

et ready for an unforgettable night of music and nostalgia paying tribute to the one and only Joe Cocker.

Australian blues artist Chev Wilson will lead a 10-piece band in The Joe Cocker Experience, coming to the Redcliffe Entertainment Centre in April.

Chev, who has been performing Joe Cocker's music from a young age, said he joined the Joe Cocker band a bit over a year ago and had learned his whole catalogue.

"I've been performing as a live entertainer professionally for over 15 years but I started singing when I was only about 6-7 years old, jumping on stage with my dad and some of his friends who had bands in the late nineties." he said.

"I've been performing Joe Cocker's music throughout that time. I learned a handful of his songs over the years. I've been performing The Letter since I was about 10 years old."

The Joe Cocker Experience, presented by The Good Company, will take the audience on a journey through Joe's career, including his early days in Sheffield to his iconic performance at Woodstock and beyond.

"The audience can expect one absolutely awesome Joe Cocker show where we go

through all of Joe's big songs and we take people on a journey back to the music of Joe Cocker," Chev said.

Chev and the band will perform hits such as Leave Your Hat On, You Are So Beautiful, Up Where We Belong, Hitchcock Railway, Delta Lady, Unchain My Heart, The Letter, With A Little Help From My Friends, Feelin 'Alright and more.

"I think my favourite Joe Cocker song would probably be Many Rivers, just 'cause it's a really, really great song to sing and it has so much really raw human emotion in it," Chev said.

He added he believed Joe's timeless appeal came from his personality and "the fact that he was such a journeyman".

"People really loved that rawness and the fact that he just went up there and he left nothing behind," he said. "He was always 110 percent that guy when he was on stage and I think that's what makes him so popular and so memorable as an artist."

## A CENTURY OF LIFE AND LOVE FOR AUDREY MOSS

Audrey Moss with husband of 75 years, Elvyn Moss (passed away aged 99 and dearly missed)

#### iving for a century is no small accomplishment, and local resident Audrey Moss and her family are getting ready to commemorate that fact.

March 7, 1924, saw the birth of Audrey May Burnett in Warwick at Welford House, during the Jazz Age and the interval between two World Wars.

According to her son, John L Moss, his mother was the second of six children raised in rural Leyburn, Queensland.

Mr Moss said that Audrey relocated to Brisbane at the age of 18, during the war years, to begin working as a nurse at the Royal Women's Hospital.

"Her eldest sister, Mona, had preceded her to Brisbane and introduced Audrey to the man she was to marry," Mr Moss said.

Marriage to Elvyn Moss (known to his friends as Lem or Len) was swift because, according to the couple at the time, "when you know, you know."

The pair were married in 1945 at St. Brigid's Roman Catholic Church in Red Hill, with a honeymoon spent at Tamborine Mountain. Audrey had six children in 10 years (Patrick, John, Teresa, Suzanne, Daniel and Maria) who mostly spent their formative years living in the north-west Brisbane locality of Grovely.

"Mum started working as a cleaner in 1960 at Brisbane City Hall and retired in December 1979," Mr Moss said.

After her retirement and after several overseas trips, such as to America, Tijuana and Singapore, Audrey moved to Deception Bay at the start of the twenty-first century.

"Moreton Bay has been her home for 24 years and she has loved it from the foreshore," Mr Moss said.

While Audrey's early passions included needlework and embroidery, she has more recently enjoyed crocheting, a bit of gardening and time spent with grandchildren.

When told of her age on her latest birthday and in anticipation of the next, Audrey Moss said, "Gee, am I really that old!"

To celebrate her upcoming centenary, there will be a letter from the King, Prime Minister, Premier of Queensland, local MP, and City of Moreton Bay Mayor, alongside a small family gathering at Seabrook - McKenzie Aged Care (attendance limited to COVID-related and other restrictions).

Franklin's music and life in a spectacular upcoming show at the Redcliffe Entertainment Centre.

The Moreton Bay rendition of RESPECT The Aretha Franklin Story stars "Australia's Soul Mama" Angela (Angie) Narayan and is part of a wider tour taking place throughout Australia and New Zealand in 2024.

According to the show's producer, Monique Cribb of McGee Entertainment, the motivation came from a literal dream in which she saw herself creating a musical production to honour Aretha Franklin's phenomenal life's work and performance.

"I wanted to honour her legacy with the highest regard, so when I went looking for a singer who could connect with Aretha's journey and have a voice to match, I couldn't go past Australia's finest soul singer, Angie Narayan," Ms Cribb said.

Ms Narayan said that at this point she wasn't entirely sure what she was signing up for but that "every cell in her body told her to go for it".

"Monique then went ahead and wrote the show, and six months later, a production was born," Ms Narayan said.

