Comforts Fund as a recreation centre for military personnel on leave. Bought in 1943 by the Sampson family, it became, once more, a family home until sometime in the 1980s, when it was sold for removal. What stories that house could have told!

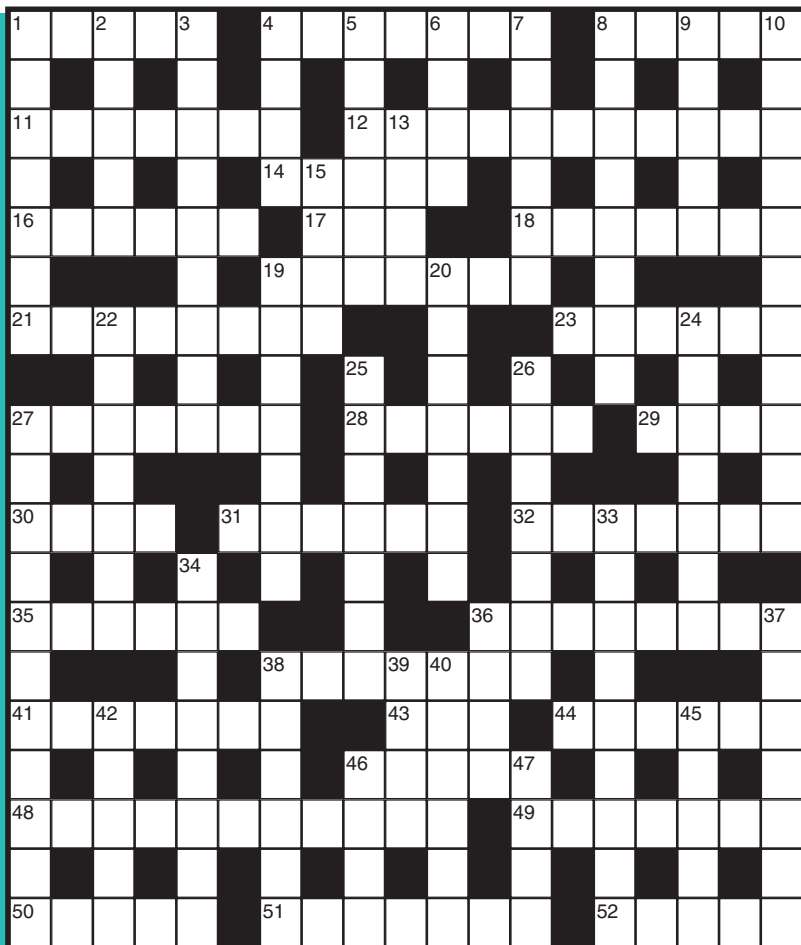

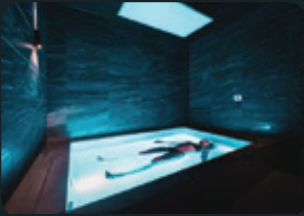

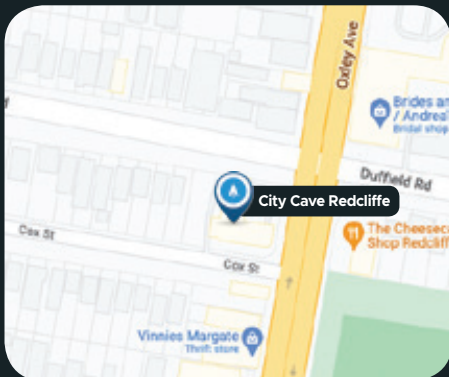

The Moreton Bay Regional Council (MBRC) announced a fully funded demand study is being considered to investigate Bay Cats as alternative transport for the Bay's waterways. This would link Bribie Island to Brisbane.

Mayor Peter Flannery is keen for the study as

it will reveal all pros/cons in undertaking such an endeavour. "Our population is growing, the Bruce is grinding to a halt, congestion consistently rates as one of the highest stress factors for locals," said Mayor Flannery. "The study will look at the possible demand for this kind of ferry service for both commuters and visitors."