According to Ms Narayan, Aretha Franklin has been one of the greatest musical influences of her life, but there were obviously important considerations to make when taking on the role.

"The biggest challenge to me was when I was figuring out Aretha's approach to songs, that I

still remained authentically 'Angie' and I believe I've managed to do that," Ms Narayan said.

As "the OG Diva" and a true trailblazer of her era, Ms. Narayan said that Aretha paved the path for a number of well-known musicians such as Whitney Houston and Mariah Carey.

"Aretha's also had such a powerful message that we highlight in the show, which is that everybody deserves respect," Ms Narayan said.

Ms Narayan said she was

excited about getting to spend time in the Moreton Bay region, describing the area as "unbelievably beautiful."

"I find that Moreton Bay is so passionate about performance and the arts – just really great people," she said.

#### MORETON BAY SECURES \$45.5M BOOST FOR TRANSFORMATIVE INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

City of Moreton Bay has secured \$45.53 million in funding for key infrastructure and lifestyle projects through the SEQ City Deal Liveability Fund, a collaborative effort with State and Federal Governments, Initiatives include Suttons Beach Pavilion Development, Centenary Lakes Regional Playground, Centenary Lakes Activation, Bongaree to Woorim Transport Network, and The Mill Lakes Precinct. Mayor Peter Flannery highlighted the positive impacts on residents and city growth. Projects aim to enhance liveability and align with the broader \$1.8 billion SEQ City Deal. Federal Minister Catherine King and Queensland Minister Grace Grace expressed commitment to community improvement, especially for the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

of what became known as Humpybong. There was as little in the way of medical assistance, adequate housing, nutrition or even creature comforts for the women of these families as there had been for the Amity families. Among the challenges were poor transportation, backbreaking work, and isolation: until the early 20th century, Redcliffe's population was sparse – fewer than 500 in 1901 – and scattered, most permanent residents being farmers or otherwise involved in rural pursuits such as logging or

carting.

Child mortality was as high on the peninsula as it was everywhere: there were six children among the first 27 burials in Redcliffe cemetery, the first being that of two-year-old Edward Pollard, who died in 1882. Few families, of whatever economic or social status. escaped the death of a child: Mrs Fanny Sutton, wife of the Rev John, gave birth to 11 children, three of whom died before they were three; Mrs Annie Copson lost little Ebenezer within a month of his birth; and even Mrs Anna Hobbs, wife of Dr Hobbs, a

hen Amity Moreton Thompson was born on 21 September 1824, her parents, Mary and Robert, part of the Moreton Bay Detachment, had lived in what we now know as Humpybong for all of nine days. Amity, named for the ship they arrived on, was the first of three babies born to soldiers' wives during the brief existence of the Redcliffe penal colony: Charles Moreton Miller in November 1824 and Mary Cox in March 1825. They and their mothers, and six other women with children, survived nine months in the primitive squalor of the fledgling settlement.

The Moreton Bay colony shifted to the Brisbane River in 1825, 40-odd years before pioneering families followed in their footsteps as residents great Redcliffe landowner and Brisbane's most prominent medical practitioner, endured the deaths of two sons.

Lacking good medical care, women themselves died of disease, in childbirth, from overwork or a combination of all three. At the inquest into the death of Emma Pearce, who died in 1909 of septicaemia as a result of miscarriage, it was asserted that she "never did any hard work to hurt her, although she helped (Pearce) gardening, hoeing, chopping limbs off trees, cross-cutting, clearing, and whatever he was doing", all this in addition to housework and tending to other children.

International Women's Day celebrates the successes of women; let it also be a day to honour and admire the fortitude and endurance of these and all pioneering women.

## SCHOOL STRESS & ANXIETY IN ADOLESCENCE: HOW HEADSPACE CAN HELP

ransitioning into a new school year can often be a stressful time for students - whether it's their first day at a new school, their first week of high school, or the first term of their senior year.

As students navigate new environments, evolving friendship groups and academic pressures, it's not surprising that they can often feel nervous and overwhelmed as they embark on these new experiences. And for many adolescents, these anxious feelings can linger throughout the entire school year.

Teri-Leigh Boyd, registered counsellor and Senior Intake & Assessment Officer at headspace in Redcliffe explains that it's common for students to feel a range of emotions when they're heading back to school.

"It can be an exciting time with new opportunities, new friendships and greater independence," she said. "However, many young people find it difficult to have to deal with trying to make new friends, feeling pressured to get the best marks, or bullying."

The good news is that there are ways that students can help ease some of their stress and anxiety – starting with getting enough sleep and packing a healthy lunch. "By creating routines, setting achievable goals and creating connections, students can help themselves get through some of these challenging times," Teri said. "Connecting with friends, family, school staff, social groups, mentors or volunteer groups can help when students are feeling overwhelmed and challenged."