Increased tourism from the upcoming Olympics would impact the Bay as well. "This is a golden opportunity to make Moreton Bay a 'must visit' destination," said Mayor Flannery. "Brisbane's City Cats have only been operating for 26 years, but fast-forward to 2023, they're not just public transport, they're one of Brisbane's top tourism attractions and a great way to see the sights."

Internationally, many cities utilise aqua buses/ferries as part of their transport options: Vancouver, Amsterdam, Copenhagen, are a few.

In due course, MBRC will announce who the study will be awarded to and the results.

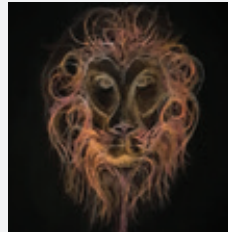

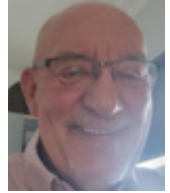

BENCHMARK PROJECT FOR WOODWORK STUDENTS

A group of local high school students have been learning valuable carpentry skills as part of a community collaboration.

Redcliffe State High School's year 11 woodwork students built three hardwood benches for the Sandgate Golf Club, thanks to funding from a Kedron-Wavell Community Grant.

The students constructed the benches using spotted gum under the guidance of woodwork teacher Mat Lewis, who also designed the benches.

"The students were very proud of their work and they really enjoyed working with hardwood," Mat said. "The legs were rough sawn 90 by 45 millimetre spotted gum that students planed back and finished themselves. They were delighted to see one of their projects used in the community and that gave them a real sense of achievement."

Redcliffe State High School employee and Sandgate Golf Club member and volunteer grants writer, Claire Daly organised the collaboration between the school and the golf club. Last year, the golf club received \$2500 under Kedron-Wavell's Community Grants Program.

Claire said the benches were one of the projects the golf club had been working on to improve the course facilities while rebuilding

the golf club house, which was badly damaged in the February 2022 floods.

"We've had so many positive comments from our members and visitors about the quality of these seats," Claire said. "We really appreciate the work of the students and the grant from Kedron-Wavell Services Club."

Now the work has been completed, the benches have pride of place on the golf course, with each including a plaque acknowledging Kedron-Wavell's contribution and the work of the students.

Redcliffe State High School's Head of Design Technology Angela Gilbert said the students had previously carried out other successful community projects.

"Last year, our year 12 students made some picnic tables for Scarborough State School, which have been extensively used by the younger students for outside learning, recreation and lunch breaks," Angela said.

"Community collaborations are a wonderful way for our students to learn new skills, whilst enjoying the feeling of contributing to the local community."

LEVI BLOWS JUDGES AWAY ON THE VOICE

A young musician who performs regularly at the Redcliffe Markets is now the star of a national reality TV show.

Fifteen-year-old Levi X amazed viewers with his saxophone and vocal performance during the blind auditions round on the current season of *The Voice Australia*.

"Over the years a number of people have come up to me at gigs and told me I should go on *The Voice*," Levi said. "This year I thought I'd put an application in to see what happened. If successful, which I obviously was, I thought it might be a great opportunity to share my music with an even wider audience beyond south-east Queensland where I play."

The Deception Bay resident first appeared on the show last month when his performance of *Seven Nation Army* by *The White Stripes* caused judges Rita Ora and Jason Derulo to press their 'I Want You' buttons and turn their chairs around.

"I knew that whether or not the chairs turned, it would be an experience in my journey that I would get a lot from, especially being so young and at the start of my musical career," Levi said. "However, while I tried to rationalise in my mind that it didn't really matter if a chair turned, I'm sure every artist who is actively gigging also fears being rejected on a national stage – you can't help not make it personal – so it is a bit of a risk even participating in the show. When I finally had those chairs turn for me, it was a huge relief."

Levi, who has been playing saxophone since Grade 4, said he and his father began busking together at the Redcliffe Markets when he was 11 years old.

"We borrowed a friend's rock and roll

speaker and 4 channel mixer and off we went," he said. "We were fortunately good enough that we were allowed to play again the following month."

At 13, Levi added singing to their performance. His brother soon joined them on guitar. Now the trio perform at several venues most weekends.

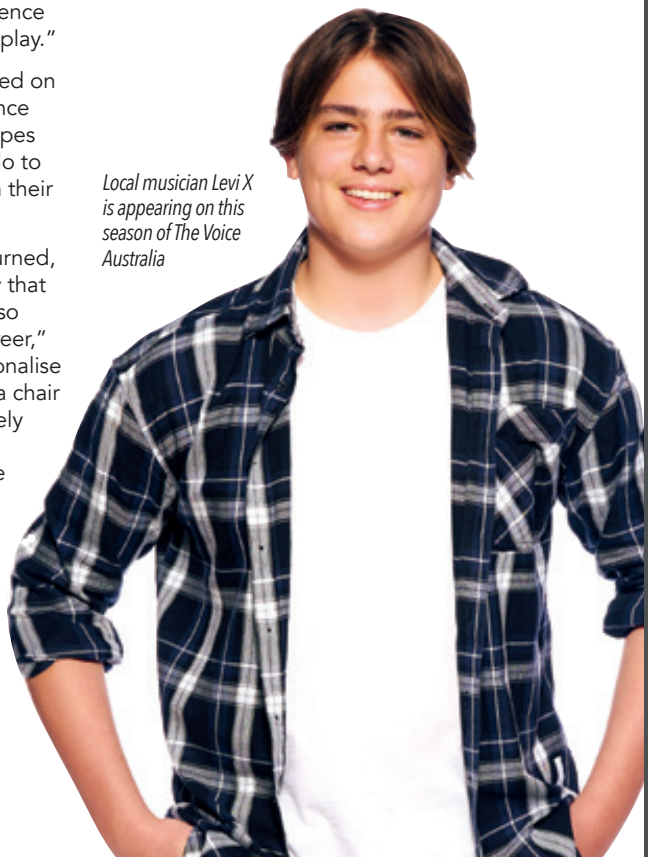
He said *The Voice* was a fantastic opportunity to get wider exposure.

"The ideal outcome, of course, would be to connect with people in the industry who can get behind me and work with me to further my career," he said.

LEISEL JONES A DRIVING FORCE IN COMMUNITY

After much petitioning and plenty of excitement, Moreton Bay now has its very own spot on the map to honour Australian Olympic gold winner Leisel Jones and her history in the community.

The service road in Rothwell near Bunnings, formerly known as Leisel Drive, has been renamed Leisel Jones Drive, following months of intense campaigning from the Triple M's The Rush Hour Team, a celebratory motorcade, and a series of overall serendipitous events.

According to Leisel Jones, OAM, she had been aware of the location's existence for a long time, but it wasn't until February of this year that the radio broadcast crew learned that the street still existed and was in use.

Having grown up in the area and having attended school at nearby Southern Cross Catholic College, she said that the coincidence

was "bizarre" and that she was "super lucky in the way that it just came together".

"It's a really pinch-me moment to be recognised in that way. It's just so humbling and lovely. Not many people have a whole street named after them in an area they grew up in and absolutely love."

It's an outlook echoed by Moreton Bay Mayor Peter Flannery, who said he was "thrilled to be acknowledging Leisel Jones OAM in this way, as one of Moreton Bay's greatest ever talents and one of Australia's most successful sportswomen."

"The key thing we're looking for when considering a place name is a strong local connection to that area or a story to tell about the namesake, like the fact Leisel Jones went to school just up the road from here and has done Moreton Bay and Australia immensely proud on the international stage."

The drive was renamed just as Moreton Bay was established as a city, and, in light of this, Ms Jones said it was wonderful that the region was "recognised for how big it's growing while still keeping its community feel".