If additional support is needed, youth mental health organisations like headspace may be able to help.

"We can all benefit from a bit of extra support from time to time," Teri said. "At headspace, we understand that not everyone's the same, so we offer support in different shapes and forms – including an array of online support such as articles, chats, and counselling, as well as in-person social groups and counselling. The best part – it's all free!"

Adolescence and young adulthood can be an exciting, yet challenging time of growth, exploration, and navigating new experiences and transitions, but knowing where to go for a little extra support can ease feelings of being stressed, nervous and overwhelmed.

# SOLDIER CRAB MICTYRIS LONGICARPUS

ut of the three different species of soldier crabs that inhabit Moreton Bay, the Light Blue Soldier Crab is the most prolific and found across the eastern coast of Australia inhabiting tidal wetlands, sand-flats and estuaries.

About the size of a 20 cent piece they feed on the detritus and algae in the substrate leaving behind little round balls of sand.

Commonly seen as large armies on our local tidal flats and burying themselves like a corkscrew in seconds when threatened, they are probably one of the most loved crabs of Australia, fascinating children (and adults like me) for years.

Larger fish such as bream and whiting, along with a host of others such as sting rays, love feeding on soldier crabs too making them a fantastic and easy to collect fresh bait.

Could you believe a convicted murderer?

s most crime aficionados know, when a wife is found dead, the prime suspect is always the spouse. So, in 1987 when Michelle Schofield's body was discovered in a pit in Florida, few people believed the innocence of her husband Leo. That is until over 30 years later when Pulitzer Prize-winning author Gilbert King and his researcher Kelsey Decker start investigating the case. Although this is a true crime podcast, it unfolds more like a work of fiction from the mind of John Grisham - two plucky reporters try to free a wronged man, unearthing new evidence, going up against the government and sticking their noses where they don't belong.

Without spoiling anything, what sets this podcast apart from other true crime podcasts is that it features a blow-by-blow confession from the killer – but that's just the beginning.

At its heart, it's about injustice and trying to uncover the truth. If you love Netflix shows like Making a Murderer then this is perfect for you. The podcast is well produced, even including music from the convicted murderer – a strange choice I know, but it'll make sense when you listen to the podcast.



Here are 4 ways to disconnect from intrusive thought/s:

• Remind yourself that you do not have to believe everything you think! Thoughts are not statements of fact; they are temporary visitors. You might want to say to yourself "my thoughts are not me" or "these thoughts will soon pass."

• Practicing mindfulness will help you to observe your thoughts without judging or reacting to them. Remember they are only thoughts.

• Using a visualisation technique where you see the thoughts moving on is also often helpful. Imagine your thoughts as clouds, which come and go in the sky.

• Spending time in nature, with a pet, or other calming activities that distract you from your thoughts can also be helpful when you are lost in your own head.

If your intrusive thoughts are making you feel distressed, or they interfere with your daily functioning or are accompanied by compulsive behaviors, please consider talking to a Clinical Counsellor, like me. Using cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT), we can begin to identify, challenge, and reframe your intrusive thoughts so they become less of an issue for you. Remember, you are not alone, sometimes we all need support to move through life's issues. All the best to you, Tanya.

If you ramp up your marketing on a product or service that has not been priced correctly and does not have enough margin, or even worse a negative margin, you will accelerate the depletion of your bank account. Sadly, most business owners go broke doing this and have no idea why.

First of all, you must be clear on your highest margin products and services that are selling the best and thus making you the most money.

If you are crystal clear on this, go to town with marketing, on the basis that you know it works. By that I mean you know that for every dollar invested (yes invested not spent - big difference) in marketing, you get your initial investment (what it cost) plus a return on your investment back.

If you are not sure, DO NOT pull the marketing trigger until you know.

Otherwise, for every dollar you invest in marketing, you may be losing more than you invest, meaning you are risking a quick trip to Brokeville.

#### What to do if you have sudden hearing loss

We consider sudden hearing loss at 30 dBH or greater in at least 3 testing frequencies within 72 hours. Sudden hearing loss usually affects only one ear. Bilateral sudden hearing loss is rare. Your history and an examination can identify whether the hearing loss is conductive or sensorineural in nature. Conductive hearing loss includes earwax, trauma, and Otitis Media with effusion. A referral for a hearing test is essential in such cases and our clinic considers these as emergency cases. If the hearing loss has been identified as sensorineural and is potentially reversible, we may recommend an urgent Ear Nose and Throat's specialist (ENT) referral and/or an Emergency Department (ED) visit to Royal Brisbane Women's Hospital (RBWH) where there's access to an ENT and to Hyperbaric



Oxygen Therapy treatment. A delay in treatment may reduce the chance of reversing or reducing permanent hearing loss.