Ms Jones thanked the Triple M team, the Moreton Bay Council and Mayor Peter Flannery for being instrumental in making Leisel Jones Drive and the motorcade event a reality.

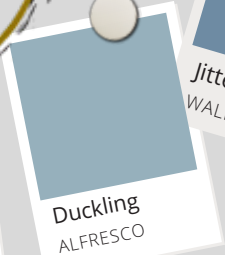
According to Ms Sawtell, families were looking forward to having movie days and arranging family functions with residents “where they can be together just like old times”.

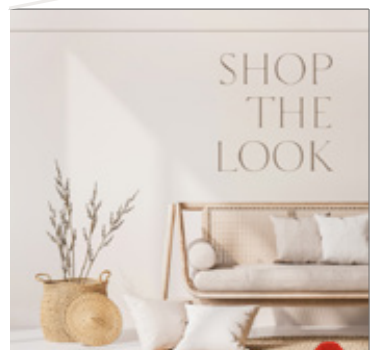

REDCLIFFE LIBRARY BEGINS NEXT CHAPTER

The first phase of an upgrade to the Redcliffe Library is underway and is set to increase flexibility and functionality for customers.

The works began last month at the library on Oxley Avenue and will include an internal refurbishment of the current layout, which will see the former Redcliffe Art Gallery converted into usable library space.

City of Moreton Bay Division 6 Councillor Karl Winchester said the library was the “most visited library in Moreton Bay”.

“Each month I hold mobile offices at the library and know that this busy facility attracts people from all backgrounds into a space of knowledge, sharing and community,” Cr Winchester said.

“In recent years we’ve increased access to services by opening on Sundays and installing a lift. This phase of the project brings even more to our bustling library by expanding into the old art gallery area, installing an adult changing place and creating a coffee cart space. Our libraries are a vital community resource and this upgrade expands on what’s on offer.”

The old art gallery will be repurposed into collaborative zones and quiet spaces with a

new podium area to be added. There will also be a new multipurpose maker space room and two digital studios.

The adult change facilities will be located in front of the current toilets, enabling people with high support needs and their carers to access public toilets. The new coffee cart is to be stationed near the main entry.

The upgrade works will also include an update to the audio-visual and ICT (information and communications technology) equipment, an open and welcoming foyer area, improvements to the floor coverings and the creation of 24/7 membership access to the upgraded space.

All local history items are to be moved into a storage room within the library.

The construction team will be on site between the hours of 7am and 5pm, from Monday to Friday. There may be minor changes to traffic conditions, minor temporary pedestrian footpath detours and some construction noise during the works.

The project is expected to be completed within a 16 week period (by December).

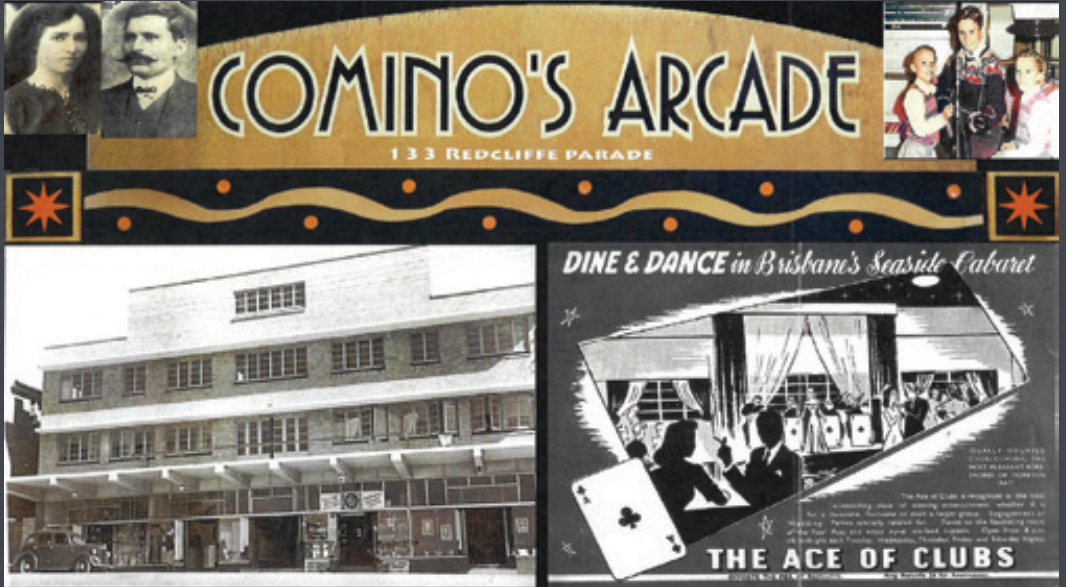

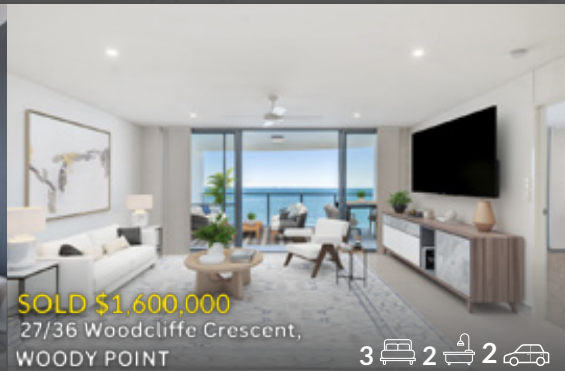
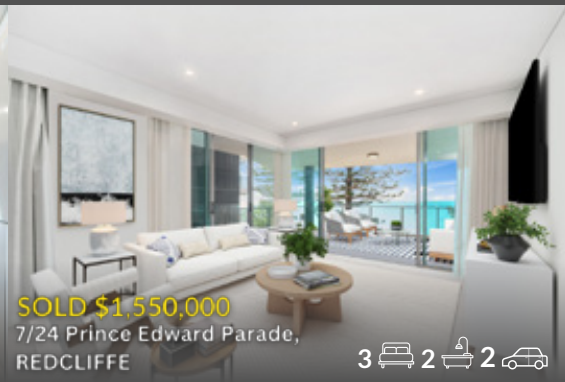

CHOCOLATE BANANA CAKE

This recipe is from the Country Women's Association Classics cookbook. An easy to make loaf cake with healthy banana and melted chocolate best enjoyed with a freshly brewed pot of tea. QCWA Clontarf Branch Member Rhonda.

INGREDIENTS

2 cups plain flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
125g softened unsalted butter
1 cup caster sugar
4 ripe bananas (mashed)
2 eggs (lightly beaten)
1 teaspoon vanilla essence
1 cup chocolate chips

METHOD

Preheat oven to 180°C. Grease a loaf tin (line base with baking paper).

Sift flour and baking powder into a large bowl.

In a separate bowl beat the butter, sugar, mashed banana, eggs, vanilla and choc chips.

Add this mixture to your dry ingredients and stir to combine with wooden spoon. (Do not overmix).

Pour batter into prepared tin and bake for 1 hour to 1 hour 15mins (depending on oven, test with skewer/fork)

Leave to cool in tin for 10 minutes before turning out onto wire rack.

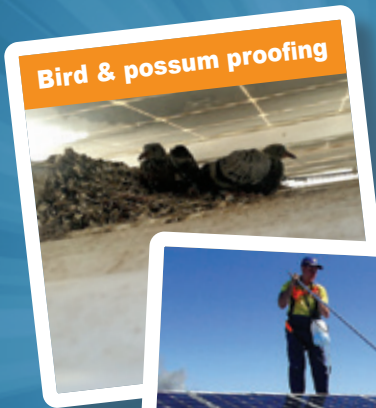
